### NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

Effective January 1, 2011, the Canadian Kennel Club has implemented a non-member participation fee which will be charged to a resident of Canada who is not a member of the Canadian Kennel Club. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being cancelled. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

### MOVE-UPS WILL BE ALLOWED IF TIME PERMITS

A dog must be individually registered with the CKC or have an Event Registration Number, a Performance Event Number or a Miscellaneous Class Certification Number in order to move up. See Ch. 6.9 on p.22

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

- No entries may be accepted, altered, canceled or substituted after the official closing date and time for entries except as provided for in the rules.
- BITCHES IN SEASON** Refund of entry will be made on bitches that come in season after entries close. Request in writing must be submitted to the Trial Secretary with a certificate from a veterinarian on or before the day of the trial.
- In Canada, an obedience or rally title can be earned with three (3) qualifying scores under two (2) different judges.
- Exhibitors should note that the CKC does not confer a title on any dog until it is registered with the CKC – full registration, ERN or PEN.
- A dog which has earned its CD title in the USA or any foreign country is not eligible for entry in the Novice A class. A dog which has earned its CDX in the USA or any foreign country is not eligible for entry in the Open A class. Such dogs must be entered in the respective B classes. Licensed handlers, trainers and persons who have previously exhibited a dog through its UD in Canada or elsewhere are not eligible for entry in the A classes.
- Exhibitors must abide by any errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how or who made the errors.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have the dog at ringside when the dog’s class is scheduled for judging.
- If entering a dog in Open or Utility and Rally Advanced or Excellent **PLEASE MARK JUMP HEIGHTS ON ENTRY FORMS.**
- The Trial Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- The precincts of the trials shall be the interior of the River Valley Community Center.
- If because of riot, civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or close trials, no refund of entries will be made.
- Ch. 20.7 -- Obedience & Ch. 17.7 -- Rally Obedience  
It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial or Rally Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- In Rally Obedience a dog that has won a CKC Rally Novice title or any Novice Obedience title, must be entered in the Rally B classes.
- It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission reaches the proper authority or recipient with the times & limits as regulated in the CKC rules & regulations. Sent fax receipts and/or copies of sent emails will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

Drive approximately 7 km. – the arena is on the left

Coming from Fredericton/Quebec

Take Highway 7 South toward Saint John  
Take Exit 80 Grand Bay/Westfield  
Turn left at end of Off Ramp; drive to intersection (flashing light) and turn right  
Drive approximately 6 km. – arena is on the right

Coming from USA (Calais, ME)/St. Stephen

Take Highway 1 East toward Saint John  
Take Exit 114 Grand Bay/Westfield, Fredericton to Highway 7  
Drive approximately 6 km. and take Exit 90  
Drive approximately 7 km. – the arena is on the left
