## Judge Biographies



**Virginia Lyne – CKC All Breed Judge**

I started exhibiting in 1953 with an American Cocker (black) and acquired my first English Cocker from the UK in 1960. In 1968 I was approved to judge all Obedience classes and in 1969 began Conformation judging with approval to judge sporting breeds. I completed All breed status in 1979. I have been actively breeding and exhibited English Cockers and Pembroke Welsh Corgis with a close involvement of Whippets and a Pekingese. Judging has taken me to so many countries and amazing life experiences.

I have been privileged to judge on every Continent where there are dog shows. I feel very lucky to have been part of the dog show scene at its time of the great shows with large, challenging entries. Though I no longer am judging regularly it is indeed an honour to be invited to judge General Specials for this Anniversary show of the Evelyn Kenney Kennel Club.

May you all enjoy this auspicious occasion.



**Tiina Taulos – All breed judge from Finland**

I am Tiina Taulos, allrounder-judge from Finland. I got my first show dog, a black medium Poodle in 1977. I am a long time breeder of all sizes of Poodles in black, brown and white with prefix Canmoy's and celebrated 40 years as a breeder in 2021. I was awarded Lauri Vuolasvirta Prize for the highest recognition of dog breeding for Medium Poodles by the Finnish Kennel Club in 1989.

Boston Terriers came to my life in 2005 and was awarded Lauri Vuolasvirta Prize for the 2nd time in 2018.

I also love and live with Pugs which I have bred few litters. In French Bulldogs I am the first breed specialist in my country. I am also a breed specialist in Affen Pinschers and Miniature Dachshunds, have a family history with Wire Fox Terriers, Westies, Jack Russel Terriers and been co-breeder in those breeds. I have bred about 300 individual champions in different breeds.

I am quite active in the Finnish dog scene being a Board member of The Finnish Toy Dog Club in which my role is educating and examining new Toy breed judges and also new Poodle judges. During Covid-19 time and after I have been giving breed webinars to foreign Kennel Club's judges. I am a member at the Finnish Kennel Club Council representing Finnish Poodle Club.

I have been awarded a Silver decoration by the Finnish Kennel Club, by the Finnish Poodle Club and by the Finnish Dog Breeder's Club. I have judged in nearly 50 different countries, including European Winner and World Dog Shows.



#### **Dr. Tamás Jakkel – All breed judge from Hungary**

I born in a perfect family with one single exception: we had no dogs. In my age of 5 I started to ask my parents to have an English cocker spaniel. I started my connection with the breed in my age of 12. Ever since I've bred or owned 34 World-and European Winners under my prefix „Black Mirage”. Some years later I joined to the already World renowned Smooth-haired Dachshund kennel „vom Golf” and „mini Golf” of which I am the owner nowadays. We bred over 50 World/European Winners and over 150 FCI International Champions under this prefix. I also used to have a European Winner Medium Poodle and in the last decade my family became strongly attached to the Magyar Agár having bred several World and European Winners in this magnificent breed under the prefix „ ILLA-Berek”.

Being dedicated besides my private life - of being a Chief Surgeon, Clinical Oncologist, later on a teaching Professor at the Medical University - I took my part of the dog-related administration at my very early age. I was the President of the Hungarian Spaniel Association for 24 years, still being its Board member. I was the President of the Magyar Agár Section of the parent Club of the breed (Hungarian Sighthound). I was a member of the Hungarian Kennel Club's Board for many years before.

I became an FCI judge in 1985., an all-rounder in 2001. I am the President of the Hungarian Kennel Club's Judges' Board since 2001. I have judged in over 80 countries of 5 Continents including the largest FCI, CKAC, and UK Kennel Club Shows.

As long as my activity quickly became an International one I also had been involved in the FCI. I was a Board member of the FCI European Section for many years since its establishment later on I was its Vice-President. I also had been the Vice-President of the FCI Judges' Commission. I resigned from both of these functions when I was elected as the member of the FCI General Committee in 2009. I am the Board's representative in both the FCI Show Commission and the Show Judges Commission ever since. As the recognition of my work I have been awarded the FCI Golden Pin by the President of the FCI. In 2017. I was also the representative of the FCI Board in the FCI Show and Show Judges Commission.

