Parking for trial attendees and instinct test attendees is on the **lower driveway areas only**. No parking by ic/test the barn – reserved for farm owners, judges and coordinators.

If your dog will not settle in the vicinity of the stock pen (barking, howling etc.) please move them to another location out of sight where they will settle.

You are responsible for any significant damage/harm to livestock, other animals, etc. Signed waivers are required.

Ensure you CLOSE all gates behind you!

Pick up after your dog – yes there are other farm dogs living there – but we are guests of this property – stoop and scoop!

Do not enter any of the barns/outbuildings etc. without specific permission from the farm owner

There will be a porta potty on site

Please come prepared for the day you and for your dog

Bring plenty of water for you and for your dog Bring a kennel/crate and/or be prepared to work out of your vehicle Bring rain gear (including rubber boots – we run RAIN or SHINE) Bring a long line to clip to your dog if you have one Lunch will be available onsite as a club fundraiser, however Lunenburg is only minutes away and they do have a Subway/Tim's etc. If you wish to setup and use a tent or EZ up for shelter, you may do so. I (we) acknowledge that the Canadian Cardigan Corgi Club has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the organizing committee shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this herding trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and win ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents, sponsors of the events, and trial secretary and the owner or leasee of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the herding trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto. I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from. sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this herding trial, howsoever such injuries death or damage to property may be caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to other dogs, animals, or people, and has received instructional training to or above the level of the class he/she is entered in.

I (we) also agree to pay the full market value (\$200.00) per sheep, for any death resulting from my (our) dog's actions, whether willful or accidental. In the case of injury to any sheep resulting from my (our) dog's actions whether willful or accidental, I (we) agree to pay all veterinary fees, up to and including the market value of \$200.00 per sheep.
