## PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

I am offering a payment plan for the MASTERS and STARTERS/ADVANCED seminars. A **\$100.00 non-refundable deposit** is due with this application to hold your working spot. You are, of course, welcome to send full payment at this time. However, if you would like to spread the cost out, the following payment schedule is available:

- \$100.00 with your entry.
- \$100.00 due August 31
- \$100.00 due September 28

*Please note that if you are entering either the Gamble or the Puppy/Young Dog session, full payment is due with your entry.*

## PAYMENT AND REFUND POLICY

Soaring Paws Agility (SPA) budgets for and hires seminar presenters based on filling a specific number of working spots. Presenter, presenter's travel costs, and facility costs are the same amount of money regardless of how many people attend the seminar. A waiting list will be maintained, however, if you cancel, a **refund will only be issued if I can fill your working spot**.
