**Premium RV Camping Sites** with power hookups \$55/night (will be numbered & assigned before the gates open)

- We have a limited number of camping sites with power. They will be available on a first booked/paid basis.
- All bookings for premium spots must be for a minimum of 4 nights (Wednesday through Sunday, May 20 to May 24) but can be extended to include Monday night May 25<sup>th</sup> (**for an additional cost**).

**Regular RV Camping Sites without power - \$40/night** (first come, first serve): Campers will be parked as you arrive so if you want to camp together it is best to arrive together otherwise we can't guarantee our ability to hold a space next to you for your friend.

**Day Tenting - \$20/day** - sites will be approximately 10'x20' ;sites will be marked for pop up & one vehicle **ONLY**; pop up and any other equipment/items may be left overnight at exhibitor's risk.

Day vehicle parking will be available at no charge, in designated area only.

All reservations for overnight camping and day tenting will be made directly with the Show Chair (Candice Little) by email at [tlakelabs@gmail.com](mailto:tlakelabs@gmail.com) . Please include the dates you are reserving, whether you want premium or regular camping, the type of RV you have, and the length. These reservations will be accepted in the order they are received. Payment in full (via etransfer) will be required once successful entry to the show is confirmed. Failure to pay within 24 hours of entries being confirmed or the show closing will result in your reservation being cancelled.

**Quiet time is 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. – generators may not be operated during these hours**  
**Jack plates will be required, as well as platforms for generators, to preserve the grounds.**  
**Please ensure your generator exhaust does not compromise the neighbouring RV's.**

NOTE: All overnight campers will be expected to provide a \$50 deposit when they enter the grounds and, provided you have left your site in good shape, we will return your \$50 as you check out and leave the grounds. This can be in the form of cash or a cheque made out to the Lakes District Kennel Club.

**Conformation Benching:** Limited spaces available inside the Arena – \$60.00 each for the weekend for a 10' by 10' space

## BEST OWNER-HANDLED DOG IN GROUP AND SHOW

The handler of the dog must be the owner of record or a direct family member. The owner must show the dog at all levels of competition. This competition is open to non-professionals only. Anyone who has handled dogs in a professional capacity in the past 2 years is not eligible to participate.

There are no additional fees for this event. Participants do not need to pre-register but the dogs must be entered in a regular conformation class.

**DATE: SATURDAY MAY 23, 2026 SHOW #5 ONLY JUDGE SHAWN NICHOLS**

**TIME: Following Puppy in Group and Puppy in Show**

Owner-Handled competition is an unofficial class. Participants do not need to pre-register but will need to inform the ring steward following the breed judging that they are the owner. The handler of the dog must be the owner for the classes. Only owner-handled dogs that receive a Best of Breed ribbon are eligible to compete in the Best Owner Handled Dog in Group. The winner of BOH in breed may compete in BOH in Group unless the dog was already defeated at the Best in Group level, by another owner-handled dog. The winner of BOH in Group will compete in BOH in Show after the completion of Best Puppy in Show unless the dog was already defeated, at the Best in Show level, by another owner-handled dog that is entered in this competition.

## **CONFORMATION CLASSES**

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex.

### **REGULAR CLASSES**

**JUNIOR PUPPY** - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

**SENIOR PUPPY**- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

**12-18 MONTH CLASS** - for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show

**CANADIAN BRED** - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR** - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

**OPEN CLASS** - shall be for all Dogs.

**SPECIALS ONLY** - This class will NOT be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for "Specials Only" and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be cancelled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

**EXHIBITION ONLY** - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

### **NON-REGULAR CLASSES**

**BABY PUPPY** -3 months & under 6 months on the day of the show

**VETERANS CLASS** - In this optional class for All Breed Shows, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. The awards for this class are: Best Male Veteran and Best Female Veteran Best Veteran in Breed Best Veteran in Group Best Veteran in Show A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Breed is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Group. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Group is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Show.

## **OBEDIENCE CLASSES**

---

**PRE-NOVICE** – shall be for any dog which has not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person.

**NOVICE "A"** - The Novice A class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has not earned the title of CD. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families, and must be eligible to handle under Section No person who has exhibited a dog that has earned a CDX title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled

**NOVICE "B"** - The Novice B class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has not earned the title of CD. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all seven (7) exercises unless he has two (2) or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B class at any one trial.

**NOVICE "C"** class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title CD or any higher obedience titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one (1) dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all six (6) exercises unless he has two (2) or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice C class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice C class are not eligible for High in Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title. Dogs may be entered in the Novice C class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible

**INTERMEDIATE NOVICE** - as per Obedience Trial Rules & Regulation

**OPEN "A"**- The Open A class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CD but has not earned the title of CDX. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. Only one (1) dog per handler is allowed in this class and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has exhibited a dog that has earned an OTCH title may not handle a dog in this class. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

**OPEN "B"** - The Open B class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CD. Dogs that have earned the title of CDX or any higher obedience titles may enter in the Open B class. A dog may also be entered in the Utility class in the same trial. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one (1) dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all seven (7) exercises. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six (6) numbered routines is to be performed. These choices will not be disclosed to exhibitors until they are posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of each class and never more than one hour before the start of the trial. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six (6) routines so they will be used approximately the same number of times.

