GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES

ELIGIBILITY: Purebred or mixed-breed dogs must be at least 6 months of age that:

- (a) Are individually registered with the CKC (have a CKC registration number),
- (b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN),
- (c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN),
- (d) Are eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- (e) Have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed
- (f) Have a Canine Companion number (CCN) if it is a mixed-breed.

Dogs that are eligible for a CKC or ERN number but don't yet have one should have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). These can be obtained free of charge online from the CKC. For this event, dogs may still be run as "Listed". For more information about the TCN:

ENTRY LIMIT: Trials are limited to 120 runs on Saturday and 75 runs on Sunday. Day of trial entries will NOT be accepted at this event. If the tests fill, waiting lists will be kept and dogs from the waiting list may be entered and added.

Handlers may only enter 1 dog in each component at each level. Dogs can only be entered in Open, Excellent or Master components if they have already qualified at the preceding level in that component.

MOVE UPS: There will be no move ups during this trial. If teams title at an earlier event and they have entered Open, they will not be able to move up to Excellent if Sunday is full. Entry fees will be refunded (excluding DogShow fees) and teams will be put on the wait list at the handler's request. If teams title in Novice at an earlier event, they may be moved up to Open by notifying the Secretary. If teams title in Excellent at an earlier event, they may be moved up to Master by notifying the Secretary.

ROSETTES & PRIZES: A rosette will be awarded for all **new** titles. Only those dogs earning qualifying scores will receive flat ribbons. Awards will be given for Most Outstanding Team for each level, to be determined by the judges.

Border Terrier Canada will offer a prize for each Border Terrier that earns a qualifying score each day (1 prize per dog per day).

EQUIPMENT: The dog may wear a buckle, snap or martingale collar and/or body harness in the ring. Collars/harnesses with tags may be worn in the ring. Harnesses may have the leash attached to the front clip or on the back. Electronic training and pinch collars are not allowed on the rounds.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. If a bitch comes into season after entries have closed, the club will refund the entry fee providing the event secretary receives, on or before the event, a veterinarian's certificate declaring that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial.

BORDER CROSSING: A valid rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada.

TEST SITE CONDUCT: No indoor kenneling. These tests will be run **rain or shine**.

All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the trial where off leash searches are permitted. All dogs must be contained in participant vehicles during the Trial. It is the participant's responsibility to ensure the dog(s) are secured by a means that does not allow the dog to 'get loose' from the vehicle (eg. crate, seat belt, harness). Dogs should not be able to hang their head or body outside of open windows or tailgates while in the vehicle.

It is the participant's responsibility to ensure their dog has the proper equipment to keep warm or cool in and out of the vehicle relevant to weather and season.

Participants must keep their dogs at least 15 feet away from other dogs at all times when transporting to bathroom areas, warm up boxes or search areas. Failure to do so may result in a dismissal. **Flexi leads will not be allowed on the test site.**

Remember that this is a public park used by families. Clean up after yourself and your dog.

Bathroom facilities are on site. A concession is available at Planet Ice within walking distance of the venue.

REGULATIONS: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Printed copies of the CKC Scent Detection Rules &

CKC REGULATION: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
