

EXHIBITION ONLY: All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competitions. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular Classes and/or Parades if provided for in the premium list.

SIRE & GET: Shall be for Sire and 2 or more of his Get. (Get MUST be entered in a regular class within this Specialty)

DAM & PROGENY: Shall be for Dam and 2 or more of her Progeny. (Progeny MUST be entered in a regular class within this Specialty)

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

This event is open to all dogs 6 months of age and under 18 months on the day of this event. All dogs MUST be entered in one of the regular classes on the day of the Specialty.

CLASSES: For judging purposes, the classes will be divided by sex as follows:

6 months & under 9 months Males/Females 9 months & under 12 months Males/Females 12 months & under 18 months Males/Females

All first place winners will compete together for the award of Best in Sweepstakes and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps

PRIZES: A rosette and 25% of total fees collected will be awarded to Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette and 20% of total fees collected will be awarded to Best Opposite Sex. A rosette and 5% of total fees collected will be awarded to first in each class. A rosette will be awarded to second through fourth place in each class.

Balance of 25% will be retained by the club to defray costs.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The Veteran Sweepstakes competition is open to all dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of this event. All dogs <u>MUST</u> be entered in one of the regular classes or for Exhibition Only.

SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THIS EVENT, BUT MUST BE ENTERED IN THE VETERANS CLASS (Competitive) OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY.

CLASSES: (divided by sex)

7 to under 10 years (Males/Females) 10 & 11 years (Males/Females) 12 years & over (Males/Females)

PRIZE LIST:

First in each class – 5% of total fees collected & Rosette Best Veteran in Sweepstakes – 25% of total fees collected & Rosette Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes – 20% of total fees collected & Rosette

A participant rosette with names and titles listed will be awarded at the end of Sweepstakes to all entrants

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility into this class shall be limited to dogs over six months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class WILL be judged upon the completion of Best in Specialty judging and prior to the unofficial classes.

Two classes ONLY will be offered as follows:

Altered Male and Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winners from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed

Championship Points will be awarded as per section 20.2, 20.8 & 20.11 of the CKC Dog Show Rules. All other requirements of section 20 are pertinent to the Altered Classes.

BEST ALTERED IN SPECIALTY

BEST OPPOSITE SEX ALTERED IN SPECIALTY

An Engraved Club Glass & Rosette will be presented to *First in each Class*A Rosette will be presented to *Second through Fourth Place in each Class*

CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered

BABY PUPPY CLASS – This class shall be for dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. (Note: dogs entered in this class DO NOT COMPETE for points). The winners of the classes will compete for the award of Best Baby Puppy in Specialty

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog **9** months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show

12 to 18 MONTH CLASS - For dogs 12 months & under 18 months on the day of this Specialty

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. **(Champions of any country excluded)**

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler <u>MUST</u> be the owner/coowner <u>AND</u> breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class <u>MAY NOT COMPETE</u> in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

ADDITIONAL REGULAR SPECIALTY CLASSES

The following additional regular classes will be offered at this Specialty:

VETERANS CLASS - For dogs 7 years of age and older on the day of this Show. Dogs entered in this class DO NOT COMPETE FOR POINTS (This class will be divided into 3 age divisions – 7 to 9 yrs, 10 & 11 yrs and 12+ yrs. Winners of each class will carry through to compete for Best of Breed) PLEASE NOTE: SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS MAY COMPETE IN THIS CLASS

BEST OF BREED WINNER WILL BE AWARDED THE HANK KAARTINEN PERPETUAL TROPHY. THE PERPETUAL TROPHY IS RETAINED BY THE CLUB, AND THE WINNER WILL RECEIVE A KEEPER TROPHY AND A ROSETTE & PRIZE.



Reserved grooming - again, offered at NO CHARGE! Due to the anticipated large entry, the club is reserving a portion of the building for pre-assigned grooming spaces. Individuals, or groups of individuals with a minimum of 6 dogs may request space. This will be on a first come, first served basis. If you are coming with a large number of dogs, PLEASE request grooming in advance, rather than expecting to be accommodated at the last minute!!

Once the allotted area has been filled, all further requests will be returned as will any requests received after the close of entries.

In addition to the pre-assigned areas, there will also be regular first come, first served grooming space in which equipment/dogs may be left for the duration of the shows. There will also be an area that will be set aside for Day of Show grooming - this will be first come, first serve and all equipment MUST BE REMOVED after Best in Show each night. There will be **NO** exercise pens allowed in this area. Any equipment left in DAY OF SHOW grooming after Best in Show will be removed by the club or one of it's delegates. Please note: Exercise pens in all areas except Day of Show Grooming (no pens permitted in this area) **may** be restricted to 1 pen per 3 entered dogs, depending on the size of the entry.

Specialty clubs will be given a 10' x 15' UPON request. This can be increased depending on the breed and number of entries. Please make your request as soon as possible.

Grooming areas will be monitored by the club and delegated individuals - exhibitors who do not keep their areas clean, or abuse the space allotted, may be asked to leave the show.

Renaissance is pleased to provide the reserved grooming at no charge to the exhibitors

I (we) agree to hold the Renaissance Dog Association. their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.
