Discipline re Indignities

As per CKC Draft Test Rules and Regulations, Section 17.7: it shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, steward, volunteer or competitor at a Draft Dog test is not subject to indignities. The Draft Dog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO TEST SITE:

From Ottawa:

take Hwy 417 west, exit at #7 Toronto/Carleton Place;

Continue on #7 to Perth, turn right on #511 (set of lights just past the Wendy's); take #511 to the end; turn left on Pinegrove Rd., turn right on George street, continue through village (less than 1km) turn left on Robertson Rd (small public school on right); take Robertson Road to Forbes Rd, (you will pass Ambulance stn & Health Centre on right/ lumber yard on left – just past this on the left is Forbes rd.) take Forbes Rd to #350 (Forbes road will change from pavement to gravel – a small Swiss Flag will be hanging out of mail box)

From Toronto:

Take #7 Hwy to Perth; turn right on #511 (goes to Calabogie), take #511 to the end; turn left on Pinegrove Rd., turn right on George street, continue through village (less than 1km) turn left on Robertson Rd (small public school on right); take Robertson Road to Forbes Rd, (you will pass Ambulance stn & Health Centre on right/ lumber yard on left – just past this on the left is Forbes rd.) take Forbes Rd to #350 (Forbes road will change from pavement to gravel – a small Swiss Flag will be hanging out of mail box)

General Information and Test Rules:

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules Pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Draft Test Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club (Tel: 416-675-5511)

As per the Draft Dog Test Rules and Regulations, the group option as stated in Section 11.2, is not offered at this test.

To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching the Test Secretary after the official closing date as published in the premium list or after the maximum number of entries has been received.

No Entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are shown thereon. Incomplete entries will be returned.

No Entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fee. Telephone, fax and e-mail entries cannot be accepted.

Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Cancellations of any entry after the closing day are prohibited.

The Club reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC Rules.

Identification and judging schedules will be e-mailed as soon as possible after **entries close.**

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all purebred CKC recognized & CKC Miscellaneous breed dogs Eighteen months of age or older on the day of the event. Every Dog Entered must be one of the following: Registered with the CKC; have an Event Registration Number (ERN); eligible for registration with the CKC or have a Performance Event Number (PEN). Entries in the Draft Dog Excellent Test must have a CKC Draft Dog (DD) Title. Entries in the Brace Draft Dog Excellent Test must have a CKC Brace Draft Dog (BDD) Title. The Judges must excuse a dog at any time during a Test for lack of physical capacity.

ENTRY LIMIT: There is a limit of a combination of 10 Draft Dogs/10 Brace Draft Dogs and 5 Draft Dog Excellent/5 Brace Draft Dog Excellent entries which will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

ENTRIES: Entries must be complete, signed & submitted on the official CKC entry form. The order of competing shall be the order that entries are received except that dogs handled by the same person will be separated when possible. No delays will be permitted for handlers entering more than one dog and entrants doing so must have an alternate handler available for the group down exercise if a conflict arises. Re-qualifications will be accepted pending space available. Re-qualifications shall be judged as the last team in the section for which they are entered. After the closing date, mail, email, fax and/or telephone of their entry will notify all entries.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season are allowed to compete but all exercises will be judged after all other dogs have been tested. Bitches in season must be kept away from the test site prior to testing.

EQUIPMENT: Each entrant to supply his or her own equipment and apparatus. The test committee will supply the freight load. DDX Entrants must provide their own backpacks and backpack weight.

TEST REGULATIONS: All dogs entered in the Draft Dog Test must go through the basic control exercise, regardless of obedience titles held.

ENTRIES CLOSE: 6:00 p.m. Thursday, October 3, 2013 or when the limit as outlined on front of this premium list is reached, even if official closing date for entries has not arrived. If combination of DDX/BDDX entries has not been received by the closing date these openings may be filled with additional DD/BDD entries. Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date. If the limit is reached prior to closing date, a list of alternates will be kept to fill any vacancies created due to early (prior to closing) cancellations. Entry fees will be refunded within 10 days following the Test to all withdrawals replaced by an alternate and to all alternates and re-qualifications that did not participate in the test. Email confirmation of receipt of entry will be provided to entrants who provide a valid, legible email address on their entry form.

FOREIGN BORN/OWNED DOGS: A dog not individually registered with the CKC may be entered at a test held under these regulations as a "Listed" dog, provided it has an event registration number (ERN) or obtains this from the CKC within 30 days of the first test entered otherwise scores will be cancelled. NON-MEMBER: Non CKC Member Participation Fee - Canadian Residents Only As of April, 2011: the CKC has instituted a Non-Member Participation fee for all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event, but are not CKC members. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. This applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members resident in Canada, and does not apply to U.S. exhibitors nor to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member.
