Please have photo ID and your original printed vaccination receipt or digital version ready to present when checking in and receiving your armband. We will not be recording any personal information.

No Lunch will be available on site. Pop and bottled water will be available.

Competitors will familiarize themselves with the CKC COVID-19 Obedience and Rally Rules General Guidelines released July 31, 2020. These are allowable temporary changes to Obedience & Rally Obedience Rules and Regulations that a Club may opt to use during their event under COVID restrictions. Changes may be adopted on the Event Day after consultation between the Trial Officials and the Judge.

Day-of-Trial Entries: There will be NO Day-Of Entries **Move-ups:** A dog that fulfills the requirements for a title in accordance with the rules during the first Trial of the day may move to the next level of competition for the second Trial. The transfer must be on the appropriate move-up form and submitted to the Trial Secretary by the owner or handler 30 minutes before the start of the Class.

Important Information for Exhibitors

In order to make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, The Poodle Farm has a few rules:

1. No outdoor shoes allowed on the turf indoors.

Please ensure you bring a clean, dry pair of indoor only shoes.

- 2. Do NOT arrive before 9am. There will be no admittance to the property before that time.
- 3. Only park in the designated area. Physical distancing between vehicles. There will be signage.
- 4. Dogs must be on a leash at all times except when competing in the ring. No "Flexi" lines allowed on the property.
- 5. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs 'faces', give other dogs the room they may require.
- 6. Please pick up after your dog's waste. Please pick up after yourself. There are waste containers for your trash.
- 7. Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum.
- 8. No smoking, vaping or Cannabis anywhere on the property.
- 9. Per CKC rules, only dogs officially entered and competing are permitted within the Trial Precincts. There is no "Exhibition Only" class being offered at this trial.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the ring area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Notes to Competitors – Special COVID Information

Due to ongoing concerns with the coronavirus disease, we are asking for your cooperation to limit the possible spread of the disease, and ensure an environment which is safe and comfortable for all participants.

Please do not participate if you answer "Yes" to any of the following in the 14 days prior to the trial:

- Are you experienced any fever, cough, or have difficulty breathing?
- Have you returned from the US or other International destinations?
- Have you been contact traced to a COVID-19 case?
- Have you had close contact with a person with acute respiratory illness who has been outside Canada?

Special Measures and Instructions:

- Face Masks/Face Coverings are required in all indoor spaces. Masks or face coverings are strongly recommended in all outdoor spaces when 2m physical distancing cannot be reasonably assured, and should be worn in proximity to the building entrance or information boards. Your cooperation and understanding are appreciated.
- Indoor shoes will be mandatory as usual from the time you enter the building until you leave.
- Queueing—one in the ring, one warming up in the adjacent warm up area, one waiting in the adjacent room putting on indoor shoes, with remaining teams maintaining 2.4m physical distancing outside.
- Please park so as to adhere to social distancing. Individual parking spots will be marked for your convenience.
- There will be no indoor crating. Please crate from your vehicle while you are here for the trial. Pop-up tents are permitted on grassy areas and may be used for dogs provided the dogs are quiet and securely contained in crates/X-pens. All shade structures must be spaced to permit physical distancing.
- To facilitate social distancing, we ask that you do not bring friends, children, spouses or others unless you need them to provide mobility assistance at the trial.
- All notices and information will be posted outside the building on a bulletin board, feel to take a picture with your phone.
- All briefings will be done outside the building
- No special area will be set aside for reactive dogs.
- Unfortunately we will not allow spectators in the building and we will not allow additional people to video your runs indoors. Handlers may set-up a video recording device to record their run prior to entering the Ring..
- Ribbons are not self-service; we will make every effort to have ribbons and scoresheets available as quickly as possible. Please bring an envelope with your name that we can put your ribbons and scoresheets in after results are announced.
- We encourage you to leave the facility promptly when you are done for the day.
- No lunch will be served. Pop and bottled water will be available.

Health, Sanitization & Trial Workers:

- We will have a team member cleaning all "touch" areas during the day
- The restroom attached to the garage will be the only facility available to competitors.
- Paper towels, soap, and hand sanitizer is available.
