This workshop will be led by Victoria Hall, Barn Hunt judge and the founder of Barn Hunt Casa Grande. Victoria has been training dogs for over 30 years, has Master level dogs in Barn Hunt and trains & competes in the sport of IPO having earned multiple titles and championships including 12<sup>th</sup> place in the World Doberman IPO competition in Italy in 2013 with her girl Vesna.

Applying all her years of dog training and observing dog hunting behavior she has been successfully helping dogs learn this sport for over 2.5 years.

Wally Quinn has had dogs most of his life. He has competed in conformation and Earth Dog with his Border Terrier and sponsored an Earth Dog training class and became an Earth Dog judge in 2011. He has been judging all levels of Barn Hunt for over 3 years in Alaska, California, Arizona, Oregon and Washington. Wally will be judging at the 2017 Barn Hunt National in Texas and the 2018 Border Terrier National in Colorado.


General parking is available outside the building, **please park where directed.**
