Dogs not registered in Canada must obtain a TCN before submitting an entry for a field trial. TCN's can be obtained from the CKC online, by paper application, or by contacting the Show & Trials division, toll free at 1-855-364-7252. A TCN fee of \$10.50 must be included with your entry for the trial.

CKC Registration or ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the trial or all awards will be cancelled.

Scratches: Entry fees will be fully refunded for a bitch in season. All other scratches will be refunded at the Field Trial Committee's discretion, minus an administration fee of \$10.

Please note: New CKC ruling: Canadian Resident non CKC Members running a wholly owned dog cannot win a placement unless they pay a non-member participation fee or a membership fee to the CKC.

Dead ducks and pheasants will be used. Males and females will be run in order of the draw. Starting dog in the all Stakes will be determined by the TSX closing on Thursday,, June 19th 2025. A system of rotation may be used for the start of subsequent series in all stakes. Female dogs will not be vetted and handlers are reminded that bitches in estrus cannot compete in a CKC Licensed Trial.

The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
