Lure coursing equipment will be a gas-powered continuous loop machine.

Entries open Wednesday, May 14, 2025 at 8pm Atlantic Time.

Entries close Wednesday, June 18, 2025 at 8pm Atlantic Time.

A wait list will be taken via DogShow.ca. Entries will be accepted from the waitlist up until the listed closing date.

Schedule for Each Day:

9:00 am - 10:30 am – First heat of ~10 dogs (~20 runs)
10:30 am - 12:00 pm – Second heat of ~10 dogs (~20 runs)
12:00 pm - 12:30 pm - LUNCH
12:30 pm - 2:00 pm – Third heat of ~10 dogs (~20 runs)
2:00 pm - 3:30 pm – Fourth heat of ~10 dogs (~20 runs)
3:30 pm - 5:00 pm – Fifth heat of ~10 dogs (~20 runs)

***Note:** Tests will run concurrently (i.e. each dog will run their second test in the same time block as their first). The running order will be cycled through TWICE, giving dogs a break between tests.*

***Note:** Each test is its own event; therefore, dogs must be inspected each time. i.e., Inspection for Test 1 will take place at the beginning of each heat; inspection for Test 2 will take place after Test 1.

All dogs in Sprinter Tests run the same distance (100 meters) but are assigned a handicap for points based on their height class. Dogs entered as Veterans will require half the points to achieve each title. Please see the CKC Sprinter Rules & Regulations for further information.

ENTRY FEES:

Entry fees per dog per test.....\$20.00
TCN fees per dog per test.....\$11.50*

***NOTE:** A CKC TCN (Temporary Competition Number) fee of \$11.50 per dog is payable for each dog that does NOT have a CKC Registration Number, Performance Event Number or Event Registration Number. This \$11.50 is **in addition** to the regular class entry fee.

HOW THE EVENT IS RUN

Please read this carefully

You are responsible for reading the club waiver (attached) which you will electronically sign with your online entry. Your helper (or anyone else you bring) must complete a paper waiver and bring it to the tests (or email it to novawestkc@gmail.com beforehand).

You are responsible for calculating/checking your own points and knowing if your dog has achieved any titles. Your dog's Sprinter points (earned *after* August 28, 2019) are now available on your CKC online portal. The calculations and handicaps are available via the Sprinter Rules & Regulations from the CKC website at: [Sprinter Rules & Regulations \[CLICK HERE\]](#)

On arrival for your scheduled time slot:

1. Please do not arrive more than 20 minutes before your assigned time block. When you arrive, go to the main check-in station for the lameness and in-season inspection. You will need to swab your bitch with a tissue for in-season check. If your dog has not been measured at a prior event, they will also be measured.
2. **Two to three dogs before your run**, proceed to the start line waiting area with your dog and have your Catcher (which may be you or your helper) proceed directly to the finish line **with a leash**. ***Unless it is a dog's very FIRST Sprinter Test weekend, Catchers CANNOT wait at the start line then walk/run down the chute when their dog steps to the start line for their turn. The Catcher must ALREADY be at the finish line and ready to catch the dog as the dog steps to the start line with their Releaser.*** Dogs may run "naked" or wear a flat, snug-fitting buckle catch collar with nothing hanging from it that can become entangled in the line **(NO running in martingale or slip collars and NO tags on catch collars)**. You may walk your dog to the start line in a martingale, slip collar or harness, but it **MUST** be removed prior to releasing them.
3. Once your dog runs and is caught and leashed, **clear the chute area**, and prepare for their second run. For safety reasons, **please stay CLEAR of the chute when walking your dog back from the finish line.**

4. The running order is cycled through TWICE (repeat steps 1-3) and the dog runs its second, and final, run for the day.
5. Once you have completed your two runs per dog, collected your ribbons, copied your times from the binder on the table, and taken your photos, please leave the property in a timely manner so the next heat may begin.

OTHER EVENT INFORMATION

You will need to crate your dog in/by your car. There will be no shade provided so please keep your dog cool by keeping windows open, using shade cloths, and providing fresh water (please bring your own).

All competitors must bring ***TWO* leashes**, one each for the Releaser and Catcher. **A slip leash is ideal for the Catcher.** You may bring your own helper to act as your Catcher or Releaser. If you are not bringing a helper, you may list another exhibitor as your helper or request that a club volunteer release your dog (our volunteers are under no obligation to release/handle your dog and reserve the right to refuse to release/handle your dog for any reason). **This information will be gathered in a Google form via email ~2 weeks before the tests.**

There will be a “photo booth” set up near the parking area with title/event boards. Feel free to take some pictures of your dog with their ribbons.

Field Conditions:

- Field is partially fenced
- No shade on field, bring your own, as well as drinking water
- Please only park where directed

Important Notes:

This is a PRIVATE property, and we are grateful for the use of this location. Please respect instructions, pick up after and maintain control of your dog.

Retractable leads, prong collars, and electronic collars are not allowed on the premises. Owners may have their dog wear a muzzle, if they desire. Dogs may run “naked” or wear a flat, snug-fitting buckle catch collar with nothing hanging from it that can become entangled in the line. You may walk your dog to the start line in a martingale, slip collar or harness, but it MUST be removed prior to releasing them.

There is a risk of injury for all active sports; you can reduce this risk by warming up and cooling down your dog, only running your dog when you feel the field and weather are appropriate and staying aware of your environment and any safety hazards. A \$10 fine, payable to NWKC, will be levied for any dog loose on the field from the time of inspection until the completion of all events for the day. A

\$10 fine, payable to NWKC, will be levied for any exhibitor not picking up after their dog. Events run rain or shine.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Sprinter Rules & Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club online or via mail. Tel: 1-800-250-8040.

CKC Regulations:

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Test Chairperson shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Eligibility:

Purebred or mixed-breed dogs must be at least 12 months of age that are:

- (a) Individually registered with the CKC,
- (b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN),
- (c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN),
- (d) Eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- (e) Have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed
- (f) Have a Canine Companion number (CCN) if it is a mixed-breed.

Bitches in Season:

***NEW* *As of January 1, 2024, bitches in season are permitted to enter these tests*.** Females in season must wear clean, dry, snugly fitting panties specifically designed for the purpose of preventing/containing discharge. Bitches in season will run in the last heat at the end of the day.

Veteran Titling Stream:

***NEW* *As of January 1, 2024, dogs 7 years old or older may enter Sprinter Tests as a Veteran (OPTIONAL)*.** The entry form must identify a dog being entered as a veteran. A dog may only be entered once in the same event. See the CKC Sprinter rule book for more information on the new Veteran titles.

In consideration of acceptance of the entry and the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win ribbons and/or prizes at the SPRINTER test(s) held on _____ [print date(s)], I agree:

1. To hold the Host Club including its members, directors, officers, employees and volunteers (collectively defined as "the Host Club"), as well as the owner and lessor of the real property on which the event is held, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of myself or my dog(s) while in or about the event premises or grounds near the entrance thereto and I assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim.
2. To hold the Host Club harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise and from any claim for damage or injury, even if such loss or damage/injury was caused or alleged to be caused by negligence of the Host Club or any other person(s);
3. To assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the Host Club harmless from any and all loss and expense, including legal fees, by reason of the liabilities imposed by law upon the Host Club for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person(s), including myself, or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my participation in the event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the Host Club or any other person(s);
