Entries close at 8:00 p.m., Wednesday June 25, 2014, or when entry limit is reached, whichever occurs earlier.

LIMITED ENTRY

Entry is limited to a total of 7 hours of judging, at a rate of 9 Pre-Novice, 8 Novice, 7 Open, and 6 Utility dogs per hour in the Obedience trial and 20 dogs per hour (less time for walk-throughs) in the Rally Obedience trial. One the judge has reached his capacity, entries for the trials will be closed, even if the closing date has not been reached. In the case of the entry limit having been reached, remaining entries will be assigned a position on the reserve list. Exhibitors will be notified of their position on the reserve list. If the entry of a bitch in seasonis pulled after entries are closed, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial. If the entry of another dog is pulled prior to the trial, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to 24 hours prior to the trial.

CATALOGUES

A catalogue to cover all events is available on a PRE-ORDER basis. Those who wish to preorder at the price of \$5.00 may do so by indicating this on the entry form. A limited number of catalogues will be available for sale at the trials for a price of \$8.00. However, according to CKC rules, the catalogues cannot be distributed until the day of the conformation show, Sunday July 13, 2014. A dog running order will be provided at the obedience and rally trials.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian funds. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared through the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full.
- 2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees.
- 3. Telephone /fax entries are accepted by The Entry Line at 1-800-293-2935, (fax) 519-754-0796
- 4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 5. Alterations, substitution, or cancellation of any entry after the closing date is prohibited.
- 6. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for registration can be entered.
- 7. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- 8. ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE WEDNESDAY JUNE 25, 2014, AT 8:00 PM.
- 9. IDENTIFICATION CARDS AND JUDGING SCHEDULES WILL BE SENT <u>BY EMAIL</u> AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AFTER THE ENTRIES CLOSE. Identification cards must be presented to the Show Secretary upon arrival at the show.
- 10.Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. **Any NSF cheque will be subject to a \$25.00 service charge.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. The Ontario Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability, in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
- 3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of Entry Fees will be made.
- 4. The show precincts shall be the ring and 10 feet in all directions from the outer edge of the ring.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at a Show held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

STATEMENT OF PRIVACY

Personal information which is provided to Danuta Booth, Show Secretary, will only be used for the purposes required by the Canadian Kennel Club and voluntarily submitted to us upon completion of an entry form. No personal information will be disclosed for purposes other than intended without consent or required by law.

In order to qualify for this distinction, points can be earned by entering 3 or more of the events offered – WC/WCI/WCX, dock diving, agility, rally, obedience, and conformation. EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan. 1/92, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Fee is \$58.50 per dog after January 1, 2012, plus applicable taxes. New - CKC Non Member Participation Fee

- a) A non member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee for 2014 is \$59.40 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- d) All Premium List will carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non member residents of Canada and are not applicable to CKC members.
