CLASSIFICATION - CONFORMATION

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex.

REGULAR CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY - 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show.

12-18MONTH CLASS - for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

CANADIAN BRED - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder

OPEN CLASS - shall be for all Dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY – Dogs which have a recorded CKC registration, Event Registration Number (ERN) or Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and have attained the required points for Championship status. All awards earned at the show will be cancelled if it is found that a dog is not registered or has not completed the requirements for a CKC Championship. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

BABY PUPPY CLASS – Dogs **4 months** of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show.

The awards for these classes are: Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female, Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Best Baby Puppy in Group, Best Baby Puppy in Show. These classes will be judged immediately after Best of Breed of the regular classes.

EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

BEST DOG HANDLED BY A JUNIOR (Jenny Stewart Scholarship Award)- Eligibility for the Best Dog Handled by a Junior competition shall be limited to dogs handled by a junior (18 years old and under) at all levels of judging. Dogs entered in this class must be entered in an official class as well. Each Junior will choose only one dog to compete in this event. This class will be judged after the Baby Puppy class except at the Best in Show level where it will be judged after Best Puppy in Show. The judge will pick the best dog, this is not a handling competition. Day of entry for this class will be accepted if the dog chosen is already registered in an official class. Entries must be submitted at least 1 hour before breed judging.

Grooming

There will be no set-up until after 4 PM on Thursday. The dog show will not start before 10:00 AM on Friday to allow people time to set up before the show.

Limited reserved grooming spaces will be available in Glenwood Center with shared power. Book your grooming spot through dogshow.ca



There will be very limited free **day** grooming available in the building and more under tents at the North side of the building (weather permitting). Exhibitors that are in the day grooming section must remove everything after they are done showing for the day.

Exhibitors may set up their own tents outside in a designated area, with no power supplied. If you use on-site power, you will be charged RV rates.

Leaving equipment overnight, unattended, will be at the participant's own risk.

Registration will be posted in the judging schedule. Junior Handlers with the exception of PeeWees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. Only complete entries accepted. The Alberni Valley Kennel Club offers rosettes for Best Overall Handler and first in each class. Ribbons for 2nd through 4th are offered. Participant ribbons will be given to all Peewee entrants. Prizes offered for First in each class and Best Overall.

SWEEPSTAKES

Juvenile Sweepstakes

Eligibility

1. The Sweepstakes are open to all dogs. Baby Puppies: Male and Female (4mos. To under 6 mos.) Junior Puppies: Male and Female (6mos. to under 9 mos.); Senior Puppies: Male and Female (9 mos. to under 12 mos.); and Juvenile Puppies: Male and Female (12 mos. to 18 mos.)
2. **All entries must also be entered in a regular breed class on the same day.**

Classification

1. For the purpose of judging, the dogs will be divided by sex into the following classes: Baby Puppy, Junior Puppy, Senior Puppy and Juvenile.
2. For the purpose of judging, the First-Place winners from each class will be brought together for the final placements of First and Runner-up.

Prizes

Rosettes will be awarded to 1st in each class and a ribbon will be awarded to 2nd to 4th in each class. 35% of total fees collected will be divided between the winners of each class.

1st in Sweepstakes = rosette & 25% of the total fees collected.

Runner-up in Sweepstakes = rosette & 15% of the total fees collected. (25% of the fees will be retained by the club to defray expenses.)

Veteran Sweepstakes

Eligibility

1. The Sweepstakes are open to all dogs 7+ years and may be altered.
2. **All entries must also be entered in a regular breed class on the same day or entered in exhibition only.**

Classification

1. For the purpose of judging, the dogs will be divided by sex into the following classes:
7-10 years, 10 + years.
2. For the purpose of judging, the First-Place winners from each class will be brought together for the final placements of Best in Sweeps.

Prizes

Rosettes will be awarded to 1st in each class and a ribbon will be awarded to 2nd to 4th in each class. 35% of total fees collected will be divided between the winners of each class.



\$500.00 Jenny Stewart Scholarship Award will be given to the Best Dog Shown by a Junior, Saturday. Eligibility for the Best Dog Handled by a Junior competition shall be limited to ONE dog handled by a junior (18 years old and under) at all levels of judging. Dogs entered in this class must be entered in an official class as well. The judge will pick the best dog, (this is not a handling competition). Winners will receive their scholarship money after submitting a receipt from an accredited post-secondary institution. Day of entries for this class will be accepted for any dog already registered in an official class. Please register at least an hour before breed judging. If you are willing to have your dog shown by a junior or if you are a junior looking for a dog email the show secretary.

CANINE CLASSIC

Celebrating 60 years of Dog Shows

Eligibility

The Canine Classic is open to all dogs who have ever won a Group 1st in an all breed championship show or complete group specialty held in Canada. The date and location of the group 1st must accompany the entry. Puppy group 1st is not eligible.

