Attention All Foreign Exhibitors!

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned for the sole purpose of entering CKC events do not require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The Event Registration Number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian Dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "at Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Thanks.

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. **The fee is \$57.60 + 5% GST.**

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

General Information and Regulations for This Event

- All Classes held Outdoors – Rain or Shine.
- Exhibitors must abide by the errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- The Show Superintendent is in full and complete charge of the Shows and Trials, which are governed by CKC rules.
- No Judge or any other person participating in any capacity at a dog show held under CKC Rules shall be subjected to an indignity of any kind during the process of the Show. Chapter 4.1.3. CKC Rules.
- Bitches entered in Obedience who come into “season” will have their full fees refunded provided that written proof from a veterinarian certifying that the bitch was in “season” within the ten-day period preceding the trial is received by the Show Secretary on or before the date of the Trial. CKC Obedience Rule Chapter 1.11.1.
- The Dog Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs, exhibitors and spectators, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortune.
- All participants must park in designated areas only. Obey posted parking signs displayed on site.
- Dogs must be under control at all times, exhibitors are responsible for clean up and are expected to use designated exercise areas – Any one violating this rule will be removed from the show site.
- The show precincts will be the designated area within fifteen feet of the show ring.
