# Saturday June 21, 2025 - 1st Specialty Show Mrs Ellie Mordecai (Millhill) - UK



Born and raised in Perth, Scotland, my first Cavalier entered my life in 1971 when I was just 14 years old, and they have been my passion ever since.

As a competitive horsewoman, my focus on showing and breeding Cavaliers developed more seriously in the early 1980s. My first Champion, Ch Millhill La Peche JW, was born in 1986 and achieved her title in 1989 by winning Best in Show at The Scottish CKCS Championship Show.

Since then, I have had the honor of producing six UK Champions across three of the four Cavalier colors:

- Ch Millhill Le Monde
- Ch Millhill Le Voleur
- Littermates Ch Millhill Le Frere and Ch Millhill La Miel (both record-makers)
- Ch Lisgarth Petrouchka at Millhill
- Ch Millhill Le Sage

Additionally, I have bred several other CC and RCC winners, including the notable sire Hometown Ever Hopeful at Millhill (2 CCs, 3 RCCs) and Millhill La Fraise JW (2 RCCs), the mother of four champions. There have also been multiple Millhill champions overseas.

I have been awarding CCs in Cavaliers for over 25 years and am also approved to award CCs in Papillons. In 2027, I will have the privilege of judging Cavaliers at Crufts. I have also judged Cavaliers in the USA, Sweden, Finland, the Czech Republic, Germany, and France, as well as at numerous CC appointments in the UK.

I am truly excited about my upcoming judging appointment in Ontario and greatly look forward to the opportunity to assess your beautiful Cavaliers.

#### Saturday June 21, 2025 - 2nd Specialty Show Nick Frost (Dehra) - USA

I grew up in Northern Ireland where my first dog was an English Springer Spaniel. I came from a family of Sporting dogs as my mother had bred English Cockers and my father worked Labradors.

My first show dog was an Afghan Hound, a breed I stayed with from the seventies for three decades. However, I am known for the pioneer work and long time involvement with the PBGV, having bred over 150 Champions worldwide.

Cavaliers came into my life back in the eighties and I established my line of Dehra breeding, based largely on Ronnoc and Homerbrent lines. A number of exports to the USA, before the breed was AKC recognised, pre-dated my own move state-side in the mid nineties when several Cavaliers accompanied me! I stayed pretty true to these lines and in those early days of AKC recognition produced foundation Cavaliers for a number of



breeders as well as successfully breeding a steady number of Champions and Group placing Cavaliers for the Dehra kennel.

I have judged Cavaliers not only in the USA but also in the UK, Ireland and Scandinavia. I judge the Hound, Sporting and most of the Terrier Groups. Although no longer breeding Cavaliers, they still remain a heart breed for me!

## Sunday June 22, 2025 - Eastlake Specialty Karen Mills-Heron (Jaron) - USA

I started showing my cavaliers in the early 70's at AKC and CKC shows in obedience and conformation. At home the dogs learned to track children and flush birds. Through them I was able to meet many others who shared my love of the breed and the events for dogs. The AKC and CKC Centennial Shows hold special memories as well as many camping trips across the border. Ruby, Dijers Red Benjamin, Am Can CDX was part of an obedience demonstration team at Westminster KC some years ago.

While probably known best for whole colours, there have been all four colours at Jaron. My first cavalier was Sartorius Olderhill Saffron. The Sartorius Kennel was nearby in NY until returning to the UK; her sister Easter Bonbon was a top winner at the first CKCSC USA specialty. I was fortunate to own Saffron and later Sartorius Pickle of Crustadele, one of the early Canadian champions. Other lovely Jaron dogs have also won acclaim in CKCSC Can and AKC competition, including Homerbrent Navaho and Huron and Brinklow's Kiowa and Quena.

Working with other cavalier fanciers to start the first annual CKCSC USA cardiology clinic many years ago and the first obedience trial were happy accomplishments for our breed. My AKC club Meadowlands CKCSC, continues to hold health clinics, specialties, performance events, as well as other educational opportunities for the Cavaliers.

Ruby Robin and black and tans, Tiva and Tattoo, and tri, India have been involved in a Sirius about Reading project in local schools and public libraries and enjoy nursing home visits. They are also AKC champions and registered Therapy Dogs. Exhibiting my dogs, breed education, judging and stewarding, and club activities keep us busy.

## Saturday June 21, 2025 - Cavalier Booster Sandra Lex (All Breed Judge) - Canada

I have been very involved in the Toy Group for many years, and it holds a very special place in my heart. As an all-breed judge in Canada, I joined the American Kennel Club judging program 26 years ago, and I am currently approved for four groups, including Toys. Two years ago, I had the honor of judging the Toy Group at Westminster.

My involvement in the dog world has been a lifelong journey. My mother bred American Cockers for many years, and I continued that legacy by breeding them for over 25 years. Later, Affenpinschers captured my heart, and I have been dedicated to this delightful breed for the past 23 years. During this time, we've achieved significant success, including major wins in Canada and at the U.S. Nationals. More recently, I acquired a

charming English Toy Spaniel from the Clussexx Kennel. This delightful dog achieved major wins and earned a Grand Champion title in a remarkably short period of time this year.

I firmly believe that judges must remain actively involved in all aspects of the dog world. Staying engaged helps keep us grounded and connected to the heart of the sport.



## <u>Sunday June 22, 2025 - Cavalier Booster</u> Wendy Maisey (Dawnaquinn) - Canada

Wendy Maisey is a CKC All Breed Judge who has judged extensively in Canada, and the US with a special assignment to judge at the Sydney Royal in Australia. She was the CKC Director for AB/NWT/NU from 2012 to 2014. Residing in Calgary, Alberta, Canada with her husband, several Cavaliers and two Berger Picards.

Originally in Dobermans, she got her first Doberman in 1972 and over the next 35 years produced many Canadian and American champions, BIS & BISS winners that set records for the breed, as well as some outstanding performance dogs. Wendy also bred Miniature Pinschers in the 80's that are behind some of the most successful kennels today. No longer breeding or owning Dobermans, for the last 20 years she has bred Cavalier King Charles Spaniels with a strong focus on the whole colours that have also set records within this breed including the first whole colour to win the Canadian National Specialty.

After being very active in Agility with her Cavaliers being ranked at the top in their breed in several organizations including the first Cavalier to get an Agility Master Championship in Canada it is now time to enjoy life, puppies, and occasionally showing in Conformation
