Official CKC Entry Forms MUST be used. PLEASE PRINT OR TYPE YOUR ENTRIES. Remember your entry can only be as accurate as the information you provide. The Show Secretary is NOT RESPONSIBLE for incorrect information provided by the entrant. Please read your entry carefully before you submit it. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the errors were made. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC Rules.

Photocopy extra Entry Forms if required. If a dog is entered in more than one class or event a separate entry form is required for each one

NO POST DATED CHEQUES ACCEPTED. ALL NSF cheques are subject to a charge of \$25.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered Non-Payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the shows/trials.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US Funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not make cheques "Payable In Canadian Funds", they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge you to purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED. Agents and handlers please note that the full name and address of owners MUST be filled in and to whom ID's are to be returned. (Section 13.1.2 Dog Show Rules)



### **EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)**

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN simply do the

following:

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- 1. send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN.
- Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. 2. 3.
  - Ensure that you provide the CKC with your full return address to enable the ERN to be sent to you

Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA/MasterCard number and expiry date, the card holders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED", however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

### **TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (\* EFFECTIVE MARCH 2, 2020)**

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN).

There is no fee to obtain a TCN, however, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

Dogs may still enter CKC events until without a registration number or ERN until March 2, 2020 by marking TCN on the entry form (or Listed if it is an older entry form). An email address is required on the entry form in this case. Before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account.

\* If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. The CKC will update its records accordingly.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

NOTE: In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall <u>NOT</u> be included in the calculation of Championship Points.

### NON MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number.

In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled.

Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "Non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC members.

### **"REFUND INFORMATION ~ COMMUNICABLE DISEASES"**

Entry Fees will be refunded for dogs/bitches that are posing a threat of a COMMUNICABLE DISEASE on the day of the show. To obtain the refund a letter from a practicing Veterinarian MUST be presented to the Show Secretary prior to the commencement of the show.

### BABY PUPPY will be judged separately on Saturday by Carola Adams and on Sunday by Wendy Bennett.

# **RULES & RULE BOOKS**

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or participant at any event held under CKC Rules, is not subjected to indignities of any kind. The Show Committee shall promptly report any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of report, indicating that this has occurred.

A copy of the Rules pertaining Dog Shows and/or Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club 1-416-675-5511. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to know the rules pertaining to these events.

#### GENERAL INFORMATON

- 1. The Show Superintendent will be in complete charge of these events, which are governed by CKC rules.
- 2. <u>The Shediac Festival Arena will open no earlier than 7:00 A.M. on Saturday 31 July 2021 for Exhibitor set-up</u>. The building will be open at 7:00 a.m. daily.
- 3. To comply with the TOWN OF SHEDIAC regulations **NO SMOKING WILL BE PERMITTED WITHIN THE CONFINES OF THE BUILDING.**
- 4. NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED TO BE LEFT IN THE BUILDING OVERNIGHT.
- 5. BAIT MUST NOT BE THROWN on the conformation ring floors.
- 6. Dogs should be on standby at their respective areas 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging. Judges are not required to wait for late arrivals and will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule.
- There will be no PA system used to call dogs to the ring. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to advise that a dog is absent.
- 7. All exhibitors will be held responsible for CLEAN-UP in the Arena building, on the show grounds and surrounding areas, for their own dogs or dogs they are handling. Additionally, CLEAN-UP after your dog(s) at your motel or campground.
- PLEASE FOLLOW THIS RULE SO THAT OUR ARENA AND MOTEL PRIVILEGES ARE NOT REVOKED.
- 8. The Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. The Moncton Kennel Club will not be responsible for equipment left in the building or on site overnight.

#### <u>APPENDIX A</u> COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOL FOR MONCTON KC 2021 SHOWS

If you cannot comply with these rules Please Do Not Enter or Attend!

THERE WILL BE A ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY ON COVID-19 VIOLATIONS INCLUDING NOT WEARING A MASK OR NOT SOCIAL

DISTANCING WHEN IT IS POSSIBLE until such time as Provincial Government of New Brunswick lifts such restrictions.

WAIVER MUST BE SIGNED by Club Members, Judges, Ring Stewards, Exhibitors, Handlers, Assistants, Volunteers, Vendors, and all other persons entering the Show Venue.

