In consideration of the acceptance of this entry by Lake Country Jumping Agility Mutts (the "Organizing Club") and the opportunity to have the Dog participate, compete in and/or be judged at this event or trial (the "Event"), I, the undersigned, agree as follows:
1. I certify that I am the actual owner of the Dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner of the Dog and that the Dog is not hazard to persons, property or other dogs.
2. I agree that the Organizing Club for the Event may refuse my entry for any reason that it deems to be sufficient.
3. I understand and acknowledge that participation in the Event carries certain risks, including, but not limited to injuries (including serious injuries and death) to myself, the Dog, another dog under my control or persons attending as my guests (my "Related Parties"), damage to property are other losses. I waive any and all claims that I have or may have in the future against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue the Organizing Club or any of the directors, executives, committees, representatives, employees, volunteers or agents of the Organizing Club (the "Personnel") for any injury, death, property damage or other loss that I or my Related Parties sustain due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence, breach of contract, breach of duty, statutory or otherwise, or mistakes or errors of judgment of any kind.
4. I assume full responsibility for the conduct of myself and my Related Parties during the entirety of the Event. I agree to indemnify and save harmless, the Organizing Club and the Personnel from and against any and all claims that may be made against them or costs, fees, expenses liability (including, without limitation, lawyers' fees on a solicitor and own client basis), the Organizing Club or the Personnel that may arise due to: (a) any act or omission of myself, my Related Parties or any party for whom I am liable at law; or
(b) aggressive behaviour by the Dog or any other dog under my control.
5. This event is held under modified AAC Rules and Regulations (as of Jan. 2010) and is open to all dogs being at least 12 months of age, purebre or mixed breed, except bitches in season, dogs showing signs of aggression, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affer the dog's physical or mental performance.
6. Food and toys shall be permitted on course; please do not use food that crumbles and pick up those that drop before continuing your run.
7. It is understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or childrecteate unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show grounds. In such cases, refund of fees will be paid.
8. All dogs must be kept in their ex pen, crate or on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be in control when they leave the ring after their ru Any dog engaging in aggressive or out of control behavior upon exit of the ring will be disqualified and /or be required to leave the show grounds. such cases no refund of fees will be paid.
9. Exhibitors must keep crate and exercise areas clean. Please pick after yourself and your dogs.
10. There will be no refunds, cancellations or changes after the closing date, except for bitches in season or injured dogs (vet certificate required).

Check in and Measuring

Trial Site

Swalwell Park in Lake Country. The trial will be held outdoors on grass and will run rain or shine! To get to Swalwell Park;

If you are coming from the South (Kelowna), turn right at the lights at Berry Rd. If coming from the North (Vernon) turn left at the lights at Berry Rd.

Enter the round-about and exit at the second exit, which is Bottom Wood Lake Road, after the sharp corner Swalwell Park is on the right, there is a large parking lot where you can park.

Concession:

There will **not** be a concession at this trial. Food and beverages are available within a short walking distance, or a short drive. Bakery, IGA, A&W, Subway, Pizza, Coffee Shops, Restaurants

Clean up

Please, please, please pick up after your dog. There will be a designated area for letting your dog go to the bathroom. Please use this area, as the park is used by many small children in the water park area as well as high school students and baseball players.

Please do not allow your dog to run in the water park or skateboard area.

Event and Class descriptions

Standard: This class includes all obstacles

Gamble: This game demonstrates the handler's strategy and the dog's ability to work at a distance from their handlers.

Snooker: A game which demonstrates the handler's and dog's versatility as they work together against the clock.

Jumper: This game demonstrates a dog's natural jumping ability. The dog is required to complete a course comprised of jumps and tunnels as prescribed by the judge.

Junior Handler: Includes children up to and including 17 years of age. Dog may jump regular height or one height lower. Standard course times are the same as veteran times.

Pre-starter: Open to dogs at least 12 months of age and have completed one set of introductory classes. Jump heights will be no higher than 16 inches. There will be no teeter or weave poles.

Special: Dogs jump one height class lower than prescribed for their height, lower A-frame, no spreads or doubles.

Veteran: Dogs over the age of 7 may jump 2 jump heights lower than regular division, lower A-frame, no spreads or doubles. More time is allotted for the course.

ALL PARTICIPANTS WILL BE EXPECTED TO ASSIST DURING THE FUN MATCH