In 2017. I became a member of the FCI Executive Committee as its Treasurer The FCI General Assembly elected me as the President of the FCI in 2019. and I was re-elected this year during the FCI General Assembly in Madrid.



#### **Jussi Liimatainen – All breed judge from Finland**

I was born into a family with Samoyeds and Huskies. I started dog shows in the 1980's with an uncle who was a dogshow judge. My first own dog was a Cocker Spaniel, then Welsh Springers and American Cocker came to my life. I lived in a city and was not able to have several dogs at home, so I started to show other peoples' dogs from all groups. I won my first all-breed BIS in 1988 with Tibetan Spaniel and 1989 with Norwich Terrier owned by late Hans Lehtinen and Johan Juslin. Until I started my judge's education, I was a successful handler.

I have owned or bred English Cocker Spaniel, Welsh Springer Spaniels, American Cocker Spaniels, Shetland sheepdog, Siberian Husky, Pomeranians, Bichon Frises, Löwchens, Papillons, Chinese Crested, and Maltese. Pomeranian is the breed I am most well-known for, I have owned or co-bred well over 100 Champions in the breed, including 10 different World or European Winners. One of the highlights was winning Reserve BIS at Dortmund European show 1992 and several group wins at other European winner shows.

I'm a President of one of the biggest breed clubs in Finland: Finnish Toy Dog Club. The Finnish Toy Dog Club is responsible for a vast variety of Toy breeds from FCI group 9 (Toy and Companion dogs) and Pomeranian, Kleinspitz, Volpino, Yorkshire Terrier, Affenpinscher, and Schipperke. I'm an examiner Judge for some breeds from five different FCI groups, especially from groups 5 and 9.

I've judged in over 50 different counties from all continents and have had CC appointments to UK for 30 different breeds. Some of the most important appointments have been judging at Westminster show 2025 and Toy group at Windsor show and several BIS appointments at main European shows like Dortmund Bundessieger, Herring Danish winner, Poznan, Brno and Istanbul Crufts qualification. Several invitations to FCI World and European shows and Champion of champions shows have also been special moments in my career.



**Desmond Murphy – AKC Judge, Florida**

I am a third-generation dog man. I have been judging for 49 years. Have judged in every Continent of the world. I have judged B.I.S. at the AKC NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW and also Morris and Essex. I was named Judge of the Year this year at the Dog News/Purina Pro Plan dinner over the Westminster weekend. I invented the Breeders Showcase, Bullygangza and the Foreign Bred Competition at Santa Barbara.



**Sandra Alder – CKC Judge**

Sandra Alder began her journey in the dog world in 1986 with her first Dalmatian, an experience that quickly grew into a lifelong passion. Just two years later, her second Dalmatian won Best of Breed at the Dalmatian Club of Canada National Specialty from the 12–18 month class, a pivotal success that led to the creation of Pepperlane Dalmatians Perm. Reg'd.

Since then, Sandra has bred and shown numerous American and Canadian champions, including a Record of Merit Dam, as well as specialty winners, group winners, and Best in Show winners. She is an active member of the Oakville and District Kennel Club, Brantford Kennel Club, Club VI, the Dalmatian Club of America, and the Dalmatian Club of Greater Detroit.

Sandra's dedication extends well beyond the conformation ring. She competes in a variety of performance sports, including scent work, rally, agility, and lure coursing, and remains committed to breeding, training, and competing with dogs that embody both beauty and purpose. In addition, she has expanded her role in the sport as a judge, licensed for the Non-Sporting Group and currently on permit for half of the Hound Group.



**Thomas Alexander – All breed CKC Judge**

I have bred German Shorthaired Pointers under the Thomashenry prefix since 1980. Our kennel has had number one GSP 1986, 88, 90, 91 and 96 with several in the top three in the sporting group in other years. I have had the top winning GSP / number one Sporting Dog & number three all breeds in South America as well as the first GSP ever to win the group at the World show in 1992. A Thomashenry dog was Best of Winners at the American National Specialty in 2000. We have champions in six countries. I have also bred English Springer Spaniels and grew up with Irish Water Spaniels.

