**Puppy Stake:** "A Puppy Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age and under 2 years of age on the day of the trial at which the Puppy Stake is judged." CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations, Chapter 10, section 2

**Limit Stake:** "A Limit Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs that have not placed in an Open All-Age Stake, or received 2 first placements in any Regular Official Stake (Puppy Stake excepted), at an approved trial in Canada or any equivalent Spaniel trial in any other country. Dogs must be at least 6 months of age on the day of the trial." CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 3

**Open All-Age Stake:** "An Open All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for all dogs at least six months of age on the day of the trial at which the stake is judged." CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 4

**Amateur All-Age:** "An Amateur All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for all dogs at least six months of age on the day of the trial at which the stake is judged. A person shall be considered an amateur if he has not attempted to receive any part of his livelihood from the training, handling or showing of field trial or hunting dogs in the calendar year of the trial or the preceding calendar year. Dogs running an Amateur Stake must be owned by an amateur and handled by an amateur." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 6*

**Water Test** - A Spaniel is primarily a land dog. However, in many parts of the country he is used to retrieve waterfowl, and in an ordinary day's shoot there are occasions when the only way of gathering shot game is after a swim or from a stream, pond or lake. *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 16, section 1*

Points: Championship Points are awarded for placements in the All-Age Stakes, provided that there are 12 or more starters:

1st Place - 5 Points, 2nd Place - 3 Points, 3rd Place - 2 Points, 4th Place - 1 Point

16.3.5 a Field Trial Committee may host a "stand alone" water test to be judged on a pass/fail basis provided such information has been outlined in the premium list and approved by the CKC.

## PRIZES

Standard CKC Rosettes and keeper plaques to all placing dogs in each stake. CKC certificate for water test.

Open – Windbourne Challenge trophy, Limit – Esten Electric Challenge trophy, Puppy – Curtis Spencer Memorial trophy.

**Indignities:** It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, field trial marshal, volunteer, or competitor at a field trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

**Field Apparel:** **Blaze Orange** visible above the waist is required by anyone that will be on the field while a trial is in progress. **NOTE:** Alcohol not permitted on the trial grounds.

<b>Comments:</b>	<p><b><u>Non-Member Participation Fee</u></b>  <b>24-12-3.</b> Non-member participation fee  a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.  b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.  c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members".</p>
<b>Location:</b>	<p>Trial to be held at the former prison Town of Burwash. Due to the construction of the new 4 lane highway 69, the turnoff to Burwash can only be accessed from the interchange at the Killarny exit. To get to Burwash from Sudbury, one must drive South of Burwash and take the exit to Killarny.(interchange at 46 13'39.55" N, 80 46'32.50" W) then immediately turn right (north) off of the Killarny highway to follow the old highway 69 which is now a service road North to the Burwash turnoff (46 15'45.48"N 80 48'41.11"W).
