#### **6.1.1 Entry Requirements**

Draft dog tests shall be open to all dogs of sufficient height and weight that are physically capable of performing all the exercises in a particular class. The judges must excuse a dog at any time during a test for lack of physical capacity. All dogs must be 18 months of age or over on the first day of the event.

If paying by credit card, each entry form must include a VISA, MasterCard or American Express number expiry date - printed name of card holder and authorized signature.

Cheques dated after close of entries will not be accepted. **Returned cheques & declined credit cards will be assessed a \$50.00 service charge.** Please do not send entries by Registered Mail. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Test Secretary after the closing time and date. **Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.** 

**ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS**: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars ONLY. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

The owner of a dog entered in this test is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made. All particulars called for on the entry form must be complete. No refunds are given due to an error in entries. The club reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC rules.

Overpayments and duplicate entries will be considered a donation to our trophy fund. Thank you!

## **ADDITIONAL ENTRY INFORMATION**

Requalifications are accepted pending 'space available'. Requalifications shall be judged as the last team in the section for which they are entered.

Day of test entries will be accepted on the days of the test, on a first come, first serve basis, beginning 90 minutes prior to the scheduled start time of each test and ending 60 minutes prior to the start time or when the limit of 22 teams has been reached.

Bitches in season are not allowed to compete.

#### WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

<u>Please note</u>: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone <u>but written or electronic notification must</u> <u>be received by the Test Secretary no later than the official closing date and time.</u> If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the test.

All qualifying scores will receive a rosette and a prize.

#### BENCHING

Limited, free on-site benching for the tests will be available within the test precincts in designated areas. No power is available.

#### **REFUNDS**

Entry fees will **not** be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee.

Bitches in season are not allowed to compete. Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered comes into season after the close of entries if a Veterinarian's Certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the test) is delivered to the Test Secretary on or before the starting date and the time of the test. The Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta will refund entry, recording and TCN fees if the above conditions are met. A 50% refund of entry fees only will be made for a bitch in season without a veterinarian's certificate with written notification presented to the Test Secretary at least ONE HOUR before the start of the Test. The bitch must be available to be examined by the Test Chairperson to verify she is in season. Refunds will be MAILED to the exhibitor.

No entry fee will be refunded if the test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, strikes, Federal, Provincial or Local requirements or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. **Draft Dog Test Rules and Regulations** are available from the **Canadian Kennel Club** or can be viewed <u>online</u>.
- 2. The Test Chairperson will be in full charge of the test which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the test date, please contact the Event Secretary.
- 4. It shall be the duty and oblicgation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, steward, veolunteer or competitor at a Draft Dog test is not sugject to indignities The Draft Dog Test Committee Chair shall prompty report to the CKC any infrigement of this regulation and the CKC shall have the authofity to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. **Draft Dog Test Rules and Regulations** Section 20.7.
- 5. We welcome all exhibitors, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the test secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.
- 6. The test committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 7. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the test grounds.
- 8. The Draft Dog Field work, Draft Dog Excellent Freight haul and/or the Draft Dog Excellent Backpacking Exercises may be performaed using the Group Option as stated in Seciton 11.2 using the recommended methodology as stated in Appendix A.

## TCN FEES

A CKC TCN fee of \$10.50 (GST Incl.) Canadian or US per dog per show is payable with the entry fee if the entry of the dog does not include a CKC individual Registration number, ERN (Event Registration Number), PEN (Performance Event Number), MCN (Miscellaneous Certificate Number) or Companion Number. The Temporary Competition Number MUST be obtained from the CKC prior to entering any CKC event. TCNs will replace the previous system of entering events with dogs as "listed" and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). If a CKC registration number is received after the closing date but prior to the date of the show, this number may be added to the entry and noted in the marked catalogue. TCN fees will not be refunded.

Bitches in season are not allowed to compete. Entry fees will **not** be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee.

Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered comes into season after the close of entries if a veterinarian's Certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Test Secretary on or before the starting date and the time of the test. ## **ENTRY AGREEMENT**

I (we) acknowledge that I (we), all exhibitors, handlers, and patrons, know and abide by the "CKC Draft Dog Test Rules" and that I am (we are) familiar with their content. I (we) agree that the Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta (RMWHCA) has the right to refuse this entry for just cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of entries made in these tests, and of the holding of these tests and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or test secretaries, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the test premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club(s) or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes. I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in these tests, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.

Kindly note that the Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta, and/or its agents, may take candid photos, win photos, or videos of the test, including but not limited to, images of the exhibitors and their dogs. #### **ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS!**

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number</u>. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded <u>here</u>.

### Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

• To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however, to enter back into the United States, all <u>US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.</u>

• Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.
