JUNIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.			
SENIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.			
12-18 MONTHS	Dogs between 12 months and under18 months on day of show.			
CANADIAN BRED	Dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.			
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.			
OPEN CLASS	For all dogs			
SPECIALS ONLY	Dogs who are Canadian champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.			
VETERAN CLASS	Dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. These dogs to compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners) Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.			
	ION-REGULAR AND UNOFFICIAL CLASSES: in any Non-Regular or Unofficial class dogs must also be entered in a Regular class by be spayed or neutered.			
BABY PUPPY	Dogs 3months and under 6 months on day of show. These puppies are not eligible to compete for championship points			
PUPPY 3-6 MONTH EXHIBITION ONLY	Puppies 3 – 6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months <u>provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class.</u> These puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or official classes.			
EXHIBITION ONLY	Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.			
STUD DOG AND GET	Stud Dog and two or more of his Get. The Stud Dog may be entered in a Regular Class or Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular Class.			
BROOD BITCH AND PROGENY	Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. This class shall have the same requirements as for Stud Dog and Get class.			
BRACE	Two dogs not necessarily of the same sex or owner; must be handled by one person on one lead and should be judged as an identical pair. Dogs may be spayed / neutered.			

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES:

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone <u>but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time.</u> If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

ERRORS IN ENTRIES:

An error in an age-specified class, date of birth or sex, may be amended up to one hour before the start of the show.

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. \$59.40 + 5% GST. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. 
