STAKE OUT Fee in effect. Each entrant will pay a \$5.00 "Stakeout Fee". This is a one time charge for the event for all participants on the grounds. Proceeds from this fee are paid directly to the landowner to offset incidental pasture damage from vehicles and animals. Please include this with your entries.

Please note: ALL PERSONS WHO ENTER THE GROUNDS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SIGN A WAIVER PRIOR to ENTERING OR ENGAGING IN ANY ACTIVITIES ON THE GROUNDS. This is the requirement of the landowner. We need to have as many waivers as we can prior to the trial. Please return your waiver with your entry.

Courses and Birds: Native Pheasant and Hungarian partridge, pen raised pheasants, partridge or quail. The Open Puppy will be single course, with no birds released and no bird field. All other stakes will be run on a single course with birds released on the back course only. At the discretion of the Field Trial Committee courses may be added, deleted or altered to accommodate as many dogs as possible.

LOCATION

Directions will be provided with entry confirmation. The club is grateful to have the use of these grounds and asks for your cooperation in keeping them free of litter by using garbage bags provided. Parking will be restricted to the designated camping areas. Camping on the grounds will be allowed from 4pm May 5th until 6pm May 8th, 2022. Training and running of dogs on the grounds will not be permitted immediately before, during or after the trial. Hay must be removed from grounds upon departure.

The GSPFCA is grateful to Monty and Roger McNair and the McNair Family for the use of these grounds. Please respect and abide by all good neighbour rules. Please clean up all garbage before leaving no matter how small.

MOST IMPORTANT: NO SMOKING OR OPEN FLAME OF ANY KIND WILL BE PERMITTED OUTSIDE OF YOUR VEHICLE. THIS AREA IS EXTREMELY DRY AND SENSITIVE TO THE SMALLEST SPARK. PLEASE RESPECT THE LAND OWNERS WISH AND ABIDE BY THIS RULE.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Running and Handling: Handling will be done on foot only. Only judges, Marshall's and bird planters may be mounted.

Tracking collars: The GSPFCA is allowing the use of electronic tracking collars in the trial. Only tracking collars that meet the CKC guidelines will be allowed. Participants must declare that they are using the tracking collars to the Field Trial Chairman and also to the judges. Garmin GPS collars that are **not** approved for use in Canada will not be permitted.

Collaring: Collaring a dog away after contact with game will be allowed.

Blank Pistols: .22 calibre or larger will be fired over all dogs with bird work in senior and derby stakes. Blank pistols will not be fired in the puppy stake.

Total Entries: Entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run in the available daylight hours Senior and Derby stakes are 30 min. and the Puppy stake will be 20 min. length. In order to accommodate as many dogs as possible in the event of a large entry, or any other unforeseen circumstances, a 20 min Derby stake and a 15 min. Puppy Stake may be run. At the discretion of the Committee, stakes may be rearranged or courses altered to accommodate as many entries as possible. This includes the addition of a birdfield.

Bitches in season: Bitches in season will be allowed to run in Open Derby only.

All participants must be familiar with the CKC Rules and Regulations and also the rules, conditions, and provisions of this Premium List. CKC Field Trial Rules are available from the CKC.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Camping will be allowed on the grounds for participants only in the area specified. Please do not leave the trail with your vehicles while driving on the pasture. Facilities are limited, come prepared. Outhouse is provided. Other accommodations available in the area: Strathmore, Leroy's Motor Inn 934-3545, Best Western 934-5777. Beiseker Motel 9, 947-2555.

FOOD

There will be no food concession available. All participants need to supply their own meals and beverages

PRIZES

Standard CKC rosettes will be awarded to all four placing dogs in all stakes.

Completed entries and payment must be submitted to Field Trial Secretary no earlier than 6 p.m. Wednesday April 27th and by 7 p.m. Tuesday May 3rd, 2022.

LISTING FEE

The rules of the CKC require the payment of a listing fee of \$10.50 (for each stake entered) in addition to the entry fee of a dog for which no CKC registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is shown on the entry form. Exhibitors should note that the CKC does not confer a title on any dog until it is registered individually in the Club's records. Foreign born and owned dogs must apply for an ERN or Registration within 30 days of the first event entered. Competitors should apply for an ERN number from CKC so non CKC registered dogs can accumulate points won, toward a championship.

IMPORTANT!! READ THIS

All entries for this Field Trial are accepted on condition that the GSPFCA, its officials and members, land and horse owners, are released from all liabilities for loss, damage or injury sustained by animal or person in conjunction with, or during the running of, this field trial. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of the parent or guardian. All persons attending this field trial as participant or visitor will be required to sign a landowner waiver. For those entering this is contained on your entry form.

COVID 19

Due to the Covid 19 Pandemic the club will be adhering to all recommended guidelines in the Province of Alberta. Since this is an outdoor event masks will not be mandatory but please respect the physical distancing (2M) guidelines and other people's space.

General guidelines to be followed:

- 1. Practice physical distancing consistent with guidelines in effect (2m) at the time of the event. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
- 2. Wash hands as frequently as possible. We will have disinfecting spray and or wipes at bathroom facilities for people to spray door handles (or anything else they touch).
- 3. Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact.
- 4. If you have tested positive for Covid 19 in the 10 days prior to the event please stay home.

Things to remember:

- 1. There will be no hospitality or concession food available...
- 2. Bring water and food for yourself and your dogs.

- 3. The Club is grateful to have the use of these grounds. We ask for your co-operation in keeping the grounds free of litter by using the garbage bags provided. Parking will be restricted to the marked areas and limited if grounds are wet. No smoking will be allowed on the trial grounds. Smoking is only permitted in your parked vehicle.
- 4. If your dog poops, please scoop and dispose in the provided garbage bags or consider packing out your own refuge.
