IMPORTANT NOTE FOR EXHIBITORS / PATRONS

- 1. Entry Limit 90 Runs (includes Instinct Testing, Novice, Open Runs – Maximum 25 Instinct Tests).
- 2. One dog per handler per class.
- 3. The Dartmouth Kennel Club respectfully asks that no posting of testing be placed on social media until end of Trial.
- 4. The only dog permitted in trial area is dog being tested; no dogs allowed with spectators.
- 5. No Prong Collars.
- 6. No internal kennelling. All dogs must be under control on a leash except during the test.

To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the closing time and date.

All entry fees must be in the hands of our Show Secretary prior to closing date.

Personal cheques and money orders for full value only will be accepted and must be made payable to the Dartmouth Kennel Club.

No post-dated cheques accepted. All NSF cheques and declined credit cards will be subject to a charge of \$40.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the trial.

A copy of the Rules pertaining to Dog Shows and Trials are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

All entries paid by credit card MUST be sent via DogShow.ca. No other entry service is authorized to accept entries for these events. The Dartmouth Kennel Club does not accept credit cards for payment.

Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes

It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules & regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails, will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)

No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. Eligibility to Compete – If a dog is not registered individually in the records of the CKC, it may be entered at a trial held under those rules with a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), providing that the number is obtained before the closing date of entries. Once the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will no longer be valid. While there is no fee for the TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay listing feels (\$11.50) when entering events. The request for a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors should go to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly. Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

RIBBONS & ROSETTES

A Rosette will be awarded to all Novice and Open new titles. Only those dogs earning qualifying scores will receive a Ribbon.

A suitable Ribbon will be provided to dogs earning their Instinct Test.

(MOVE-UPS WILL BE PERMITTED IF MADE 15 MINS BEFORE START OF CLASS)

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the event that will be governed by CKC rules.

2. Judging schedules will be sent as soon as possible after the Closing Date.

3. The Dartmouth Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.

4. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

5. All exhibitors will be responsible for clean up on the grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs and/or dogs they are handling.

6. Precinct incudes entire property.

7. A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)

8. No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)

9. **Bitches in season** shall not be eligible to enter the test (please see refunds/duplicate entries - #10 General Information).

10. There will be no refunds on duplicate entries or overpayments: Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in Scent Detection comes into season after the close of entries if a Veterinarian's Certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Show Secretary before the starting date and the time of the trial.
