It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

USA EXHIBITORS

Bank drafts of money orders in Canadian Funds and personal cheques, payable in U.S. funds, and for the full amount of the entry, will be accepted. Personally discounted cheques will not be honoured. Please do not mark personal cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as such items are not cleared through the banks.

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entries close, a Veterinarian's Certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within ten days of the trial must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial prior to the judging of the class and the club will refund entry fees.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full.
- 2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 3. Alterations, substitutions, or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules. ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE WEDNESDAY JUNE 8, 2011, at 8:00 pm
- 4. Identification cards and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented upon arrival at the trial.
- 5. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. **Any NSF cheques will be subject to a \$40.00 service charge.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the trial which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. The North York Obedience Club Inc. will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability, in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
- 3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of Entry will be made.
- 4. The trial precincts shall be considered to be 10 feet from all obedience ring sides...
- 5. Any ties in individual classes, or for High In trial, will be determined by the judge in accordance with rule 8.9, whereby the dog and handler will be re-tested individually.
- 6. Tie-breaking judge for the high score of the day shall be the judge who finishes last.

"Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of, and will comply with the CKC Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations Effective January 1, 2008, copies of which may be obtained by calling the Central Order Desk of the CKC at 1-800-250-8040."

New - CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

In 2010 the Board of Directors passed a motion with respect to a Non-Member Tracking Fee for Canadians that participate in CKC events and are not CKC members. At the December 2010 Board of Directors meeting the Tracking Fee motion was deleted and replaced with the following motion:

Non-Member Participation Fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.


The Non-Member Participation Fee is effective January 1, 2011. Non-Member Participation Fee: \$55.00 + HST

GETTING TO THE TRIAL

From the West: Take the 401 Eastbound towards Toronto. Exit at Islington Ave. North. Take the first stret on the right (Allenby Ave.) to Pine Point Arena (about 5 min from the 401).

From the South/West: Take the QEW Eastbound towards Toronto. Exit on Hwy. 427 and go north to Hwy. 401. Go east on the 401 and exit at Islington Ave. North. Take the first steet on the right (Allenby Ave.) to Pine Point Arena (about 5 min from the 401).

From the East: Take Hwy 401 Westbound towards London. Exit at Islington Ave. North. Turn right onto Chilcot, then right again on Burrard to get to Allenby Ave. Turn left onto Allenby to Pine Point Arena (less than 10 minutes from the 401).
