All Around Papillon Challenge – 2019 Papillon Canada National Weekend

This award recognizes those papillons that exemplify true versatility by successfully competing in Conformation and Performance Events, either at the National Specialty (Conformation) or Designated Booster Events at Alberta Kennel Club (Obedience, Rally & Agility)

Eligibility: \$10.00 Entry Fee and **MUST** be acknowledged on entry form

To be eligible to participate for this award, a papillon must enter and compete in a **minimum of 2 events** offered on the national specialty weekend – agility, rally, obedience and conformation (see eligible classes below), any combination is acceptable.

Papillons that have attained one of the following conformation titles prior to the closing date of the specialty (champion, grand champion, or grand champion excellent), need only to be enter and compete in **one performance event** (to comply with the 2 event minimum). This applies to conformation titles from either Canada or the United States.. Move ups will only apply if notification is given to Margaret Zacher prior to July 30-2019.

ENTERING multi events competition is encouraged, as the winner is the papillon with the most points overall. Scoring Criteria: These Points for the National Specialty All Around Papillon Challenge are accumulative.

In order to get the 1 point for each of the groups listed below (you <u>must</u> not only enter, but you <u>must</u> participate). If you enter and do not show up, you will not be eligible for these points.

Example: A papillon enters = $\underline{1pt}$, if they place $1st = \underline{3 pts}$, if they win Winners dog = $\underline{3 pts}$, and if they win Best of Opposite Sex = $\underline{6 pts}$.

In this example. 1 + 3 + 3 + 6 = 13 points

Dog DOES NOT have to be entered in the conformation National to be awarded these additional points.				
Restrictions: Points are awarded at the highest title level from each country.				
2 pts	Has earned a CKC or AKC Championship title prior to competition			
4 pts	Has earned a CKC or AKC Grand Championship title prior to competition			
6 pts Has earned Grand Championship Excellent title prior to competition				

Example: A papillon enters = <u>1pt</u>, if they place 1st = 3 pts, , if they win Winners dog = <u>3 pts</u>, if they win Best of Opposite Sex = <u>6 pts</u>, and they also have an Am Grand Champion = <u>4 pts</u>. In this example. 1 + 3 + 3 + 6 + 4 = 17 points

Winner will be the PAPILLON with the most points.

1st place – 50% of all proceeds received, PLUS \$100 Bonus and Rosette 2nd place – 25% of all proceeds received and Rosette 3rd place – 25% of all proceeds received and Rosette

In the event of a tie, bonus points will be added to the tied scores based on level of competition in each event the dog participated in.

The highest class competed in will be used, regardless if that score was used in the original calculation.
