

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

<u>SECTION 1:</u> A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be DOGS COMPETING:

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

OFFICIAL CLASSES:

The following Official Classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY - Dogs 6 months but under 9 months on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY ~ Dogs 9 months but under 12 months on the day of the show

12-18 MONTHS - Dogs 12 months but under 18 months on the day of the show.

CANADIAN BRED - Dogs born in Canada. Champions in any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - Dogs owned/handled in the ring by the breeder. Handler must be the owner/co-owner and breeder/co-breeder of the dog.

OPEN - All dogs

SPECIALS ONLY - For Canadian Champions only. Must have a CKC registration number or ERN. Listed dogs cannot enter the Specials Class.

VETERANS - Dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. (Specialty shows only) These dogs to compete for regular placements, and the 1st place dog and bitch will go on to compete for Best Of Breed. Spayed/Neutered dogs may compete.

EXHIBITION ONLY - For all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club.

BEST PUPPY IN BREED & BEST CANADIAN BRED IN SHOW WILL BE OFFERED AT THIS SHOW

SEXUALLY ALTERED DOGS:

All rules and regulations in the CKC Dog Show Rules shall apply except for those which disallow sexually altered dogs from regular conformation competition. Judges shall judge this class as if judging regular conformation classes. Withholding awards for lack of merit is encouraged. Points may not be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging.

These classes will be judged after the judging of the Best Of Breed in the Regular classes and before the non-regular/unofficial judging.

OFFICIAL CLASSES: One class for Males, One class for Females. Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Reserve Winners Dog, Reserve Winners Bitch, Best Of Breed Altered and Best Of Opposite Sex Altered will be offered at this show.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

STUD DOG - Stud dog and 2 (or more) of his get. Class will be judged on the merits of the get.

BROOD BITCH - Brood bitch and 2 (or more) of her progeny. Class will be judged on the merits of the progeny.

BRACE - A Brace should be judged as an identical pair - same color, size, gait and same stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. A brace must be handled by 1 person and 1 LEAD.

TEAM ~. A Team should be judged on same merits as the brace class (see above description).

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

The following unofficial classes will take place at the competition of the Specialty Show; that is, after the judging of Best Of Breed, Altered Classes and Non-Regular Classes.

GAIT - Movement is the prime purpose for this class. It is open to any dog or bitch entered in the Specialty Show. The judge shall withhold this trophy when he/she feels that no hound entered in this class has the desired degree of excellence and efficiency of movement to deserve the award.

HEAD - To emphasize the importance of a typical head as a distinguishing feature of the Breed. It is open to any dog or bitch entered in the Specialty Show.

HINDQUARTERS - This class is open to any dog or bitch entered in the Specialty Show. The winner will be the one that exhibits the preferred hindquarter assembly to the judge on the day of the show.

NOTE: As per CKC rules, a spayed/neutered dog may be entered in the Veterans class and in any of the non-regular or unofficial classes. Dogs entered in the non-regular classes must also be entered in either a Regular, Veteran, Sexually Altered classes or Exhibition Only.

Canadian Kennel Club Non-Member Participation Fee (Effective January 1, 2011)

Policy:

Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled.
- c) All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members. **Information:**

$_$ A non member resident in Canada is subject to the fee. Dogs co-owned with a CKC member are exempt. There are 2 options for non-members:

- a) Join the CKCb) Pay the Non-Member Participation Fee
- _ Dogs co-owned by two or more individuals; the first person listed in the CKC dog records will be considered the caregiver of the dog and all communication will be sent to this person.
- The fee is a yearly charge based on the calendar year January 01 to December 31 in which the awards, legs, points, titles, etc. were achieved. It is not based on the number of dogs, titles, or awards earned and is assessed against the owner(s).
- _ Non-members will receive a letter from CKC Head Office informing them that they have 30 days to join the Club or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee.
- _ Payment of the Non-Member Participation Fee or becoming a CKC member will protect all awards, points, titles and legs in the calendar year in which they were earned.
- _ Failure to pay the fee within 30 days of the notice will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being cancelled. Once cancelled the awards, legs, points or titles will be given to the next applicable dog.
- _ Once cancellation takes place, any subsequent awards, titles, legs etc. earned will automatically be cancelled without further notice.
- _ The Non-Member Participation Fee is applicable starting at the first event in which the dog earns awards, points, titles, legs and is not prorated.
- *Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee form are available on the CKC website under CKC Services/Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.
