SLED DOG CLASSES:

*** For all purebred registered Siberian Huskies **All dogs entered in the non-regular

classes must be entered in a regular class in the specialty or in Exhibition Only.

Dogs may be neutered/spayed.

Males & Females judged together.

Class A: For dogs with any level of "Sled Dog" titles (SD;SDX;SDU - Canadian and American titles accepted)

Class B: For dogs who have completed a publicized race* greater than 20km.

Class C: For dogs who have completed a publicized race* less than 20km.

(NB: Class B & C entries will require a copy of documentation signed by race official.

The winners of each sled dog class will compete for Best Overall Sled Dog, and The Henry Csabak Memorial Trophy.

* publicized race means any race that has been announced in a recognized magazine/newsletter or website, such as Sleddog Central, Team & Trail etc.

Trophies and rosettes will be offered as follows;

Best of Breed; Best of Opposite Sex; Select Male & Female; Best of Winners; Winners Male & Female; Reserve Male And Female; Best Puppy; Best of Breed (Altered); Best of Opposite Sex (Altered); Best Brace; Best Team; Best Sled Dog; Best Baby Puppy; Best Overall Sled Dog. An AWARD OF MERIT rosette and trophy is offered. (one AWARD of MERIT for every ten (10) dogs competing for Best of Breed)

Classifications

The following classes (divided by sex) are offered:

All regular classes as indicated in the Lakehead Kennel Club Premium List:

(Junior Puppy, Senior Puppy, 12 – 18 Mo, Bred By, Canadian Bred, Open, Specials) & Exhibition Only) Baby Puppy Class

The Baby Puppy Class is for dogs 3 months and under 6 months on the day of the show. Dogs entered in the Baby Puppy Class do not compete for points.

Puppies entered in this class will participate & compete for Best Baby Puppy in Specialty.

Plus

Veterans Class For dogs seven (7) years of age and over on the day of the show. (Dogs entered in this class may be neutered/spayed). Classes further divided by age (7-10 and 11 & over). Best Veteran Male & Female will compete for Breed.

Altered Classes All dogs over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure.

Non-Regular Classes

**All dogs entered in the non-regular classes must be entered in a regular class in the specialty or in Exhibition Only. Dogs may be neutered/spayed.

Brace: Two dogs shown on a single lead. Ownership does NOT have to be Identical.

Team: Four dogs shown on a single lead. Ownership does NOT have to be Identical.

Temporary Competition Numbers: Self-serve Online Registration for Listed Dogs

With the implementation of CKC's IT system, a new process requires all owners of unregistered, recognized breeds entering events to obtain a *Temporary Competition Number* (TCN). TCNs will replace the current system of entering events with "listed dogs", and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN or (Canine Companion Number) CCN.

While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called *listing fees*) when entering events using this number.

The process of obtaining a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion.

Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC via mail, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

Until March 2, 2020 dogs may still be entered into CKC events without a registration number or ERN by marking "TCN" on the entry form (or "Listed" if it is an old entry form). However, an e-mail address will be required. Before you apply for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if CKC has already created a TCN for them. There will be a tab for TCN Dogs on the Owner's Portal account.

Please note that if your dog does not have a registration number or ERN, and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores, or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. CKC records will be updated accordingly.

HOW TO GET YOUR TCN (TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER) ONLINE

Go to: CKC.ca and create an account, you need an account to do your application online. Under Quick Links go to Register Dog and follow the instructions.
