- 2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Event Secretary.
- 4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" **Conformation Show Rules and Regulations** Section 19.7.
- 5. We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the show secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.
- 6. The CKC will not consider a request for any corrections to results if received more than 90 days following the date(s) of the event(s).
- 7. No dog may be brought on the grounds or premises of an event if it:
 - Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable diseases;
 - Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable diseases within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
 - Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable diseases.

ADDITIONAL SHOW INFORMATION

- 1. Group judging will follow breed judging through to BIS whenever possible. No two groups will be judged simultaneously. Should a conflict arise, the Chief Ring Steward will determine which Group will be judged first.
- 2. There will not be any dog bathing facility at this show. Spiffy Pet Wash and Pet Value have dog washing facilities if required.
- 3. THE SCOOP-UP BYLAWS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED! Exhibitors are responsible for any accidents their dogs have in the rings or elsewhere. This is a **SELF CLEAN** show.
- 4. Show site will open daily at 7:00AM and close 6:00PM or an hour after BIS or end of obedience trial witch ever is later.
- 5. Dogs will **NOT** be allowed to stay in the building overnight.
- 6. There will be an "In-Transit" area.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS!

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded here.

INFORMATION FOR US EXHIBITORS ON ENTERING CANADA

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from zero (0) to five(5)) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

^{*} includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall **not** be included in the calculation for championship points.

If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total.

If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing in Specials Only shall be included in the total.

If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.

If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.

The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification:

Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Dog shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

A dog awarded Winners that also placed Reserve Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with four (4) championship points in addition to any points earned at the breed and group level, to the maximum allowed championship points in a single show.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must:

- a) Earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges;
- b) Be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN);
- c) Have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean:

- a) At a single breed National Specialty, the male designated Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded three (3) championship points, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes is sufficient for the Winners Bitch to have received five (5) points.
- b) At a single breed National Specialty, the female designated Reserve Winners Dog will be awarded three (3) championship points, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes is sufficient for the Winners Dog to have received five (5) points.
- c) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level;
- d) Each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing:
- e) All points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

GRAND CHAMPION (GCh)

The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.

To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level, to a maximum of 5 points.

a) Grand Champion Point System - Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh: Select Dog = # of regular class dogs + # of specials dogs - 1, Select Bitch = # of regular class bitches + # of specials bitches - 1.

b) The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at Group level for all levels of GCh:

- c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.
- d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

GRAND CHAMPION BRONZE (GChB)

The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level, to a maximum of 5 points.
- c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

GRAND CHAMPION SILVER (GChS)

The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level, to a maximum of 5 points.

GRAND CHAMPION GOLD (GChG)

The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level, to a maximum of 5 points.

GRAND CHAMPION EXCELLENT (GChEx)

The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.

To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

- a) One (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed)
- b) Three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed speciaty best of breed wins.
- c) A CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

1. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until December 31, 2022.
