NOTE: a CKC TCN (Listing) Fee of \$11.30 per dog is payable for each dog that does NOT have a CKC Registration Number, Performance Event Number or Event Registration Number, Temporary Competition number. This \$11.30 is in addition to the regular class entry fee.

OTHER ENTRY INFORMATION:

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full and accompanied by a signed waiver and entry fees. Telephone entries cannot be accepted
- Cheques dated after the close of entries will not be accepted. Tendering of an NSF cheque will be considered non-payment of entry and can result in cancellation of awards. All NSF/ returned cheques are subject to a \$40 service charge. There will be no refund of overpayments or duplicate entries
- 3. An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time published in the premium list. Written or electronic notification MUST be received by the Event Secretary by the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the event(s). Entries that are cancelled before the closing date will be refunded.

REFUNDS:

There are NO CREDITS nor refunds for anyone wishing to pull their entries after the closing date / or when limit is reached.

If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to start or to complete this event, no refund of entry will be made.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB INFORMATION

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE POLICY

Effective January 1, 2011

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$59.40, plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers
- all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
 c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (TCN)

Effective November 1, 2019, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and

enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require a Temporary Competition number (TCN). This TCN does not register a dog for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an TCN, go to the CKC website and register online. This number will automatically be generated once submitted and will be a 9 character registration number such as TC-AB1234567

MIXED AND UNRECOGNIZED BREEDS

These events are open to mixed and unrecognized breeds. In order to compete, mixed and unrecognized breed dogs must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) from the Canadian Kennel Club and must have a CKC-approved microchip. Mixed-breed dogs must be spayed or neutered.

Unrecognized breed dogs do not need to be spayed or neutered. A dog eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC studbook it may be entered as a listed dog per CKC rules for this designation, as of July 1, 2018; exhibitors must apply to the CKC for "temporary competition number (TCN), before event closing date".

TITLES SHALL BE AWARDED ON THE BASIS OF THE FOLLOWING:

Sprinter Titles will be awarded for dogs that accumulate the required points. For purebred dogs, these are suffix titles that will appear on a dog's pedigree with a higher level title superseding a lower level title.

- 1. Novice Sprinter (NS) = 150 points
- 2. Sprinter (S) =500 points
- 3. Advanced Sprinter (AS) = 1,000 points
- 4. Sprinter Excellent (SE) = 1,500 points
- 5. SE followed by a number (e.g. SE2) for every additional 500 points

Veteran

- 1. Veteran Novice Sprinter (VNS) = 750 points
- 2. Veteran Sprinter (VS) =250 points
- 3. Veteran Advanced Sprinter (VAS) = 500 points

- 4. Veteran Sprinter Excellent (VSX) = 750 points
- 5. Veteran SE followed by a number (e.g. VSX2) for every additional 250 points

RIBBONS:

Flat ribbons for qualifying time Title Ribbons

ELIGIBILITY & EQUIPMENT

ELIGIBLE BREEDS: SPRINTER participation is open to all purebred and mixed breed dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the CKC; or have Temporary Competition Number (TCN); or have a Performance Event Number (PEN); or eligible for registration with the CKC; or have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed; or have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it's a mixed breed. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event.

***** New FEMALES IN SEASON: ********

Females in season must wear a clean, dry, snugly fitting panties specifically designed for the purpose of preventing/containing discharge.

ROLL CALL for females in season will be NOON.

They will run at the end of all events on each day.

Panties must be worn at all times when not in the "females in season" exercise area.

Please advise event secretary prior to the day of event that your female is in season or 1 hour prior to roll call, if absent for regular roll call and we are not aware they will be scratched and NO REFUND given.

The host club(s) DO NOT assume any responsibility for "accidental" breedings; it is the sole responsibility of handlers to ensure that this does not happen.

CONDITIONS: All dogs will run individually. Bitches in season or lame dogs during roll call will be excused and any entry refunded. Dogs not present at roll call will be scratched and entry fees not refunded. Slip leads recommended when starting your dogs. Muzzles should be used, if no muzzle available, two handlers are required to catch the dog. Dogs may wear plain flat collars with no tags or attachments.

EQUIPMENT: Drag type with squawker lure, or continuous loop lure with plastic bags. Handler may bring a toy to add to the line for their dog's run, (if deemed safe and practical by Starter)

HEALTH REMINDERS:

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease:

- 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
- 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

FIELD CONDITIONS

- All fenced. No shade on field.
- Picking up after your dog is required.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Port-a-potty on site
- NO POOP bags in port-a-potty
- NO food or vendors on site, bring your own food/water for dogs
- Dogs will run once per event
- There will be a \$20 fine for any loose dogs interfering with a course in progress
- Flexi Leads and Electronic collars are not permitted on the field
- Please ensure you bring a MUZZLE to prevent destruction of the lure
- Handlers will require a helper to catch their dog at finish and return lure to start line – if no muzzle two catchers are requested to catch the dog
- It is a good idea to have a leash for releaser and catcher
- Dogs are expected to be aroused and excited in the presence of the lure, but handlers must be able to control their dogs for everyone's safety or they shall be refunded their entry and not allowed to run. Additionally, the Field Committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site
- The Host Clubs appreciate everyone's co-operation in keeping our site clean.

VOLUNTEERS:

They are essential to help run these events, so we can all enjoy our dogs having fun. Please consider volunteering at these events, learn to work as a starter, timer, begin learning about lure operating or helping other exhibitors with releasing or catching.