Contact tracing information including names and telephone numbers must be provided for all who attend the shows on a daily basis.

Until such time as the Government of New Brunswick lifts all restrictions, the Dog Show is NOT OPEN to the General Public.

MANDATORY: MASKS MUST BE WORN correctly over mouth and nose by Exhibitors, Judges and Stewards in the rings during judging and in the ring ready area.

MANDATORY MASKS MUST ALSO BE WORN in Washrooms and in any other location where Social Distancing cannot be maintained.

MANDATORY SOCIAL DISTANCING will be required in the rings, adjacent ring areas, at the Show Secretary Table and at the Photographer's Set-up.

There will be:

Mandatory Designated RV Parking Only

Mandatory Designated Vehicle Day Parking Only

There will be No Public Catalogues. All pre-ordered Catalogues will be put in plastic and labeled with the purchaser's name. This will also be done for all Judges and Stewards.

**SHOW SITE ACCESS PROCESS**: Waiver is to be handed into the club at the door and the Contact Tracing sheet filled in upon entrance to the building by **EACH** person. Each person will be asked the Covid survey questions and asked to sanitize their hands. Each person must have their mask on correctly. An attendance wrist band will be provided at this time only.

The Club will provide hand sanitizing stations at the building entrance/exit and at all rings. There will be a Limited supply of masks in case someone needs one. Grooming tables and ramps used in the rings will be cleaned frequently.

Equipment used to measure or weigh dogs will be sanitized after each use.

There will be Limited Grooming space inside the building that will be clearly marked to maintain proper social distancing.

There are grooming rooms which will be granted to those who have the most dogs entered for a fee and on a first come, first served basis. Contact Show Superintendent Paul Oslach at poslach@rogers.com or (506) 204-8355. Handlers may have a maximum of two assistants.

Exhibitors entering the building to show their own dogs are limited to the individual showing the dog - NO assistants.

### The use of ALL forced air dryers or fans is <u>PROHIBITED</u> in the building.

Exhibitors will be granted access to the building one hour prior to their ring time. When an exhibitor who is in the general grooming area is finished showing for the day, they must leave the building, WITH ALL THEIR EQUIPMENT, so that the next group can be granted access in accordance with the Judging Schedule. Each ring will have an Entrance, an Exit and Social Distancing markers. Exhibitors will pick up their placement ribbons as they exit the ring and there will be NO RECYCLING of ribbons.

Each ring will have two ring stewards. The Entrance Steward will call the dogs in to the ring. The Exit Steward will lay out the ribbons for pick up and hand out duplicate armbands if required. EXHIBITORS SHOULD KNOW THEIR ARMBAND NUMBER BEFORE COMING.

Exhibitors are encouraged to return to their set up immediately after they have exhibited their dog.

There is to be no switching of dogs, exchanging of armbands at ringside. The original handler must stay on the dog through breed judging with the exception of handlers with multiple breed dogs and their "bubble assistants".

Frequent Hand Washing is encouraged!

Note that this protocol is subject to change depending on New Brunswick Public Health restrictions at the time of the Shows.

# ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Indoor Grooming will be limited. It is your responsibility to keep your set-up clean.

No Public Catalogue will be available. Know your numbers when picking up armbands.

No Public ex-pens.

No Public dog bathing station.

Be Self-sufficient: Bring sanitizer, personal use masks, water, chair and snacks. There will be no public seating provided.

Do Not leave personal belongings at ringside.

Do Not leave masks, gloves, water bottles, litter, etc. behind. Dispose of these items in the garbage bins provided.

Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact.

Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.

Avoid common use pens/pencils - Bring your own writing instrument.

THIS IS A SELF CLEAN SHOW. Exhibitors are to provide their own means for cleaning up after their dogs in the <u>entire facility and grounds</u> including the parking lot. There will be NO public scoops.

Bring your own shade for any set up you may wish in the parking lot.

A canteen will be run upstairs by Royal Canadian Legion - Shediac Branch #33 providing Breakfast and Lunch menu items on a "Take-Out" basis. A very limited number of socially distanced tables will be available for bubble groups on the mezzanine.

Please be respectful of the Arena Staff at all times.
