CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 20 - Dog Show Rules: Champions and Championship Points

Section 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these dog show rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0-5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder:

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

^{*}includes dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the number of championship points by a dog awarded WINNERS. total of all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex, and then consult the schedule set forth above. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at a breed or group level.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Northern Alberta Canine Association premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
- 2. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
- 3. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" - CKC rule book, Section 19.7
- 4. All dogs must be kept on leash while on the grounds. You are responsible for cleaning up when your dog relieves himself. PLEASE 'STOOP AND SCOOP' AT ALL TIMES - THANK YOU. Failure to do so may result in being expelled from the SHOW GROUNDS by the Superintendent
- 5. "All dogs must be kept under control at all times." If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to
 enter back into the United States, all <u>US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved
 Secure Travel Dow ment.</u>
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies
 vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this
 country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs
 less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.30 per copy + 13% Ontario HST.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR	dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.
OPEN CLASS	for all dogs - divided by weight: under 15 lbs., 15-20 lbs. 20-25 lbs.
VETERAN CLASS	for all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered.
SPECIALS ONLY	dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.
EXHIBITION ONLY	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MONTHS)	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. <u>These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular</u> or <u>unofficial classes or Parades</u>

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require</u> an <u>ERN - Event Registration Number</u>. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expir) date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is** \$58.50 + 5% GST. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.
