Reserved grooming - again, offered at NO CHARGE! Due to the anticipated large entry, the club is reserving a portion of the building for pre-assigned grooming spaces. Individuals, or groups of individuals with a minimum of 6 dogs may request space. This will be on a first come, first served basis. If you are coming with a large number of dogs, PLEASE request grooming in advance, rather than expecting to be accommodated at the last minute!!

Once the allotted area has been filled, all further requests will be returned as will any requests received after the close of entries.

In addition to the pre-assigned areas, there will also be regular first come, first served grooming space in which equipment/dogs may be left for the duration of the shows. There will also be an area that will be set aside for Day of Show grooming - this will be first come, first serve and all equipment MUST BE REMOVED after Best in Show each night. There will be **NO** exercise pens allowed in this area. Any equipment left in DAY OF SHOW grooming after Best in Show will be removed by the club or one of it's delegates. Please note: Exercise pens in all areas except Day of Show Grooming (no pens permitted in this area) **may** be restricted to 1 pen per 3 entered dogs, depending on the size of the entry.

Specialty clubs will be given a 10' x 15' UPON request. This can be increased depending on the breed and number of entries. Please make your request as soon as possible.

Grooming areas will be monitored by the club and delegated individuals - exhibitors who do not keep their areas clean, or abuse the space allotted, may be asked to leave the show.





OBEDIENCE CLASSIFICATIONS

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A" & "B" AT SAME TRIAL NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN "A" & "B" AT SAME TRIAL

NOVICE "A" - This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of "CD" in ANY COUNTRY. **One dog ONLY** may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor **MUST BE THE OWNER** or **A**

MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY and MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class, but MUST COMPETE IN NOVICE "B" CLASS NOVICE "B" - This class is open to all dogs, which have not earned the title of "CD", and may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog may not necessarily be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class OPEN "A" - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD" IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of "CDX" in any country. One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor MUST BE THE OWNER or A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY and MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete, but MUST COMPETE IN THE OPEN "B" CLASS. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at

<u>OPEN "B"</u> - This class is open to all dogs, which have earned the title of "CD" in CANADA, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog **MAY ALSO COMPETE IN THE UTILITY CLASS**. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

<u>UTILITY CLASS 'A'</u> - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class..This dog must be shown by the owner or a member of their immediate families. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter More than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score will be cancelled.

<u>UTILITY CLASS 'B'</u> - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person.A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ringside, approx. 30 mins. Prior to the start of the class.

TRANSITION OBEDIENCE CLASSES

PRE-NOVICE – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together on the Group exercise. A dog may be entered in the Pre-Novice that has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

NOVICE "C" – This class is open to any dog of either sex that has gained the title Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down Exercises when they are judged in the same group. The Novice 'C' exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice Class except that exhibitors may compete in the Novice 'C' Class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice 'C' Class are not eligible for High In Trial. The P.C.D. and C.D.I. and Novice 'C' are elective classes which are offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience and acclimation to the trial situation or would like to earn additional titles. Dogs may be entered in the Novice – Intermediate (C.D.I.) and/or Novice 'C' class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial Classes.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have earned the title of (C.D.) Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada. A dog eligible for entry in the Open A or B Class at any obedience trial held under these rules is also eligible for entry in the Novice 'C' and Novice Intermediate Class at the same trial. The Novice Intermediate class (C.D.I.) is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to a Companion Dog Excellent title. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High In Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

DOG SHOW CLASS INFORMATION

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of this Specialty

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of this Specialty

12 to 15 Months Class – This class shall be for dogs at least 12 mos. of age on the day of this Specialty and under 15 mos. on the day of this Specialty

15 to 18 Months Class – This class shall be for dogs at least 15 mos. of age on the day of this Specialty and under 18 mos. on the day of this Specialty

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. (Champions of any country excluded)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler <u>MUST</u> be the owner/co-owner <u>AND</u> breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN BRINDLE CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs of the brindle colour

OPEN FAWN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs of the fawn colour

VETERANS CLASS – This class shall be for dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of this Specialty. (This class will be divided into 3 age divisions – 7 to 9 yrs, 10 & 11 yrs and 12+ yrs. Winners of each class will carry through to compete for Best of Breed)

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for Champions of record at the time of closing of entries for this Specialty. Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE FIRST SHOW. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades



NON-REGULAR CLASSES

BRACE CLASS - This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex)

STUD DOG CLASS – This class shall be comprised of the Stud Dog and 2 or more of his get. All dogs comprising the get need not be the property of the same exhibitor. Get must be entered in a regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – This class shall be comprised of the Brood Bitch and 2 or more of her progeny. All dogs comprising the progeny need not be the property of the same exhibitor. Progeny must be entered in a regular class.

PARADE OF CHAMPIONS— This class shall be for all Boxers who: hold a CKC or AKC Championship and/or hold a CKC or AKC performance title Dogs entered in the Parade MUST be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition only, spayed and neutered dogs may be entered in the parade. The parade will be held after the completion of Best of Breed judging. **Please include a short resume of your dog, limited to 50 words or less for publication in the catalogue.**

DOGS ENTERED IN NON-REGULAR CLASSES MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY



AGREEMENT

I (we) agree to hold the Renaissance Dog Association. their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
