Owners are responsible for entering the correct height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their correct division will be eliminated. Judges may require any dog to be measured.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

- The precinct of the trials shall be the ring enclosure and the surrounding parking area.
- Only dogs entered for competition will be permitted in the precinct of the trials.
- The trials will be held outside on a grass surface. The courses will be set up within a fenced enclosure of 70' by 145'. A PVC swinging entrance and exit gate will enclose the ring.
- No provisions have been made for rain or sun bring your chair and protection from the weather for yourself and your dog. Water is not available at the site for cooling your dog.
- Please do not litter. Use the designated area for your dog, then clean up.
- Dogs must be under control at all times and kept on a leash except in the warm-up area and on the course.
- No food or other device will be allowed on the course. The dog may wear a well-fitted plain buckle collar, quick release collar or no collar on the course (note: no tags or decorations are permitted on the collar).
- The competitors participate at this event at their own risk. The release on the entry form must be signed.
- All obstacles will conform to CKC specifications.
- The Flat-coated Retriever Society of Canada reserves the right to refuse entries, subject to CKC rules.
- There will be no contact familiarization for Novice dogs.
- Electronic timing will not be used.
- The wall jump and broad jump will not be used.

ALL PARTICIPANTS are asked to assist by volunteering to help when they are not running their dog(s). Please complete the volunteer form so we can slot you in at appropriate time(s). If everyone volunteers, you will only be requested to pitch in minimally. Thank you.

CKC Agility Miscellaneous rule changes:

- A dog entered in Selected division may not move into Regular division at a later date. Dogs can no longer run in two divisions.
- Movement from Regular to Selected divisions is allowed.
- ❖ PAD –This strategic game involves a point gathering component and a distance element.
- Now positionless table performance with a continual table count.
- Weave poles in all Novice Classes.
- A-frame at 5 feet for dogs jumping 12" or less.
- Mixed or unrecognized breed dogs are allowed to participate in the CKC Performance Events of Agility, Obedience, and Rally Obedience Trials effective July 1, 2014, with CCN.

Performance Event Number (PEN) / Canine Companion Number (CCN)

A PEN allows an unregisterable dog of a CKC recognized breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. A CCN allows mixed breed dogs to participate in competitive events. A dog that is eligible for a PEN or a CCN may not be entered with a TCN. Events may only be entered after PEN/CCN has been issued. Please note that fees are due and payable as listed above. Discounted cheques will not be accepted. Cheques in US funds are accepted for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded. Please do not mark cheques "payable in Canadian funds" or "at par".

CONDUCT: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Accommodations Accepting Dogs - Check with the Trial Secretary if accommodations suggestions are needed.

Refunds are for bitches in season only. *Bitches in season* may NOT compete. When a bitch comes in season after entries have closed, a veterinarian's certificate verifying she was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial must reach the trial secretary on or before the start of the trial. A full refund of entry fees and listing fees will be given.
