WHAT IS LGRA?

LGRA is sprint racing for Gazehounds. The hounds run 200 yards straight after a lure consisting of a fur bag and squawker. Up to four hounds race a total of three times, called programs. Depending on the order of finish, they may attain national points towards a GRC (Gazehound Race Champion) title. Hounds will be hand slipped. More information can be found at <u>www.lgra.org</u>

Hounds need to be one year of age or older to be entered. They will also need to be registered with LGRA. This can be done the first time the hound is raced by including a photocopy of the hound's registration papers (either Canadian or American) with the entry. After registration, your hound will receive an LGRA number that will be used in entering future LGRA meets.

HOUNDS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER WITHOUT A COPY OF PROPER REGISTRATION AT THE TIME OF ENTRY. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE ALLOWED.

All hounds will run muzzled to prevent damage to the squawker. It is recommended that hounds be accustomed to a muzzle before the event. A limited supply of racing muzzles will be available for use so please bring your own if possible. Numbered racing blankets will also be available. Bitches in season are not allowed to compete.

Previous experience is not required. Time allowing, several practice runs will be held for new hounds.

Dogs five (5) years of age or older are considered Veterans for Straight racing.

Try it and see – your hound may surprise you!

ENTRY FEES

The entry fee for each hound will be \$12 if the entry/email is received by the Race Secretary by May 25, 2014. Entries will be accepted after May 25 and on the day of the event, at a gate entry fee of \$18 per hound. First time entries must include an additional \$2 and a copy of registration certificate.

Directions to Site

This race meet is being held on the same grounds as the Specialty Show the day prior.

From Montréal, take Champlain Bridge then highway 10 towards Sherbrooke for 20km; Exit 22, take highway 35 towards Saint-Jean- sur- Richelieu for 11 km; Exit 7, Boul. Du Séminaire. Keep straight, on McDonald to reach Champlain Street; Turn right on Champlain and follow the Richelieu River. After downtown, the street merges to the left and becomes Jacques Cartier; The military base is on your left and the entrance, on the left, is only 500 meters after the merge. Main entrance is 15, Jacques-Cartier Nord You can ask the military guardian at the gate for further indications to Complexe Sport Absolu.

NEW THIS YEAR; From Western provinces, there is a new section of highway 30 to avoid the city of Montreal. You can reach it from autoroutes 20(401) or 40 (417). This will take you straight to autoroute 10. You will easily save an hour and a lot of stress with the new highway.
