MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

Chapter 13, Section 13 of the Dog Show Rules has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

Effective Jan. 1/92, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an **E**vent **R**egistration **N**umber (ERN). The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Fee is \$53.50 per dog. For further information contact:

No Entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the Entry Form are completed in full. Handlers or Agents please note the full name and address of all owners MUST BE FILLED IN.

Incomplete Entries Will Be Returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by Entry Fees. Telephone and Telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Alterations, Substitutions or Cancellations of any Entry after the Closing Date is prohibited, except moving Class Dogs to Specials. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules. ENTRIES CLOSE 9:00 PM TUESDAY MAY 15, 2012 and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.

Identification Cards and Judging Schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the entries close.

Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a \$25.00 service charge

DOG SHOW RULES

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Dog Show Rules of the Canadian Kennel Club. Chapter 6 - Section 6.3.3 of the Dog Show Rules states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out.

Precincts of the Show will extend to twenty feet from the edge of the rings or as otherwise designated with appropriate signs. Unentered dogs will not be allowed within the precincts.

The Show Giving Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.

NO COVER SHALL BE PROVIDED IN CASE OF INCLEMENT WEATHER.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (See Section 26.7)

OFFICIAL CLASSES:

The following Official Classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY - Dogs 6 months but under 9 months on the day of the show. **SENIOR PUPPY** - Dogs 9 months but under 12 months on the day of the show **12-18 MONTHS** - Dogs 12 months but under 18 months on the day of the show.

CANADIAN BRED - Dogs born in Canada. Champions in any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - Dogs owned/handled in the ring by the breeder. Handler must be the owner/co-owner and breeder/co-breeder of the dog.

OPEN - All dogs

SPECIALS ONLY - For Canadian Champions only. Must have a CKC registration number or ERN. Listed dogs cannot enter the Specials Class.

VETERANS - Dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. (Specialty shows only) These dogs to compete for regular placements, and the 1st place dog and bitch will go on to compete for Best Of Breed. Spayed/Neutered dogs may compete.

EXHIBITION ONLY - For all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club.

BEST PUPPY IN BREED & BEST CANADIAN BRED IN SHOW WILL BE OFFERED AT THIS SHOW

SEXUALLY ALTERED DOGS:

All rules and regulations in the CKC Dog Show Rules shall apply except for those which disallow sexually altered dogs from regular conformation competition. Judges shall judge this class as if judging regular conformation classes. Withholding awards for lack of merit is encouraged. Points may not be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging.

These classes will be judged after the judging of the Best Of Breed in the Regular classes and before the non-regular/unofficial judging.

OFFICIAL CLASSES: One class for Males, One class for Females. Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Reserve Winners Dog, Reserve Winners Bitch, Best Of Breed Altered and Best Of Opposite Sex Altered will be offered at this show.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

STUD DOG - Stud dog and 2 (or more) of his get. Class will be judged on the merits of the get.

BROOD BITCH - Brood bitch and 2 (or more) of her progeny. Class will be judged on the merits of the progeny.

BRACE - A Brace should be judged as an identical pair - same color, size, gait and same stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. A brace must be handled by 1 person and 1 LFAD

TEAM -. A Team should be judged on same merits as the brace class (see above description).

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

The following unofficial classes will take place at the competition of the Specialty Show; that is, after the judging of Best Of Breed, Altered Classes and Non-Regular Classes.

GAIT - Movement is the prime purpose for this class. It is open to any dog or bitch entered in the Specialty Show. The judge shall withhold this trophy when he/she feels that no hound entered in this class has the desired degree of excellence and efficiency of movement to deserve the award.

HEAD - To emphasize the importance of a typical head as a distinguishing feature of the Breed. It is open to any dog or bitch entered in the Specialty Show.

HINDQUARTERS - This class is open to any dog or bitch entered in the Specialty Show. The winner will be the one that exhibits the preferred hindquarter assembly to the judge on the day of the show.

<u>NOTE</u>: As per CKC rules, a spayed/neutered dog may be entered in the Veterans class and in any of the non-regular or unofficial classes. Dogs entered in the non-regular classes must also be entered in either a Regular, Veteran, Sexually Altered classes or Exhibition Only.

BEST BRACE* This trophy is donated by Judith P. Ryan, Curiann Reg'd, to the winner of this category. It is a Perpetual Trophy and can never be won outright. The winner will receive a keeper trophy.

BEST GAIT The MADRYN TROPHY, donated by Susan Weeks, will be offered for the winner of this event. To retain permanent possession this trophy must be won three times by the same exhibitor, though not necessarily with the same hound, or at consecutive shows. Allan and Juanita McLeod will offer a keeper trophy.

BEST HEAD The AOTEAROA TROPHY. This trophy is donated by Barbara Daley, to the winner of this class to emphasize the importance of a typical head as a distinguishing feature of the breed.
