BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test. When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the test secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the test, must reach the secretary on or before the date of the test. The trial-giving club must refund the entry fee, service charge and listing fee.

MOVE UPS: Move ups are permissible one (1) hour before the event or immediately upon completion of a level.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY: The receipt of entries will be confirmed for those providing a return e-mail address on their form.

QUARRY: The guarry used in these tests will be two rats.

- AWARDS: Qualifiers in the Introduction to Quarry test will receiver flat ribbons. Qualifiers in Junior, Senior and Master Earthdog tests will receive rosettes.
