## **What is a Sniff 'N Go?**

A Sniff N Go is similar to a Fun Match or a Run Through in other dog sports. It provides you with a chance to practice all 4 K9 Nosework® elements in a new location. This event will be run similar to a trial but a bit more loosely to accommodate the small facility and number of participants. Your searches will be timed and you will receive a score sheet at the end of the day to take home.

There will be 2 elements run in the morning, a potluck lunch around noon with the remaining 2 elements run after lunch. The target odor for the dogs will be Birch. Dogs need to be on odor but hides will be paired if necessary.

This event will proceed, rain or shine and will start at approximately 9 AM. There will be no crating outside of vehicles.

**Cost:** \$30 Canadian for the 1<sup>st</sup> dog, \$25 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> dog, same handler. US exhibitors please send a Money order in Canadian funds.

- ∅ Handlers are limited to 2 dogs each. Hides will not be reset for the 2<sup>nd</sup> dog.
- ∅ Entries are limited to 40 dogs.
- ∅ Dogs and handlers need not be members of NACSW. ORT's are not required.
- ∅ Entries must be received by 6 PM, July 21, 2012. No day-of entries will be accepted.
- ∅ Females in season will be allowed to run at the end of each element.