For the last twenty years I have bred Multi BIS, BISS, Labrador Retrievers who have placed in the top five, including number one Labrador Retriever for 2016. I am involved WC training with our dogs. I am the field representative for the CKC, EOC.



**Will Alexander – CKC Judge**

I've spent my entire life immersed in the world of purebred dogs. My journey began in the early 1970s when my parents introduced me to the sport, and from that moment on, I knew there was no turning back. My family bred and showed Irish Setters, and as a junior I began breeding English Cockers under the Wilspride prefix. I made my ring debut at just seven years old with one of my father's Setters, competing in both Junior Showmanship and the breed ring. After apprenticing with Garry MacDonald in Canada and Bobby Stebbins in the United States, I turned professional in 1986. Just a year later, in 1987, I made history by handling Ch. McCammom Impresario, an Irish Setter, to Top Dog All Breeds, becoming the youngest handler ever to earn that distinction.

I have been fortunate to present many of Canada's top-winning dogs, including multiple Best in Show winners and National Specialty Best of Breeds across several groups. Much of my early success came with Irish Setters, a breed that helped refine my understanding of balance, movement, and presentation. That foundation deepened my admiration for the Sporting breeds, particularly Setters and Spaniels, whose form, function, and spirit remain so closely connected to their original purpose. There is nothing quite like watching a truly balanced dog move with reach, drive, and that unmistakable sparkle of enthusiasm that defines a great Gundog.

Throughout my career, I have handled many of Canada's most accomplished dogs and am proud to be one of only a handful of handlers to have achieved multiple Top Dog All Breeds titles. I have maintained a Top Ten All Breeds dog every year since 1991 and have guided numerous dogs to success at the highest levels of competition. Among the most memorable were the Irish Setter Ch. Muldoon Dewitt's Great One, who earned more than 100 Best in Show wins, and the 15-inch Beagle Miss P, who captured Best in Show at the Westminster Kennel Club in 2015.

I believe that every dog, whether in the show ring or in the whelping box, represents decades, sometimes centuries, of dedication and purposeful breeding. As a judge, my goal is to honor that legacy by rewarding dogs that not only meet the standard on paper but also capture the living essence of their breed in motion, temperament, and spirit.

Outside the ring, I share my experience through DogShowTips.com, my online educational platform and seminar series "*Handle Your Way Out of a Paper Bag*", where I focus on both technique and philosophy, the art of handling, presentation, and connection. I have had the privilege of teaching exhibitors from all walks of life and watching their confidence grow along with their appreciation for the craft and history of the sport.

Whether I am judging a lineup of Sporting dogs or helping a newcomer find their rhythm, my passion remains the same: to celebrate the relationship between handler and dog, to preserve the integrity of our breeds, and to honor the timeless balance of beauty and function that defines our sport.

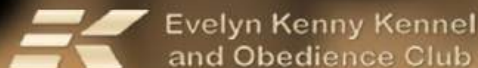

## Rules and Regulations

**ATTENTION: building opening/closing times – open 6 am sharp, and close at 11 pm sharp**

1. Dog Show Rule books and Obedience/Rally Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club.
2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules.
3. ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED BY EMAIL after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" – CKC rule book, Section 19.7.
5. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
6. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH WHILE ON THE GROUNDS. You are responsible for cleaning up if you permit your dog to relieve itself outside the show building. Failure to do so may result in being expelled from the building for one day's showing by the Superintendent.
7. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs.
8. SHOW PRECINCTS Show precincts will be entire AG Building at Stampede Park
9. "ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES." If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area.

**EXTRACTS FROM THE DOG SHOW RULES - BREEDS, CLASSES, AWARDS AND STAKES CONFORMATION CLASSES OFFERED:**

12.2.1 Regular official classes at a CKC conformation show shall be as described in (a) to (k) of this section. All classes must be divided by sex (except for Specials Only). Only dogs entered in one of the regular, non-regular, or unofficial classes shall be allowed within the show precincts.

**JUNIOR PUPPY:** shall be for dogs at least six months of age and under nine months of age on the day of the show.

**SENIOR PUPPY:** shall be for dogs 9 months of age and under twelve (12) months of age on the day of the show.

**12-18 MONTH** - for dogs over 12 months of age but under 18 months of age.

**CANADIAN BRED:** shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR:** shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the Breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class but need not handle the dog for further awards.

**OPEN CLASS:** shall be for all dogs.

**SPECIALS ONLY:** is for dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status including at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

#### **UNOFFICIAL/NON-REGULAR CLASSES OFFERED**

**BABY PUPPY** Dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The awards for this class are: Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female Best Baby Puppy in Breed Best Baby Puppy in Group Best Baby Puppy in Show **(Friday and Saturday ALL BREED ONLY)**

**VETERAN** In this optional class for All Breed Shows, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. The awards for this class are: Best Male Veteran and Best Female Veteran, Best Veteran in Breed, Best Veteran in Group, Best Veteran in Show. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Breed is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Group. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Group is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Show. **(Saturday and Sunday ALL BREED ONLY)**

**RESERVE BEST IN SHOW:** will be selected from the remaining 6 Breeds competing for BIS

#### **CHAPTER 4 – JUDGES**

SECTION 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

**EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER** Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$64.00.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded from the CKC website: <http://www.ckc.ca>

CKC Non-Participation Fee:

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) *"These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"*

\*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, <http://www.ckc.ca> under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved. ***This fee does not have to be paid before entering this show.***

**Attention Foreign Exhibitors:** Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you pay by credit card, bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.

**Entries sent by Courier must be sent prepaid;** To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing time and date.

Entries sent requiring a signature WILL NOT BE accepted.

#### **Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.**

**Exhibitors Please Note:** An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry at any time up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone, but **written or electronic notification must be received by the show secretary not later than closing date and time.** If written or electronic notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the show.

Section 9.9 Effective January 1, 2024

The CKC will not consider a request for any corrections to results if received more than 90 days following the date(s) of the event(s).

#### **There will be no refunds after close of entries on duplicate entries or overpayments.**

The Evelyn Kenny Kennel and Obedience Club reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Conformation Show Rules and Regulations (8.6.1). In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to be bound by the rules and regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in this premium list.

I (we) agree to hold the Evelyn Kenny Kennel and Obedience Club, their members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim.

I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.

An "In Transit Area" for owner/handlers who are transporting dogs not entered in the show is offered. The dog's information and reason for its presence must be recorded with the Show Secretary and identifying information attached to the dog's crate.

Please note: Dogs shall be exercised only in specified areas provided by the Club. Private exercise pens will be limited.

Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees). It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds' conflict.

The Evelyn Kenny Kennel and Obedience Club will not allow the use of spike or pinch collars on its show grounds.

If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the Evelyn Kenny Kennel and Obedience Club, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It should be understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children. The Evelyn Kenny Kennel and Obedience Club will not be responsible for injury to any child whether by accident or any other cause.

**ERRORS IN ENTRIES** An error in an age-specified class, date of birth or sex, may be amended up to one hour before the start of the breed judging for that breed for that day. Should the owner/breeder be unable to handle a dog entered in the bred By Exhibitor class, the dog may be moved to the Open class (at least one hour prior to the judging of the breed in question). Please note: **The show is a public event, candid photos and/or videos may be taken on the show premises. Such images may be published in print or on a website without your consent. By entering this dog show, you waive all rights to such images and agree that the Evelyn Kenny Kennel and Obedience Club shall not be held responsible for their use.**

#### **MOVING A CLASS DOG TO SPECIALS**

A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN), or Event Registrations Number (ERN) and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or handler at least one (1) hour prior to breed judging. A dog that has a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) is not eligible to be transferred from one (1) of the regular classes to Specials Only.

**Please note that the concession for this show is the Grill in the AG Building just a short outside walk from the Nutrien Event Center.**



**Extracts From CKC Dog Show Rules**

**Chapter 8 Entries and End of Show Section**

**8.2.5** An error in an age specified class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

**Section 8.3.1** Entries: Every dog entered in a Championship show must be one of the following:

- a) registered with the CKC,
- b) have an Event Registration Number,
- c) be eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- d) if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN).

**Section 8.4.1** Listed Dogs: If a dog is not registered as in 8.3.1 (a) or (b) but is eligible for registration with the CKC, it may be entered at a show as a listed dog provided:

- b) that if born in Canada, it is eligible for individual registration.
- c) that if not born in Canada, is eligible for registration in the records of the CKC.
- d) that if it is a foreign born and owned dog, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtain from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

**Section 8.4.2** Entry of a listed dog at a show must be accompanied by a listing fee as set by the Board in addition to the regular entry fee.

**Section 8.5.1** Acceptance of Entries: If indicated in the premium list, an electronically transmitted entry may be accepted provided the entry is accompanied by a credit card charge authorization.

**Section 8.5.3** No entry shall be accepted from or on behalf of any person who is officially known to be expelled, deprived of privileges, debarred or suspended by the CKC or any other registering body for pure bred dogs.

**Section 8.5.4** After entries close, no further entries may be accepted, cancelled or substituted other than as otherwise stated in this section or as provided for in case of a postal strike.

**Section 8.6.1** Refusal of Entries: The authorities of any show may:

- a) decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or
- b) refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show building on account of disease or viciousness.
- c) in the case of non-acceptance, refund the fee with the reason for non-acceptance.

**Section 8.8.2** Fees: Tendering of a dishonored cheque or declined credit card in payment of an entry fee shall be considered non-payment of said fee and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

**Section 8.9.1** Moving a Dog to Specials: A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for a show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or handler at least one hour prior to the opening of the show.

**Section 8.9.2** If it is established that a dog transferred to Specials Only has not completed the Championship requirements, all awards will be canceled, and all ribbons and prizes won shall be forfeited. The owner may also be subject to disciplinary action.

**Section 8.9.3** When one or more All-Breed and/or Specialty Shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the moving of class dogs to Specials must be made prior to the scheduled opening of the first show.

**Chapter 4 Judges Section 4.1.3** A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

**Section 4.1.5** No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act.

**Chapter 14 Disqualifying or Excusing Dogs**

**Section 14.1.2** (a) At his discretion, a judge shall have the authority to excuse or disqualify a dog which menaces, threatens, attempts to bite or bites the judge, another person, or another dog in the ring. When a dog is twice excused on this account, it shall have the status of a disqualified dog.

(b) At his discretion, a judge shall have the authority to permanently disqualify a dog which bites the judge or another person in the ring. Dogs disqualified under this provision will not be eligible for reinstatement. The decision to permanently disqualify a dog must be clearly indicated on the Judge's Disqualification Form.

**Section 14.1.4** Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until

the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action. A dog disqualified under section 14.1.2 (b) is not eligible for reinstatement.

**Section 14.1.5** Any dog that is disqualified under section 14.1.2(a) shall automatically be disqualified from entering in any CKC event in any other discipline until such time as the dog is officially reinstated, if the dog is eligible for reinstatement.

**Championship Points and Cancellations**

**Section 15.1.1** A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

**Section 15.1.2** The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 & more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*\*Includes the dog awarded Winners.*

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

**Section 15.1.3** If a Dog awarded Winners was also awarded Best of Breed, then at the show all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included the total.

**Section 15.1.4** If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total.

**Section 15.1.5** If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.

**Section 15.1.6** If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.

**Section 15.1.7** The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

**Clarification:** Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Male shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials Bitches and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

**Section 15.1.8** In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that the dog was defeated at the Group level.

**Section 15.1.9** A dog may not be credited with more than 5 championship points in a single show:

**Section 15.1.10** A breed or class shall not be allowed more than 2 sets of championship points per sex on any day in the same venue.

**Section 15.1.11** A dog awarded Winners which also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with 5 championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

**Section 15.1.12** In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate, the dog must:

- (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 judges; and,
- (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number.
- (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

**15.2 Grand Champion (GCh)**

15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.

15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

**(a) Grand Champion Point System**

Points towards the Grand Champion title are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

(b) the following schedule shall be employed in determination of points awarded at Group Level for all GCh:

c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

(d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.

Win	Points
Best in Show	5
Best of Breed at a National Specialty Show	5
Reserve Best in Show	4
Best of Breed at a Specialty Show (other than National)	3

(a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.

(b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

(c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021, may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS) The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.

(a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze

(b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold: (GChG) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.

(a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.

(b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

**15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx)**

15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.

15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

(a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed)

(b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins.

(c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

NOTE: 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above.

2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until July 1, 2022.
