When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the test secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the test, must reach the secretary on or before the date of the test. The test-giving club must refund the entry fee, service charge and listing fee. See Bitches in Heat below.

MOVE UPS: Move ups are permissible one (1) hour before the event or immediately upon completion of a level.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY: The receipt of entries will be confirmed for those providing a return e-mail address on their form.

QUARRY: The quarry used in these tests will be two rats or two gerbils.
