DOGS COMPETING* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more POINTS AWARDED 0 1 2 3 4 5 includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall <u>NOT</u> be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; (2) a two point win awarded either at the breed or group level; and (3) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN).

A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.

RALLY EXCELLENT "B" – This class will be for dogs that have earned the RA title. A dog completing the RE title may continued to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

Non Member Participation Fee

- A non member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a not a member of the CKC.
- The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.

NB: the non-member participation fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

Payment of this Non Member Participation Fee in advance is not necessary to enter this Specialty

It is the obligation of exhibitors to be familiar with the CKC rules for shows and trials. CKC members may obtain rule books at www.ckc.ca or order from the CKC supplies department at 416-675-5511.

OBEDIENCE CLASSES AT THIS SPECIALTY

PRE-NOVICE - This class shall be for all purebred dogs which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together on the Group exercise. A dog may be entered in the Pre-Novice that has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

NOVICE "A" - This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of "CD". One dog only may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor must be the owner, coowner, or a member of their immediate families and this person must show the dog in all classes. No person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "CDX" title shall be allowed to compete in this class, but MUST COMPETE IN ...

NOVICE "B" - This class is open to all dogs, which have not earned the title of "CD", and may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog may not necessarily be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

NOVICE "C" - This class is open to any dog that has gained the title CD or any higher obedience titles. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down Exercises when they are judged in the same group. The Novice 'C' exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice Class except that exhibitors may compete in the Novice 'C' Class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice 'C' Class are not eligible for High In Trial. Dogs may be entered in the Novice C class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE – This class is open to any dog who has earned a "CD" or any higher obedience title. Dogs may compete in this class indefinitely and a person may enter more than one dog in this class. Dogs may be entered in this class in addition to any other official class.

OPEN "A" - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD", but have not earned the title of "CDX". One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor must be the owner or a member of their immediate families and must show the dog in all exercises. No person who has previously trained or exhibited a dog through its "UD" title shall be allowed to compete, but must compete in the Open "B" class. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

OPEN "B" - This class is open to all dogs, which have earned the title of "CD", and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog may also compete in the Utility class. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in this class. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

UTILITY CLASS 'A' - This class is open to any dog which has earned the title of "CDX" but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class. This dog must be shown by the owner or a member of their immediate families. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises.

UTILITY CLASS 'B' - This class is open to any dog which has earned the title of "CDX" or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ringside, approx. 30 mins. prior to the start of the class.

UNOFFICIAL OBEDIENCE CLASS

ALL DOGS ENTERED IN A UNOFFICIAL CLASS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY AT THIS SPECIALTY TRIAL.

VETERANS CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years old prior to the closing of entries. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the "Novice Class". A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

NOTE: DOGS ENTERED IN THE VETERANS CLASS MAY BE ENTERED IN ANY OF THE REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES.

CLASSIFICATION

CONFORMATION CLASSES AT THIS SPECIALTY

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered:

<u>JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

<u>SENIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog **9** months of age and under **12** months of age on the day of the show

12 TO 18 MONTHS: Shall be for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the Specialty.

<u>CANADIAN BRED CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/co-owner **AND** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

<u>OPEN CLASS</u> - This class shall be for all dogs (divided by coat variety ie Groenendael, Malinois, Tervuren, Laeken) Please note: Open class divided in the National Specialty only.

<u>VETERANS CLASS</u>: Shall be for all dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the Specialty. The winners of the Veteran Male and Female classes will NOT compete for Championship points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR COMPETITION IN THIS CLASS. <u>Please Note</u>: Veterans offered in the National Specialty only.

<u>SPECIAL'S ONL'Y CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. <u>Note</u>: A Listed dog <u>MAY</u> be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class <u>MUST</u> be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees <u>WILL NOT</u> be refunded

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class MAY NOT COMPETE in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

EXHIBITION ONLY BABY PUPPY: Catalogue listing only

NON-REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASS AT THIS SPECIALTY

BABY PUPPY: Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the Specialty

UNOFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES AT THIS SPECIALTY

The following classes are offered in the National Specialty only:

Note: Any dog entered in these classes <u>MUST</u> also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only. The Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and dogs in the Brace may be spayed/neutered but must be entered in an Altered class, Veterans or for Exhibition Only. <u>ALL GET/PROGENY MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS.</u>

<u>SIRE & GET</u>: Shall be for Sire and three maximum of his Get. **BROOD MATRON & PROGENY**: Shall be for Dam and three maximum of her Progeny.

BRACE CLASS: Shall be for two dogs (not necessarily the same sex), must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered classes shall be limited to dogs over six months of age, which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class WILL be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed.

Two classes ONLY will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in Breed.

CONFORMATION PRIZE LIST

NATIONAL SPECIALTY

An appropriate prize and rosette will be awarded to the Belgian's winning the following:

Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Winners, Best Puppy, Winners Male, Winners Female, Reserve Winners Male, Reserve Winners Female, Best Veteran*, Best Baby Puppy, Best Brace, Best Stud Dog, Best Brood Bitch, Best Altered in Breed, Best Canadian Bred in Specialty*, First Place in all Classes.

