In payment of entry fees, the tendering of NSF cheques shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A collection fee of \$25.00 will be added to the amount of any returned cheque. **Fax entries** and/or **credit card payment** will be accepted when accompanied by authorized VISA or MASTERCARD credit card number, expiry date and cardholder's name. 10% of total fee will be added for FAX/Credit Card entries. Customers whose charges are declined by the Bank Card Authorization Department will be assessed a service charge of \$25.00 for each transaction declined. Telephone entries are not accepted by the Show Secretary. Incomplete entries or entries received without fees, or entries received after the advertised closing date will not be accepted. #### **REGULAR CLASSES**

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex.

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

12 - 15 MONTH 12 months & under 15 months on the day of the show

**15 - 18 MONTH** 15 months & under 18 months on the day of the show

**CANADIAN BRED** – Dogs born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR** – Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner and breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

**OPEN CLASS** - shall be for all Dogs.

**VETERANS** - open to all dogs over 7 years of age and older on the day of the Specialty. The winners of the Veterans Male & Female classes will not compete for Championship points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Veteran dogs may be neutered or spayed.

**SPECIALS ONLY** - This class will NOT be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for "Specials Only" and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. Should a dog entered for Specials Only place in its group at the show then all awards the dog earned at the show will be canceled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

**AWARD OF MERIT** This award will be made after the Best of Breed judging. One Award of Merit is offered at the discretion of the judge for every 10 dogs competing at the Best of Breed level.

#### NON-REGULAR CLASSES

**EXHIBITION ONLY** - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes. **STUD DOG & GET** - The name of the Stud Dog must be indicated on the entry form, the name of the get must also be on the entry form. The entry will consist of the dog and two of his progeny. Entry in this class need not be the property of the same owner although ALL must be entered in regular classes or Specials Only or Exhibition Only

**BROOD BITCH & PROGENY** - The name of the Bitch must be indicated on the entry form, the name of the get must also be on the entry form. The entry will consist of the bitch and two of her progeny. Entry in this class need not be the property of the same owner although ALL must be entered in regular classes or Specials Only or Exhibition Only

**BRACE CLASS**.... This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex)

**GUN DOG/BITCH** For any spaniel that has earned a Working Spaniel (WS) title or higher at a Spaniel Hunt Test, or has earned a placing (1st through 4th) in an Open or All-Age Field Trial class in Canada or the US by the close of entries..

**SEXUALLY ALTERED DOG CLASSES** Eligibility for the Altered Dog Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered Dog Class judging. These classes will be judged immediately after Best of Breed of the regular classes.

Two classes will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed

#### CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows: (\*Includes the dog awarded Winners.)

Dogs Competing\* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more Points Allocated\* 0 1 2 3 4 5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded winners also places in the Group as listed hereunder. NEW: A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points. Further section 15.1.12 {C} has been added and states the dog must: "have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed level or group level."

#### TROPHIES AND ROSETTES

Rosettes and /or Trophies are offered by the members of Clumber Spaniel Club of Canada, for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best Puppy in Breed, Best of Winners, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Reserve Winners Dog, Reserve Winners Bitch. Rosettes will be given for first in each class and **Best Veteran Male & Female, Best Veteran in Breed**, Best Stud Dog, Best Brood Bitch, Best Altered Bitch and Dog, Best of Breed Altered, Best of Opposite Sex Altered, Hunting Dog Hunting Bitch, Brace. Rosettes will be offered for Award of Merits. One Award Of Merit will be offered for every 10 dogs competing at Best of Breed level. Awards of Merit will be presented at the

discretion of the judge. Select dog or bitch if that is awarded here.(?)

Best of Winners - Stained Glass Plaque

Best Puppy - Donated by the founding members of CSCC and sponsored by its' members;

All Perpetual Trophies remain in the possession of the CSCC. Keeper Trophies will be awarded.

## About The Club

The Clumber Spaniel Club of Canada was granted recognition on June 1, 1994. The Club was formed to ensure the quality breeding of Clumber Spaniels, promote the natural versatility of the Clumber, inform the public concerning the Clumber, and to hold a National Specialty show, boosters and all forms of trials for the breed. The first Annual General Membership meeting was held on October 15, 1994 at the London, Ontario show, and the first Specialty was held in October, at London Ontario, in 1995.

# **SWEEPSTAKES**

#### Juvenile:

Classes (Sexes divided), 6 - 9 months, 9 -12 months, 12-15 months, 15-18 months All Clumber Spaniels between the ages of 6 and 18 months on the day of the Specialty shall be eligible to compete regardless of place of birth.

Money received as entry fee for the sweepstakes will be pooled and divided as follows:

1 -30%, 2nd-20%, 3 -15%, 4th-10% of money for each class. A rosette &/or prize will be awarded for Best in Sweeps, Best Opposite Sex, Flat ribbons will be awarded for placements in each class. Balance of 25% will be retained for administration.

#### Veteran:

Classes (Sexes divided), 7 - 9 Years, 9+ Years All Clumber Spaniels between the ages of 6 and 18 months on the day of the Specialty shall be eligible to compete regardless of place of birth.

Money received as entry fee for the sweepstakes will be pooled and divided as follows:

1 -30%, 2nd-20%, 3 -15%, 4th-10% of money for each class. A rosette &/or prize will be awarded for Best in Sweeps, Best Opposite Sex, Flat ribbons will be awarded for placements in each class. Balance of 25% will be retained for administration.

## **GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS**

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors patrons, or equipment.
- 4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under C.K.C. rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
- 5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. The ring shall not be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers.
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied with a fee set by CKC which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 9. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring.
- 10. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club.
- 11. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from completion by action of the Show Committee.
