I bred multi- BIS, BISS winning Siberian Huskies and have bred Shetland Sheepdogs. I owned Chows in the past and currently breed and own Labrador Retrievers including the number one Labrador retriever in 2016. We also pursue Field titles on our Labradors. I am a grooming salon owner by trade and handled all breeds. I have judged in Canada, the USA, Australia, China, Spain and Japan including specialties and National Specialties. I am licensed by the CKC to judge all Breeds.

### **BREEDER SWEEPSTAKES**

Designed to be a show case of the breeder's finest specimens. This Sweepstake is open to all champions and non-champions alike who must be entered in a regular class in this show at the appropriate entry fee. In this Sweepstake the breeder or co-breeder must handle the dog in the ring, but the dog need not be owned by the breeder or co-breeder. A first and second place will be awarded.

The first place winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes.

The second place winner to Best in Sweepstakes will then compete for Reserve Best in Sweepstakes.

Rosettes will be awarded for First and Second place in both males and females.

75% of the total entry fees will be divided as follows:

25% to be divided equally between the two first place winners; 20% to be divided equally between the two second place winners  
A Rosette and 20% will be awarded to Best in Sweepstakes; A rosette and 10% will be awarded to the Reserve Best in Sweepstakes

**Show precincts shall be within 50 feet of the designated Specialty ring**

**SPECIAL BREEDER AWARDS:** The Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever Club of Canada is pleased to offer a special rosette to recognize the breeder of purebred dogs. A green rosette will be awarded to the breeder of the dogs awarded Best of Breed and Best Puppy in Breed

The **Fair Dinkum Toller Award** is sponsored by Kirchoff, Lidliva and Fionavar Kennels. The trophy itself is Australian White Cedar with brass plates. Each year the award is presented, a plate will be added with the names of the winning Toller and Handler team. Dog/Handler must compete over the days of the Specialty earning points in Obedience, Conformation and Working Tests. Points to be awarded, with the Dog/Handler team obtaining the highest number of points to be the winner.

**FIELD DOG CLASS DESCRIPTION** – Dogs entered in this class must have attained a title or placement in a field trial or test. This class is to be judged prior to Best of Breed judging with winners of each sex competing for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

**GUN DOG CLASS DESCRIPTION** – This unofficial Class is for all Retrievers who have earned a Certificate of Merit or better at a Licensed Field Trial, or who have received a Junior Hunter Title or higher, a Working Certificate of higher, in Canada or the United States by the close of entries. Each dog must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only.