BEST CANADIAN BRED IN SPECIALTY (* award may come from any class)

BEST VETERAN IN SPECIALTY (*award will be made from the winners of the Veteran Male and Veteran Female class)

Second thru Fourth Place winners (in all classes): ribbon Select Male and Female: rosette

JUDGES AWARD OF MERIT ROSETTE will be presented at the judge's discretion (1 award per 10 dogs competing for Best of Breed)

REGIONAL SPECIALTY

An appropriate prize and rosette will be awarded to the Belgian's winning the following:

Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Winners, Best Puppy, Winners Male, Winners Female, Best Baby Puppy

First in all Classes: ribbon Select Male and Female: rosette

JUDGES AWARD OF MERIT ROSETTE will be presented at the judge's discretion (1 award per 10 dogs competing for Best of Breed)

OBEDIENCE, RALLY & AGILITY

BSDCC Obedience (June 3): a rosette and appropriate prize is offered for High in Trial and Highest Qualifying Score in each class. All Qualifying Scores and 2nd through 4th in each class will receive a ribbon.

BSDCC Rally (June 3): a rosette and appropriate prize is offered for HQS in each of the Rally classes. 2nd through 4th in each class will receive a ribbon.

PWDCA Agility Trial (June 3): a rosette and appropriate prize is offered for Highest Scoring Belgian Shepherd in trial. In the event of a tie, the dog most under standard course time will receive the prize. A ribbon and prize is also offered to the HQS in all 6 classes.

ADDITIONAL PRIZES

Beauty and Brains

Rosette and prize for the dog and handler accumulating the most points, everyone meeting the criteria will receive a ribbon. Winners announced and ribbons awarded at the Banquet.

ALL PRIZES MUST BE CLAIMED AT THE SHOW - NO PRIZES WILL BE MAILED

Note: The person handling the exhibit in the ring shall be recognized as the owner or agent for owner and delivery of any prize won shall constitute full delivery of the prize to the rightful owner.

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

The Sweepstakes classes are open to all dogs from 6 months to under 12 months regardless of their place of birth. Dogs MUST also be entered in one of the regular classes at this Specialty. A rosette and 5% of total fees collected will be awarded to Best in Sweepstakes and Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes. A Rosette and 25% of class fees collected will be awarded to First Place in each class. A Rosette and 20% of class fees collected will be awarded to Second Place in each class. A Rosette and 10% of class fees collected will be awarded to Third Place in each class. A Rosette and 5% of class fees collected will be awarded to Fourth Place in each class.

Classes (divided by sex ONLY) offered as follows: 6 to 9 months Male/Female 9 to 12 months Male/Female 12 to 18 months Male/Female

25% of all Sweepstakes money collected retained by Club to defray costs.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all dogs 7 years of age and over. Dogs MUST also be entered in one of the regular classes or Exhibition Only at this Specialty. Dogs may be spayed or neutered provided they are entered in the Veteran (competitive) class or for Exhibition Only. Classes will be divided by sex as follows:

7 to 10 years Male/Female 10 years & over Male/Female

A rosette and 30% of total fees collected will be awarded to Best in Sweepstakes, a Rosette and 25% of total fees collected will be awarded to Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes. A Rosette and 5% of total fees collected will be awarded to First Place in each class. A Rosette will be awarded for Second through Fourth Place in each class.

25% of all Sweepstakes money collected retained by Club to defray costs

JUNIOR HANDLING

COMPETITION IS OPEN TO ALL JUNIORS BETWEEN THE AGE OF 7 AND 18 YEARS. DOGS HANDLED BY THE JUNIORS MUST BE ENTERED IN AN OFFICIAL CLASS AT THIS SPECIALTY. DOGS NEED NOT BE OWNED BY THE JUNIOR. 3.4.1 – Junior Handlers (except PeeWees) must apply to the CKC for a Junior Handler Number. Contact CKC @ 416-675-5511

THE CLASSES WILL BE DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS:

<u>JUNIOR NOVICE</u> - 7 to 10 (who have NOT won 6 first places in this class with competition), <u>JUNIOR OPEN</u> - 7 to 10 (who HAVE won 6 first places with competition), <u>INTERMEDIATE NOVICE</u> - 11 to 14 (who have NOT won 6 first places in this class with competition), <u>INTERMEDIATE OPEN</u> - 11 to 14 (who HAVE won 6 first places with competition and for any handler who has progressed through the Junior Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level), <u>SENIOR NOVICE</u> - 15 and up to 18 (who have NOT won 6 first places with competition), <u>SENIOR OPEN</u> - 15 and up to 18 (who HAVE won 6 first places in the Senior Novice Class), <u>PEE WEE</u> (non competitive) 4 to 6.

NOTE: PEE WEES DO NOT COMPETE FOR BEST OVERALL.

Rosettes and a suitable prize will be offered for Best Overall and all Class winners. Pee Wees will also receive a token prize.
