GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES

ELIGIBILITY: This test is open to all purebred Dachshunds and those CKC recognized Terriers in Group IV and the Miscellaneous Class list originally bred for or developed for use as Earthdogs, small enough to fit into a 9 inch drain, as listed in Appendix A of the CKC Earthdog Test Rules & Regulations. Dogs must be aged 6 months or older.

Gate entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the start of the class unless the limit has been reached prior to that time.

DogShow.ca service fees: 10% of total fees + GST. These fees are non-refundable effective April 7, 2021.

Mail entries may be sent to the Test Secretary, please provide an email address for confirmation of entry. **Online entries close at 9:00 pm MDT September 16, 2021**. There will **not** be any drop boxes.

Cheques dated after close of entries will not be accepted.

COVID-19 REFUND POLICY: Should provincial regulations force cancellation of this event prior to the day of the test, entry fees (less processing costs) will be refunded.

ENTRIES: Entries must be complete, signed and submitted on the official CKC entry form. Entries are accepted on a first come, first served basis. Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date and time. If the limit is reached prior to the closing date, a list of alternates will be maintained to fill any vacancies created due to early (prior to closing date) cancellations. The order of competing shall be a random draw; handlers with multiple dogs in a class will have their entries separated where possible.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test. When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the test secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the test must reach the secretary on or before the date of the test. Alternatively, the bitch may be presented to a member of the test committee no later than 1 hour before the scheduled start time of the test to determine that she is in season. The trial-giving club must refund the entry fee, service charge and listing fee.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY: The receipt of entries will be confirmed for those providing a **return e-mail address** on their entry form.

QUARRY: The quarry used in these tests will be 2 adult gerbils

AWARDS & PRIZES: Qualifiers in all classes will receive a prize and ribbon.

TEST PRECINCT: The entire field east of the buildings. Dogs waiting to be tested shall be kept at least 30.5 m (100ft) from the perimeter of the test area in a designated holding area.

TEST SITE: Bring water, shade and shelter for you and your dogs. These tests will be run **rain or shine**. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the test. Flexi leads will not be allowed within the test precinct. Remember that this is private property, and we are here at the pleasure of our hosts. The test site is strictly non-smoking; if you must smoke please do so in your vehicle and dispose of your butts appropriately. On site portable washroom will be available. Clean up after yourself and your dog. As is the case with most Earthdog Tests, the ground at the site is uneven; wear appropriate footwear.

Vehicle parking is limited, please obey all parking directions. Day tents may be setup in the designated area outside of the test precinct.

WAIVER: Please complete the enclosed waiver that excludes the property owners, the Canadian Scottish Terrier Club of Canada, and/or any person associated with the Earthdog Test from any liability for personal injury or personal property damage and submit it with your entry.

REGULATIONS: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the Rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Earthdog Test Regulations are available online from the CKC.

HOSPITALITY: Due to COVID-19 health recommendations on sharing food and serving utensils, no food will be provided. Please bring your own food and drinks. The test site is conveniently located less than 5 minutes away from a gas station, a Tim Hortons and a Burger King and less than 10 minutes from Gasoline Alley which has more restaurants.

CKC Regulation 15.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an Earthdog test held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities. The Earthdog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted. If you pay by personal American cheque, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Do not write "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". This will not be acceptable and will not be cleared by the bank. To simplify the process, we urge you to purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds.

BORDER CROSSING: Government regulations require a valid rabies certificate for dogs entering Canada from countries not recognized by Canada as being rabies-free. The European Union pet passport is an acceptable alternative to the rabies vaccination certificate as long as all the elements outlined in the requirements are included. EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (FOREIGN BORN/FOREIGN OWNED DOG): For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain CKC titles, individual registration is not required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of entering first CKC event to avoid cancellation. Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of dog's foreign Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee along with the completed application form.

CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE:

(This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member, nor does it affect US exhibitors who must apply for an ERN number as noted above)

A non-member resident in Canada is subject to the fee. Dogs co-owned with a CKC member are exempt. There are 2 options for non-members:

- a) Join the CKC, or
- b) Pay the Non-Member Participation Fee

The fee is a yearly charge based on the calendar year January 1 to December 31 in which the awards, legs, points, titles, etc. were achieved. It is not based on the number of dogs or titles or awards earned, and is assessed against the owner(s).

Non-members will receive a letter from CKC Head Office informing them that they have 30 days to join the Club or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee.

Payment of the Non-Member Participation Fee or becoming a CKC member will protect all awards, points, titles and legs in the calendar year in which they were earned. Failure to pay the fee within 30 days of the notice will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being cancelled. Once cancelled the awards, legs, points or titles will be given to the next applicable dog. Once cancellation takes place any subsequent awards titles, legs, etc. earned will automatically be cancelled without further notice.

Please note that the CKC Membership application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website under CKC Services and then Forms On-Line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that CKC is aware of the dogs involved.

EARTHDOG TEST COVID-19 INFORMATION AND SAFETY MEASURES

These guidelines may be altered or amended before the test, as per current Alberta Chief Medical Officer recommendations.

- Please familiarize yourself with the latest AHS screening checklist and refer to this document before attending the tests. If you exhibit any of the listed symptoms or have been in contact with anyone who has symptoms or has travelled recently, please advise us and we will refund your entry fees (less any processing costs).
- There will be enhanced cleaning and disinfecting procedures in place during the weekend tests. Hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes and a hand wash station will be available to assist with maintaining hygiene.
- All judges, workers and handlers should use proper hand washing, be conscious of respiratory
 etiquette and avoid borrowing others equipment. The number of volunteer workers in the field
 and den areas will be limited to as few as possible.
- Spray disinfectant will be available at the porta potty. Anyone using this facility will be expected to spray down surfaces after each use to ensure this area remains as clean as possible.
- Avoid over-crowding the area around the Test Secretary during the check in process. While
 the test dog is running, be very conscious not to crowd the staging area. Please wait your
 turn and do not move to the staging area until the previous person is over 2 metres away.
 Practice physical distancing, where possible.
- Please pick up after your dog, especially in any parking and day tent areas and around the test precinct and keep your dogs on leash. Be sure to pick up and take ALL your belongings at the end of the tests; it is imperative that personal items not be left behind.
- If you have any questions or concerns, these can be directed to the Test Secretary or CSTC Test Committee members.



From the QE2 Highway, head north or south towards Red Deer and take Exit 384 for Highway 42 East (turnoff for Penhold/Pine Lake). Turn east toward Pine Lake, then take your first right and head south on the Service Road (RR273A) that runs parallel to the QE2 Highway. Drive for approximately 2.3 km and turn left into the driveway.
