Any ties in individual classes or for High in Trial, will be determined by the judge of the second trail of the day in accordance with rule 7.8 whereby the dog and handler will be re-tested individually.

Eligibility: To be eligible to compete in an obedience trial, the dog must be registered with the CKC, be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, or have a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate number. A dog may be spayed, neutered or debarked.

**Bitches in Season** are not permitted to compete. The judge of an obedience trial must remove from competition any bitch in season, or any bitch which appears so attractive to males as to be a disturbing element. When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the Trial Secretary and a Veterinarian's certificate that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial, the Trial giving club will refund entry, service charges and listing fees.

**NOVICE 'A' & OPEN 'A' CLASSES**

Entries cannot be accepted into the 'A' Classes for two dogs owned by the same person. One dog may be entered in the 'A' Class; the other dog must be entered in 'B' The exhibitor, or a member of his immediate family, must handle the dog in all exercises. A dog which has earned its CD degree in the USA or BERMUDA is not eligible for Novice 'A' class. A dog which has earned its CDX in the USA or BERMUDA is not eligible in the Open 'A' Class. Such dogs must be entered in the 'B' Class Refer to the CKC Rule book for clarification

**LISTED DOGS** Listed dogs may not be entered in Open or Utility. There is no limitation on the number of trials at which a dog maybe entered as a LISTED DOG except that a dog which has obtained 3 qualifying scores at obedience trials held under CKC rules may not continue to compete at licensed obedience trials held under the club's rules until the dog is registered individually or has obtained an ERN number with the CKC or until its owner has provided evidence satisfactory to the CKC that is eligible for registration in the club's records.

**Brace Class: 15.5.1** The Brace Class is open to any 2 dogs of any breed and of either sex that has attained not less than a C.D. title in Canada. It is not necessary that the same person own both dogs, nor that they be of the same breed, except when entered in a breed specialty obedience trial. **15.5.2** The Brace Class is performed and judged in the same manner as the Novice Class. The 2 dogs shall be hitched together with a brace chain or coupling and are judged on the performance of the 2 dogs as though they were one. Exhibitors may enter more than one brace in this class, but must have a separate handler for each brace in the Long Sit and Long Down exercises when judged in the same group.

**Obedience Rules & Regulations**

Chapter 19.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

**Junior Handling Obedience Competition, December 18 & 19, 2010**

Entry must be made on a special entry form as provided by the CKC and available from the Trial Secretary .Any dog entered in the trial maybe used with the owner's or agent's permission. The Junior Handler will wear the armband number assigned to the dog for the trial. **Junior Novice A** for handlers 7 years up to & including 11 years of age who have not achieved 300 point in the same class competition. **Junior Novice B** for handlers 7 years up to & including 11 years of age who have achieved 300 point in the same class competition Intermediate A & B Class: **Junior Open A** for handlers 7 years up to & including 11 year of age who have not achieved 300 points in the Open class. The dog must have its CD to compete in this class. **Junior Open B** for handlers 7 years up to & including 11 year of age who have achieved 300 points in the Open class. The dog must have its CD to compete in this class. **Senior Novice A** for handlers 12 years up to but not including 18 years of age who have not achieved 300 point in the same class competition. **Senior Novice B** for handlers 12 years up to but not including 18 years of age who have achieved 300 point in the same class competition **Senior Open A** for handlers 12 years up to but not including 18 years of age who have not achieved 300 points in the Open class. The dog must have its CD to compete in this class. **Senior Open B** for handlers 12 years up to but not including 18 years of age who have achieved 300 points in the Open class. The dog must have its CD to compete in this class.

-Fee for an Event Registration Number with the CKC is \$53.50  
Include your payment in the full amount in Canadian Funds.

Non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates
