COVID RULES, INFORMATION and WAIVER

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING ENTERING THIS SHOW!

By submitting entries or attending this show you are declaring that you agree to the following strictly enforced COVID RULES and the RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INFORMED CONSENT. Please do not enter this show if you have personal or political reasons for not abiding by the Alberta Government Covid-19 protocols.

- 1. Execution of the show is contingent on the Camrose area of Alberta remaining open for ADULT SPORTS in the Alberta COVID reopening plan and allowed to compete in the numbers expressed in the catalogue. Unfettered provincial, interprovincial and international travel is not a prerequisite for operating the show, and refunds will not be considered if you cannot travel to the show due to a restriction on travel.
- 2. MASKS are RECOMMENDED in the building
- 3. **PHYSICAL DISTANCING is RECOMMENDED** in the building. Conformation rings will be larger to provide a buffer between exhibitors and people waiting outside the ring.
- 4. In general **PERFORMANCE** exhibitors should park in the **FRONT** lot. **CONFORMATION** exhibitors should park in the **BACK** parking lot.
- 5. Violation of any rule may result in your entries for the weekend being cancelled with NO refund of entries and a COMPLAINT lodged by BRCA with the CKC.
- 6. The concession will not be operating. Food trucks will be available in the parking lot.
- 7. Limited RESERVED BENCHING will be permitted in the show building. UNRESERVED BENCHING will also be available. DAY-BENCHING will also be provided for those that only need a space to hold a crate while you're showing. Dryers will be permitted in the benching areas. If you cannot book or find benching space please be prepared to groom your dog before you come to the show and use the day-benching area.
- 8. The building will be CLEANED each night and anything left behind in the day-benching or ringside area will be removed. Tables and other high touch surfaces will be cleaned regularly throughout the day. There will be limited chairs at ringside.
- 9. **REFUND POLICY**: If we are required to CANCEL the show due to any Alberta Government, City of Camrose or Canadian Kennel Club guidelines, policies or directives, a partial refund (based upon our unrecoverable costs) of entries will be considered. In the event of any refunds; credit card and Dogshow.ca charges will not be refunded.
- 10. **ISOLATION REFUND POLICY**: If required to ISOLATE due to a COVID-19 core symptom, try to find an alternate handler for your dog. In the event you are unable to find an alternate handler the BRCA will consider a 50% refund of applicable entry fees when accompanied by proof of a positive Alberta Health Services COVID-19 test, a Doctors note showing COVID-19 symptoms and requirement to isolate, or an Alberta Health Services or Canada Border Services isolation order. Please note that submission for this type of refund will be evaluated after the Show's completion. - 11. There will be a PHOTOGRAPHER at this show.
- 12. There will be NO PUBLIC attendance at this show. You may bring helpers with you.

- 1. I agree and acknowledge that I have met all the prerequisites required for participation in the Event and will abide by its rules and regulations.
- 2. I agree and acknowledge that participation in The Event has risks and hazards including risks associated with the novel coronavirus and COVID-19. As a participant, I may suffer property damage, personal injury, and even death. I freely and voluntarily assume all the risks and hazards of participation, including any legal risks. This means that I am giving up my right to sue the BRCA, its members or employees for any reason, including the BRCA, its members or employees' negligence, if I suffer any damage, injury, loss or death by participating in the Event.
- 3. I agree and acknowledge that, I waive any claim I may have against the BRCA, its members or employees arising from my participation in the Event, however it is caused, and I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the BRCA, its members or employees from all claims arising from my participation in The Event.
- This RÉLEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS INCLUDING CLAIMS ASSOCIATED WITH THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS AND COVID-19, ASSUMPTION OF RISK and INDEMNITY is binding on myself, my heirs, my executors, administrators, personal representatives and assigns.