Prize List

Best in Classic: **\$750.00** and Rosette -
Group Winners: **\$100.00**

Best Veteran in Classic: **\$250.00** and Rosette
Veteran Group Winners: **\$50.00**

Canine Classic Judges

3 secret judges. Two judges will be chosen at random for each group. Winners of the group will be the dog with the highest average score from each judge. At the Best in Classic level dogs will be judged by which ever judge had not previously examined them. (Exhibitors may enter more than one dog per group as they will be entering the rings separately.)

Judging Criterion:

Dogs competing shall be judged in their CKC recognized group in random order. Each group will be judged by two judges without consultation between judges. Each judge will score each dog out of a possible 100 points. The total score awarded will be announced. Individual scores will be posted later. The seven group winners will be judged again individually by a third judge. The dog's three scores will be added together and the highest score will be awarded Best in Classic. In the case of a tie the lowest score of the dogs concerned will be dropped and the new total shall be the deciding factor. If a tie still exists the show committee shall render a decision.

Entry Fee: \$40.00 - includes a complimentary digital catalogue. Exhibitors may submit a photo and a short description of wins for their dog for submission to the digital catalogue if they choose. Copies of the digital catalogue will be available on our club's website after the show.

Rules

The Canine Classic is an **unofficial event** and is separate from the Alberni Valley Kennel Club CKC approved all breed shows & trials. Catalogues, entries and armbands are separate from those used for the all breed shows.

The Canine Classic will be start **at 6:00PM** (after BEST In Show) on **Sat. October 18th 2025**.

Only dogs that have won a group first at an all breed championship show or complete group specialty will be entered.

For **an extra \$5.00 fee** entries will be taken Friday and Saturday (Oct. 17 & 18) of the show.

NO dog may be entered in the Classic if it has been handled, owned, leased or boarded by any of the classic judges. Exhibitors will be notified by the show secretary if an entry is not eligible.

The show committee reserves the right to remove any person or dog from competition for misbehavior.

The club wishes to express that this is a **FORMAL EVENT and formal attire is requested**.

There will be no refunds of entry fees for any reason.

4.1.5 *No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.*

19.7 *It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.*

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows: (*Includes the dog awarded Winners.)

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite, Best of Breed. A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. Further Section 15.1.12{C} has been added and states the dog must: “have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed level or group level. “The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded winners also places in the Group as listed below.

A class Dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show.

15.2 Grand Champion (GCh) (47-06-12)

15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Conformation Championship.

15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Conformation Championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the Conformation Championship.

15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

a) Grand Champion Point System

Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, and are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level:

(c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

(d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward

15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.



(a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.

(b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

(c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS) The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.

(a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.

(b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold: (GChG) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.

(a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.

(b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) *(48-06-12)*

15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.

15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

(a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed)

(b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins.

(c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty

Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above.

2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until July 1, 2022

RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

1. Parking on the grounds is at the owner's risk. PARKING ON THE GROUNDS IS AT THE OWNER'S RISK, THE CLUB WILL NOT TAKE RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY DAMAGES TO VEHICLES OR EQUIPMENT.
2. THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY PERSON FROM THE SHOW. THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT SHALL HAVE FULL CONTROL OF THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS, WHICH WILL BE GOVERNED BY CKC RULES.
3. ANY DOG EXCUSED BY THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT OR VETERINARIAN FOR ANY REASON SHALL NOT, COMPETE IN ANY CLASS FOR ANY AWARDS FOR THE BALANCE OF THE SHOW.
4. THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL USE DUE CARE AND DILIGENCE FOR THE WELFARE OF DOGS AND EXHIBITORS, BUT WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR, OR ASSUME ANY LIABILITY IN THE EVENT OF ACCIDENT OR MISFORTUNE TO EITHER DOGS, EXHIBITORS, SPECTATORS OR VENDORS.
5. DOGS MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 1 HOUR PRIOR TO THE JUDGING OF THEIR BREED.
6. THE OWNER OF A DOG ENTERED IN THESE SHOWS IS ENTIRELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ERROR IN ENTERING HIS/HER DOG REGARDLESS OF HOW OR BY WHOM ENTRY WAS MADE.
7. EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR DOGS AND EQUIPMENT LEFT AT THE SHOW GROUNDS.
8. OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP AFTER THEIR DOGS.
9. ANYONE FOUND DISCHARGING WATER ON THE GROUNDS FROM THEIR RECREATIONAL VEHICLE WILL BE REMOVED BY ORDER OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT, AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO A FINE.
10. IF, BECAUSE OF CIVIL DISTURBANCE OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE CLUB, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR COMPLETE THE SHOW, THERE IS NO REFUND OF ENTRY.
11. DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OR WITHIN THE SHOW BUILDING.
