No post dated cheques accepted. The Shows and Trials Division of the CKC interprets the term "Post Dated" to mean date other than the date on which the entry was received. Entries cannot be processed unless the date of the cheque is current. All NSF cheques will be Subject to a charge of \$50.00, N.S.F. cheques are considered nonpayment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards All fees must be paid before the show.

It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile. Or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits regulated for each document in the CKC Rule and regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or copies of emails, will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in USfunds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts ormoney orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you A copy of the Rules pertaining to Dog Shows & Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.



ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED NO LATER THAN 4 PM EST TO ENTRY LINE.

#### **ENTRYINFORMATION**

- 1. All entries are to be sent to the Show Secretary and must be received by the closing date and time.
- 2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.
- 3. Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and Handlers please note that full name and address of owners must be filled in.
- 4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
- 5. Only dogs eligible for CKC registration may enter this show. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
- 6. A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of Championship, in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 20 of these rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary IN WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

# EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that areforeign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN).

To obtain an ERN number simply do the following:

- 1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, e.g., AKC Registration Certificate, with a written request for an ERN number.
- 2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount of \$50.00 (plus GST or HST where applicable) pay able to the Canadian Kennel Club.
- 3. Ensure that you provide us with yourfull return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you.
- 4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA/ Mastercard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "Listed"; however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event will result in cancellation of any wins, awards, or scores.

# Champions and Championship Points - Chapter 21

SECTION 1 - A dog awarded Winners at a champiorship show held under these Dogs Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of champiorship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder: SECTION 2 -

Dogs competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

<sup>\*</sup> includes the dog awarded Winners

#### CONFORMATION

REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Baby puppy a dog 3 months up to 6 months on the day of the show

Junior puppy a dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show

Senior puppy a dog between 9 months up to 12 months on the day of show

12-18 Month a dog between 12 months up to 18 months on the day of show

Canadian bred dog which was born in Canada.

**Bred by exhibitor** a dog owned and handled by the breeder

Open class all dogs

Veterans a dog 7 years and over

**Specials only** dogs who are Canadian champions only

**Exhibition** dogs 6 months and over, not in competition. Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes. No exhibitor may entermore than 2 puppies.

**Note**: Awards of Merit will be made (if warranted) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (offered for the National Specialty only on Aug 30, 2014)

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or

Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog Classshall be for Stud Dog and two or more of his Get, same varietyBrood Bitch Classshall be for Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny, same varietyBrace Classshall be for 2 dogs of the same colour and variety of either sex and identical

ownership.

Team Class shall be for 4 dogs of the same colour and variety of either sex and identical

ownership.
