TEST SITE: No indoor kenneling. These tests will be run rain or shine. All dogs must be under control and on a leash (off leash searches may be permitted). NO non-trial odour is permitted on the trial grounds. No warm up area will be offered.

This is a family run business facility. Clean up after yourself and your dog, failure to do so will be immediate expulsion from the event.

We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. However, this venue is not entirely wheelchair accessible. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club by contacting the show secretary prior to entry to determine if we can accommodate your needs.

Washroom facilities are available indoors but are not wheelchair accessible.

PARTICIPANT ILLNESS: Any handler unable to attend these trials due to exhibiting COVID-19 or other serious illness symptoms after entries close must contact the trial secretary so they may try to fill the available spaces. If those spaces are filled you may receive a refund, if spaces cannot be filled you will forfeit your entry.

DAY OF TRIAL ENTRIES: Day of trial entries will be accepted if space allows and must be submitted prior to the judges briefing. Day of entries shall be \$40.00 per component and only cash or e-transfer will be accepted on the day of the trial. A rosette may not be guaranteed for day-of trial entries but will be provided at the next available opportunity. Move ups within the same trial ie: Novice to Open are not permitted.

ENTRIES MUST BE PAID IN FULL. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. The owner of a dog entered in this Trial is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

REFUNDS: Fees will not be refunded after closing date for any reason other than a bitch being in season. If for any reason, APWDC has to cancel the trial prior to the closing date, all entry fees will be refunded.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone, but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show. Refunds will only be guaranteed for bitches in season as per CKC rules.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test.

ROSETTES & PRIZES: Flat ribbons will be given for all qualifying scores. Rosettes for titles will be available, the day of the trial or shortly thereafter, depending on the number of titles earned. Additional door or draw prizes may be offered at the time of trial. To celebrate breed participation the APWDC will be offering Breed Booster prizes to all Portuguese Water Dogs entered into the Sunday Sept 17 trial.

ELIGIBILITY: Purebred, unrecognised or mixed-breed dogs may compete

Every dog entered in an approved event must be one of the following:

a) Registered with the CKC

- b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN)
- c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN)
- d) Eligible for registration with the CKC, and have a **Temporary Competition Number (TCN)
- e) Mixed breeds must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN)

To be eligible to compete at approved trials or sanctioned matches a dog must meet the requirements of Section 6.1.1, and:

- a) Must be at least 6 months of age.
- b) May be spayed, neutered, or debarked.
- c) Must not be lame (judge reserves final determination on lameness).
- d) Must not compete if it has tape or bandages that may impair its working ability (such a dog must be immediately excused and under no circumstances may it be returned later for judging after the tape or bandages have been removed).
- **NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE/TCN Number: The CKC requires all owners of unregistered, recognized breeds entering events to obtain a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). TCNs will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

If a dog is not registered individually in the records of the CKC, it may be entered at a trial held under these rules with a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), providing that the number is obtained before the closing date of entries. Once the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will no longer be valid. While there is no fee for the Temporary Competition Number, exhibitors will still be required to pay listing fees (\$10.50) when entering events. The request for a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors should go to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly. Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

IMMUNISATION: The CKC Rules and Regulations for shows, trials and tests, with some exceptions, have explicit rules to minimise the transmission of communicable diseases. A dog may not be entered or exhibited at a show, trial or test if it has any communicable disease. Dogs entered in a show, trial or test must be able to provide proof of current immunisation status.

HANDLERS WITH MULTIPLE DOGS: Handlers with multiple dogs will be permitted to enter a maximum of two dogs in the same class / components. I.e.: Two novice dogs handled by the same person can be entered in the same Novice components at the same trial. **The hides in any level will be reset only once.**

CKC REGULATION: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial- giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred."

GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES FROM THE CKC SCENT DETECTION RULES & REGULATIONS:
