ENTRY & PAYMENT (please read carefully): Entries are to be sent in by email along with payment. Please email entry & e-transfer to catstestsecretary@gmail.com and use "scentdetection" as the answer to your e-transfer security question. Any other answer will be considered a non-payment of entry fee, and your entry will not be accepted. All email entries must be scanned & sent as a PDF attachment with no dark background present. Any entry forms sent as a photo, a JPEG or in any other format will not be accepted & your entry will not be accepted.

The Temporary Competition fee as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Temporary Competition Number (TCN) is not shown on the entry form.

DAY OF ENTRIES: Day of event entries will be accepted if the limit has not been reached in each level.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES & REFUNDS: An exhibitor may withdraw their entry prior or on the closing date, in writing, by contacting the Match Secretary by email. No refunds will be offered for this event after the closing date.

CHANGES/MOVE UPS: There will be no change of entries or move ups after closing.

BITCHES IN HEAT: Bitches in heat will be permitted to compete but must wear panties when trialing and will be placed at the end of the running order for each component. Please advise the Match Secretary as soon as possible to allow for the run order to be adjusted accordingly.

HANDLERS WITH MULTIPLE DOGS: Handlers with multiple dogs will not be permitted to enter more than one dog in the same class/components. For example: Two Novice dogs handled by the same person cannot be entered in the same Novice components at the same trial. The handler may enter one dog in Instinct, and one dog in Novice as an alternative.

SICK DOGS: Please do not bring a dog that has acquired or has been exposed to a communicable disease to the Sanction Match. Inform the Match Secretary immediately if you have a dog that is sick (per CKC rule 6.6 Health).

RIBBONS & SPECIAL AWARDS: As this is a **Sanction Match**, meaning NO official titles can be awarded, those dogs earning qualifying scores will receive a ribbon for their success!

RULE 14.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

NON-MEMBERS PARTICIPATION FEE: The CKC has a tracking fee for non-members. Please refer to the information about this policy on the CKC website: https://www.ckc.ca/en/Files/Forms/Shows-Trials/Exhibitors/Non-MemberParticipation-Fee-Form-Form-No-150-00-5.

If a dog is not registered individually in the records of the CKC, it may be entered at a trial held under these rules with a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), providing that the number is obtained before the closing date of entries. Once the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will no longer be valid. While there is no fee for the Temporary Competition Number, exhibitors will still be required to pay listing fees (\$10.50) when entering events. The request for a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors should go to the CKC website to complete an online application, and a TCN will be issued instantly. Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application, and submitting it to the CKC, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Scent Detection Rules & Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. INFORMATION FOR US EXHIBITORS ON ENTERING CANADA: To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document. Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

CATS Health Safety: While all health restrictions have been lifted, our club would like to keep our judge, members, volunteers, competitors, & any spectators safe from illness. If you are feeling unwell prior to or on the day of the match, and would like to pull from the match, please inform the Match Secretary.

Should the Alberta Health Guidelines & Protocols change at the time of this match, our protocols will adjust accordingly.

VENUE: This match will run rain or shine. All dogs must be under control, and on a leash except in the designated search area while being judged in the match. It is within the judge's discretion to allow or disallow a dog to be off leash while searching. Violation of this rule or failure to follow the judge's direction may result in immediate removal.

No scent oils, scent aids or scent vessels are allowed within the match venue including parking lot.

Remember that this is a public facility used by families. Clean up after yourself and your dog, failure to do so will result in immediate expulsion from the event.

Stairs during the match may need to be used to access search areas. Please inform the club if you need assistance.

Washroom facilities are available indoors and may only be available on an intermittent basis.

If a handler has a disability or a dog has a physical challenge that may require accommodation, please advise the Match Secretary prior to entering so it can be determined if the disability/challenge can be accommodated.

Do not allow your dog to urinate or defecate on buildings or structures.

Central Alberta Tracking Society will exercise all reasonable care for the safety of the dogs competing, but will not be held responsible for the loss, damage, or injury to any dog, handler or owner, children not under the control of their parent or guardian and their property.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY: Central Alberta Tracking Society members, volunteers, and the judge will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, BUT will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. By entering this Sanction Match each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the Match and agrees to release and to save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) and/or leasee(s) of any property upon which the Match may be held together with their officers, agents, employees, and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participant's use or entry upon the property. My signature on the entry form indicates that I understand and agree to the above and to abide by rules of the current Official CKC Rules and Regulations as well as rules set forth by Central Alberta Tracking Society concerning this event.
