ELIGIBILITY

In order to be eligible to compete in these trials, a dog must be registered with the CKC, hold an ERN, PEN, or Misc. number, or be eligible for same. Dogs may be spayed, neutered and/or debarked. Dogs must be 18 months of age or older. Dog may not compete if it has tape or bandages (such a dog must be immediately excused and may not return later for judging after same has been removed.) Dog may not be lame.

ENTRIES LIMITED TO 150 RUNS PER TRIAL

CONTACT FAMILIARIZATION will not be available at these trials.

SURFACE Trial will be run outdoors on sand.

PRECINCTS The precincts of the trial will extend to 20 ft. beyond the rings.

VOLUNTEERS Volunteers are needed to help with timing and scribing. If you are willing to volunteer, please indicate your preference and include with your entry.

MOVE-UPS will be allowed from the morning trial to the afternoon trial and must be completed at least one hour prior to the start of the afternoon trial.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Building will open at 6:30am each day. On Friday, the building will be open from 4:00pm until 10:00pm for anyone wishing to set up early.
- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of shows, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- **All rules and regulations pertaining to the Halifax Kennel Club show are applicable to this show.**
- **All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.**
- Dogs should be in the building 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging and may be removed from the building after their breed. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.

- Papillon Canada and Exhibition Park will not be held responsible for any equipment left in the building overnight.
- A canteen will be available in the arena.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is enforced. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 6.3.3)
- No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 6.3.4)
- Papillon Canada and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the BMDCC and their Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.
- "Puppy for Sale" or "Dog for Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.
- The precincts of the show shall be the entire building and its entrances.

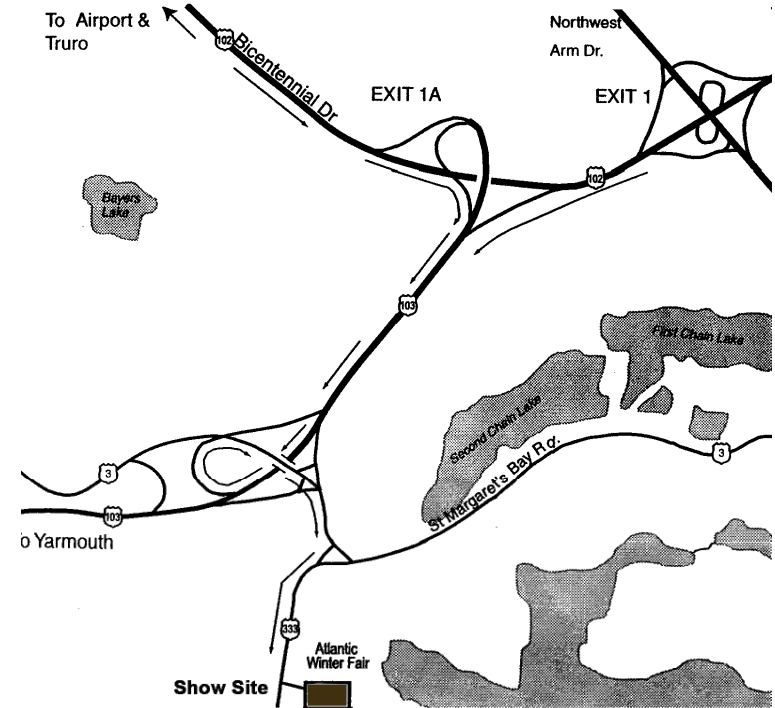
