DOG SHOW CLASS INFORMATION

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of this Specialty

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of this Specialty

12 to 18 Months Class – This class shall be for dogs at least 12 mos. of age on the day of this Specialty and under 18 mos. on the day of this Specialty

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. (Champions of any country excluded)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/co-owner **AND** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs

VETERANS CLASS – This class shall be for dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of this Specialty

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for Champions of record at the time of closing of entries for this Specialty. **Note:** A Listed dog **MAY** be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class **MUST** be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE FIRST SHOW. Listing Fees **WILL NOT** be refunded

NON-REGULAR CLASSES: Brace, Brood Bitch & Get, Stud Dog and Get,

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades

DOGS ENTERED IN NON-REGULAR CLASSES MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY

NEW RE-ENTRY REQUIREMENTS TO THE US

On **June 1, 2009**, the U.S. government will implement the full requirements of the land and sea phase of WHTI. The proposed rules require most U.S. citizens entering the United States at sea or land ports of entry to have a **passport, passport card**, or other travel documents approved by the Department of Homeland Security.

BORDER CROSSING: A Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require this certificate **MUST** be dated at least 30 days prior to re-entry into the U.S.

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
3. There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
4. Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
5. **Entries positively close 12:00 noon (PST) Thursday July 4, 2013**, and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.
6. Identification cards and judging schedules will be emailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented upon arrival at the show.
7. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. **Any N.S.F. or returned item will be subject to a minimum \$50.00 service charge. \$50.00 will be charged on all returned items NSF cheques.**
8. There is a minimum \$3.00 fee per credit card transaction.

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Attention US Visitors

If not entering on line please purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in CANADIAN FUNDS for the full amount. Please **do not** mark the cheques PAYABLE IN CANADIAN FUNDS or AT PAR as such items CANNOT BE cleared through the banks, and your Entry will be returned.

U.S. EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

For the sole purpose of entering CKC events to acquire CKC degrees and titles, foreign born, foreign owned dogs may apply for an EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER. This number must be obtained within 30 days after receiving points to avoid cancellation of wins, and can be obtained by submitting a copy of your foreign Certificate of Registration and a fee of \$57.60 with a letter of request to the CKC. (This ERN replaces a CKC Individual Registration Number for entering events only. The Individual Registration must still be obtained for breeding purposes.)

For final judging, the first place dog from each of the above classes will be brought together for the final placing of “**Best in Sweepstakes**” and “**Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes**”

PRIZES

Best in Sweepstakes will be awarded 25% of the Entry Fees received and a Rosette

Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes will be awarded 20% of the Entry Fees received and a Rosette

First Place winners in each class 3.75% of total entry and a Rosette
2nd to 4th place in each class—Flat Ribbon

The Club will retain the remaining 25% to defray costs.

Non Member Participation Fee

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a **Canadian** non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee

In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

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ADDITIONAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from these shows, which will be held strictly under Canadian Kennel Club Rules.
2. The Club reserves the right to decline to accept entries for just cause, in which case the fee will be refunded with the reason for non-acceptance. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club holding the show or any official connected therewith for refusal of an entry.
3. The Show-giving Club will exercise due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
4. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct of their animals while they are on the Show Grounds. Exhibitors are responsible for their equipment and possessions.
5. Dogs must be ready for judging. The club will not be responsible for and not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agent of breed or class judging. **NO RING WILL BE HELD UP WAITING FOR EXHIBITORS OR HANDLERS.**
6. For the benefit of the health of animals, the pleasure of exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping the show grounds as clean as possible. **EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP AFTER THEIR DOGS.** Dogs are to be exercised in **DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY**. Failure to comply may result in future entries being refused.
7. All trailers, motor homes, campers and recreational units will have buckets underneath their sink drains. Anyone found discharging gray or black water from their unit will immediately be removed from the grounds.
8. There will be no other facilities in case of inclement weather.
9. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
10. Entries will be acknowledged (with a judging schedule) as soon as possible after the closing date by email only. If it is not received within a reasonable time please contact the Show Secretary.
11. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Any exhibitor wishing to substitute or cancel an entry must do so in writing before the hour of closing. Substitutions or cancellations of entries after the closing time are prohibited. **THERE WILL BE NO REFUND FOR OVERPAYMENT OR DUPLICATE ENTRIES..** There is a minimum transaction fee of \$3.00 .
12. Instructions to exhibitors to review Section 6.3 - Judges - General, sub-sections 6.3.3, 6.3.4 and 6.3.5 of the Conformation Rules and Regulations.
13. Dogs must be kept ON LEAD in all Public Areas.
14. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules. This is a Non Smoking Show.

PEE WEE (non competitive) 4 TO 6.
JUNIOR NOVICE - 7 to 10 yrs SENIOR NOVICE - 15 to 18 yrs
JUNIOR OPEN - 7 to 10 yrs SENIOR OPEN - 15 to 18 yrs
INTERMEDIATE NOVICE – 11 to 14 yrs
INTERMEDIATE OPEN – 11 to 14 yrs

NOTE: PEE WEES do not compete for Best Overall.

Competition is open to all Juniors between the age of 4 up to 18 years of age (of the competition year). DOGS HANDLED BY THE JUNIORS MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS AT THE Specialty on Saturday July 28, 2012.

DOGS NEED NOT BE OWNED BY THE JUNIOR.

A rosette will be offered for FIRST IN EACH CLASS (except Pee Wee class entrants, who will receive a Participant flat ribbon). A rosette and trophy will be awarded for BEST OVERALL HANDLER. Ribbons will be awarded to second through fourth in each class., A Prize will be offered for Best Junior Handler.

RAMPS: Effective January 1, 2010, a ramp must be available to judges (at their discretion) for examination of low heavy set breeds, in accordance with the CKC Rules and Regulations: Spaniels (Clumber, Sussex,), Basset Hounds, Whippet, Bull Terriers (miniature), Irish Terrier, Kerry Blue Terrier, Soft Coated Wheaten Terrier, Staffordshire Bull Terrier, Bulldog, Chinese Char-Pei, Chow Chow, Kees-hound, Polish Lowland Sheepdog

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog.

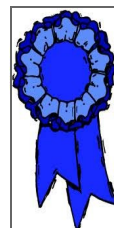
A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) the number of championship points shall be as follows:

In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

A Dog may not be credited with more than 5 points in a single show.
