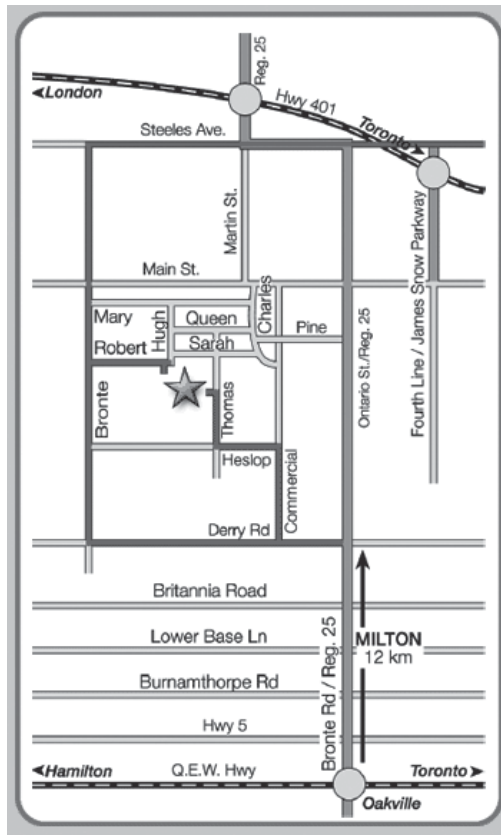

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

Effective Jan. 1/92, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Fee is \$58.50 per dog plus applicable taxes. For further information contact:

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

Effective January 1, 2011:

- A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$58.50 plus applicable taxes.
- The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

Rally Novice A – Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (RN) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

Rally Novice B – Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Rally Advanced A – This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (RA) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one time.

Rally Advanced B – This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (RA) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Rally Excellent A – This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (RE) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.

Rally Excellent B – This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (RE) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

**BITCHES IN
SEASON**

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete under CKC Rules. We will refund all entry and listing fees if a bitch comes into season after the closing date of the trial, upon presentation of a veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial. This certificate must reach the Trial Secretary before the trial commences.

- No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
- Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules. **Entries positively close 6:00 p.m. SATURDAY, JULY 27, 2013** and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.
- Identification cards and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented upon arrival at the show.
- Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. **Any N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a \$20.00 service charge.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- The Golden Retriever Club of Greater Toronto will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
- Dogs should arrive in adequate time for judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several dogs must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times conflict.
- SHOW PRECINCTS:** The Show precincts shall consist of all areas set out for rings, all shelters or facilities set aside for show officials, judges or exhibitors and handlers, and an area of 30 feet outside of the judging rings. In the event of inclement weather, no provisions have been made for cover.

Best Overall Rosette donated by MJN Show Services.

A rosette will be offered for First through Fourth in each class.

Each participant will receive a rosette.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded WINNERS at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. Every day of a 2 or 3 day show is a separate show. Please note that this rule is effective up to one hour prior to the opening of the show, NOT one hour prior to the judging of the breed.

CKC RULES AND REGULATIONS

The exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club applying to Conformation Shows, Licensed Obedience Trials, and Licensed Rally Obedience Trials. A judge officiating at a show or trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show or trial. It shall be the duty of the club holding the show or trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

SPECIALTY OFFICIAL CLASSES

BABY PUPPY CLASS – Dogs 3 months of and under 6 months on the day of the show. Both male and female Baby Puppies will be judged prior to the judging of other official classes. Puppies in this category may not compete in any official, unofficial or non-regular classes.

JUNIOR PUPPY – a dog between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.

SENIOR PUPPY – a dog between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.

12 – 18 MONTHS – a dog between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show.

CANADIAN BRED – a dog which is born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR – dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The breeder/owner must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS – for all dogs.

VETERANS CLASS (classes split by ages: 7 to 10 years and 10+ years) – for all dogs over seven years of age as of the date of the show. These dogs to compete for the regular placements and the 1st place Dog and Bitch from each age split class will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

SPECIALS ONLY – dogs who are Canadian Champions only.

EXHIBITION ONLY – all dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades.

AWARD OF MERIT – At the judge's discretion, Awards of Merit may be awarded up to one Award for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. Rosettes will be given for the Awards of Merit which will be presented following Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

BRACE – Two dogs of same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). Must be handled by one person on one lead. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

STUD DOG & GET – Entry comprises the Stud Dog and two only of his Get. Stud Dog must be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class. Stud Dog may be neutered. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

BROOD BITCH & PROGENY – Entry comprises the Brood Bitch and two only of her Progeny. Brood Bitch must be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition Only. Progeny must be entered in a Regular class. Brood Bitch may be spayed. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

Dogs entered in Obedience cannot be used as part of these classes.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Dogs must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

GUN DOG AND BITCH CLASS – shall be for any dog of either sex with a CKC WC, WCI or WCX or a CKC or AKC JH or SH or a GRCA WC or WCX.

FIELD DOG AND BITCH CLASS – shall be for a dog of either sex with a CKC or AKC MH or placement in a CKC or AKC Licensed Field Trial.

These classes will be held after the Breed Class and any Non-Regular Class judging.
