NEW VENUE - Athens, ON is a township in the united townships of Leeds and Grenville in Eastern Ontario Canada. It is located approximately 25 kilometres (16 mi) north of the St. Lawrence River, near Brockville, west of Addison, and about 90 kilometres (56 mi) south west of Ottawa.

Originally known as Farmersville, Athens was settled by Benoni Wiltse, a United Empire Loyalist, and his brothers in 1792. The town was renamed to Athens in 1888 by Arza Parish in honour of Athens, Greece, due to its status as an educational centre. Today, Athens is known for its large outdoor murals depicting historical local life, painted on the sides of various buildings.

The Township of Athens is part of the region's heartland and is also famous for its lakes and cottage country. Charleston Lake is the jewel of the area, attracting boating, fishing and water sport enthusiasts. Athens, Ontario, hosts a summer fair called "Cornfest" on the 3rd Saturday of August annually, celebrating the harvest of corn. Another annual event is the "Farmersville Exhibition", also known as "Steam Fair", which celebrates the town's agricultural heritage with displays of steam engines and antique tractors.

The Township of Athens has all the amenities of a larger community, but with a small-town atmosphere and strong agricultural roots. It boasts restaurants, a liquor store, grocery stores, hardware and much more.

Athens has much to offer and TIKO is so grateful to be able to utilize Athens Arena 76 and Centennial Park for our annual weekend of shows and trials this year

Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. GENERAL RULES

1. Site will accept dogs and equipment after 4:00 pm. Thursday.
1. Exhibitors must vacate the site 1 hour after Best in Show on Sunday.
2. In Transit area available.
3. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept entries reaching the Show Secretary after the official closing date as published in this premium list.
4. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are shown thereon. **INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY ENTRY FEES.**
5. TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.
6. DIANA EDWARDS SHOW SERVICES, reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to C.K.C. Dog Show Rules.
7. Acknowledgement of Entry and judging schedule will be mailed as soon as possible after entries close.
8. The person accompanying the dog must show Acknowledgement of Entry before the dog is allowed in the show and, unless a dog is entered officially, it will not be allowed in the show precincts, with the exception of dogs to be kept in the "In Transit" area. Show Precincts are the whole Memorial Centre building proper plus anything within ten feet of the outdoor rings.
9. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is scheduled for judging.
10. D.E.S.S. and the T.I.K.O. Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
11. Conflicts between Dog Show Rules and New Breed Standards. The Board of Directors of the CKC has ruled that, where there is a conflict between the Breed Standards and the Dog Show Rules the Dog Show Rules will take precedence.
12. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entry was made. Changes or cancellation of any entry after closing date is prohibited.
13. If, because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
14. To avoid noise and confusion, there will be no individual dogs called to the ring by loud-speaker. Delays waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.
15. We will have someone clean up during the show times but remember they cannot be everywhere at once. Your co-operation in cleaning up after your dog is much appreciated.
16. By virtue of entering these shows -

SECTION 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder):

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

GRAND CHAMPION POINTS

15.2 Grand Champion (GCh) 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. 15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh

(c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points. (d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS) The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.