---

**UTILITY “A”** – The Utility A class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CDX but has not earned the title of OTCH. Any person who has exhibited a dog that has earned a MOTCH title may not handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. Owners may enter more than one (1) dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

**UTILITY “B”** – The Utility B class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CDX or OTCH. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one (1) dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six (6) numbered routines will be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class and never more than one hour before the start of the trial. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six (6) routines so that each will be used approximately the same number of times

## **RALLY CLASSES**

**RALLY NOVICE A-** Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (RN) **Obedience** title, (earned the RN title) or any CKC (Novice) obedience title **other than PCD**. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC **Companion Dog Excellent** CDX title or **CKC RA title** (or instructed dog training classes) shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one (1) dog in this class. (A dog may continue to compete in the class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in the class. However a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.)

**No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one (1) trial.**

**RALLY NOVICE B** - Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one(1) dog in this class. (All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.)

**RALLY INTERMEDIATE** - This class shall be for dogs that have earned the RN title. A dog completing the RI or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dog in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

**RALLY ADVANCED A** - This class shall be for dogs that have earned the RN title but have not (won) **earned** the RA title or any CKC (novice) obedience title **other than PCD**. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC **Companion Dog Excellent** CDX title or **CKC RE title** shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one (1) dog in this class. (A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.)

**No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one (1) trial**

**RALLY ADVANCED B** - This class will be for dogs that have earned the RN title. A dog completing the RA title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one (1) dog in this class. (All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.)

**RALLY EXCELLENT A** - This class shall be for dogs that have (won) **earned** the RA title, but have not (won) **earned** the RE title or any CKC (novice) obedience title **other than PCD**. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC **Companion Dog Excellent** CDX title, (or instructed dog training classes) shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one (1) dog in this class. (A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from theCKC that the dog has won the title.)

**No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one (1) trial.**

**RALLY EXCELLENT B** - This class will be for dogs that have (won) **earned** the RA title. A dog completing the RE title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one (1) dog in this class. (All exercises are judged off leash except the Honour Exercise. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.)

**RALLY MASTER** - This class is for dogs that have earned the RE title. Any person may handle the dog in this class. Dogs must earn 3 qualifying scores of 85 points or more under at least 2 different judges

## **CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

15.1.10 Permission shall be granted to a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges;

(b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN);

(c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

15.1.13 The Board interprets the words “earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges” to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge’s awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

**As of July 2021, the rules for awarding of Grand Champion and Grand Champion Excellent have changed. Please see CKC Conformation Rule 15.2 Grand Champion (GCH) & 15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GCHEx) for details.**

## GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Conformation Rule book are available from the CKC, 400 200 Ronson Dr., Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9

-----

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
4. A Judge, Ring Steward, Show Secretary, Show Superintendent, or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
6. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are **PACIFIC DAYLIGHT TIME**.
7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 plus GST which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
9. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog **BEFORE** taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the ring areas.
11. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, pandemic and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
12. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
13. If you are unable to attend due to COVID or any other ailment, it is your responsibility to find an alternative handler for your dog. No refund will be given.
- 14 **LDKC has a zero tolerance** of abuse of any description involving any person involved with the LDKC shows, including spectators.

## **OTHER EXTRACTS FROM CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS**

### **SHOW OFFICIALS – SECTION 5.1.6**

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

### **ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.3**

Entry forms received by the CKC, which are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information may result in awards being cancelled.

### **ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.5**

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

### **ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1**

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- a. registered with the CKC
- b. has an Event Registration Number
- c. eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- d. with the exception of Baby Puppy, if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN)

### **REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2**

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonored cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

### **DISQUALIFICATIONS – SECTION 14.1.4**

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

### **INDIGNITIES - SECTION 19.7**

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

**NO SMOKING OR VAPING ANYWHERE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS  
OR IN THE ARENA**



**ZERO TOLERANCE** – Any individual initiating bullying tactics at the Lakes District Kennel Club Shows individuals will be asked to leave the show grounds premises immediately and for the remainder of the event (no refunds). A report will be filed with CKC and the Disciplinary Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit. Including and not limited to suspension from attending the event for a specific period of time in the future, including permanently.

**Definition of Bullying:** *Refers to a range of behaviors in which targeted individuals are repeatedly, and over time, treated in a mean, insulting or abusive way. Bullying can be initiated deliberately or unconsciously. The affected person may feel upset, afraid, isolated, or humiliated. The bully sometimes acts alone and sometimes as part of a group of people.*

*Examples include:*

- *insulting a person's skills, looks, or habits*
- *spreading false or malicious rumors, gossip, or innuendo*
- *berating/belittling an individual*
- *unwarranted criticizing or ridiculing, especially in the presence of others*
- *giving insulting nicknames*
- *engaging in practical jokes that humiliate*
- *undermining or deliberately impeding a person's work*
- *physical gesturing that intimidates, offends, degrades, or humiliates*
- *mocking a person's accent, abilities or mannerisms*
- *yelling or shouting which intimidates, coerces, or belittles*
- *intruding on a participant's privacy by pestering, spying or stalking*
- *physically abusing or threatening abuse*
- *criticising a participant persistently*
- *constantly belittling a person's opinions.*

This applies to interpersonal and electronic communications, such as email, Facebook, text messaging, Twitter and Instagram.