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

A description of all *Conformation, Obedience and Rally Classes* and *Rule and Regulations* can be found at www.ckc.ca

- 1. This show is held INDOORS at the **Camrose Regional Exhibition Grounds (4250 Exhibition Drive, Camrose, Alberta)**
- 2. This is an UNLIMITED entry Conformation dog show. Performance shows entry limited to the timing restrictions of each judge.
- 3. DAY OF TRIAL ENTRIES are permitted at this show. MIXED BREEDS are allowed in performance events with CCN.
- 4. RALLY-OBEDIENCE will be held in a 40' x 55' Ring. The Precincts of the Rally trials are the ring and the immediate area surrounding the ring. Only dogs entered in the trials are permitted within the Precincts of the Rally trials.
- 5. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to INDIGNITIES. The Conformation Show or Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue. (19.7 CKC Conformation Show and 20.7 CKC Obedience and Rally-Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations.)
- 6. ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by an act of the event club or because it has been entered incorrectly, except as provided in 8 below. Nor will entry fees be refunded if due to riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the BRCA, that make it impossible to open or complete the show. See COVID Rules for Special Circumstances.
- 7. ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED INTO THE OBEDIENCE OR RALLY SHOW COMES IN TO SEASON within 10 days of the show. A veterinary letter certifying that the bitch came into season within 10 days prior to the show must be delivered to the Show Secretary prior to the commencement of that trial's judging.
- 8. NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE:
 - a. An annual non-member fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
 - b. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or pay the non-member fee.
 - c. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-members of the CKC.
- 9. The show building will be OPEN at 4 p.m. on Thursday for exhibitors. Booths may be set up after 1 p.m. Thursday.
- 10. The Camrose Regional Exhibition will LOCK the doors at 10 p.m. each night of the show and OPEN the doors at 6:00 a.m. each morning. CRE staff will patrol the building overnight but will not be responsible for any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons or their property.
- 11. All EMPTY rings are to be kept free of dogs one hour before the show and during the show.
- 12. Entries will be ACKNOWLEDGED after the closing date. Judging schedule and receipts available online or by mail.
- 13. Dogs must be EXERCISED in designated areas only. If you exercise outside you must clean up after your dog.
- 14. All dogs in the show building must either be REGISTERED in the show, "IN TRANSIT" or registered for the Eye Clinic.
- 15. All entries must be CLEARLY filled out. The BRCA or the Show Secretary will not correct incorrect entries.
- 16. SIGNS advertising puppies or other services will not be permitted in the benching area or around the rings
- 17. BRCA has a ZERO tolerance of abuse of any description involving any person involved with BRCA Shows, including spectators.

CKC Conformation Judging Rule Changes for COVID

MOTION:

"THAT, the following be in place to allow clubs flexibility with their judging panels due to government COVID-19 regulations when every reasonable effort has been made to fulfill the judging panel with licensed or permit judges.

This is a temporary alteration to normal judge approval practices.

Exceptions will be permitted under the following circumstances where local guidelines limits the choice of judges to a region and no judges are available.

This includes circumstances where the guidelines change prior to the beginning of the show where judges can no longer officiate.

The club may obtain Shows & Trials Approval to allow permit judges to judge beyond their approved groups.

The club may also seek Shows and Trials approval to select as a Judge a CKC member who must meet the following criteria:


1) Has attended Judges 101 course

2) Has a minimum of 10 years experience as an exhibitor or handler

3) Has acted as a Ring steward within the past 3 years

4) The breeds and/or groups to be judged should be aligned to their breeding or handling experience.

In the unlikely event that there is no individual who meets the above criteria, the club will be required to provide a short biography of the selected person to Shows and Trials for consideration. These assignments will not count towards any future credit for assignments.

To minimize exposure of the Veterinarian and her helpers to COVID, dogs will be taken into the examination room by the veterinarian's assistant.





CKC Obedience and Rally Rule Changes for COVID

(Copied directly from CKC Covid guidelines)

Clubs will follow all Federal, Provincial and local health rules when holding a trial and the protocol will be detailed in the Premium List. Judges, officials, and handlers will abide by the rules specified.

The following are allowable temporary changes to the Obedience Rules and Regulations that a club may opt to use during their event while operating under COVID restrictions. However, any other changes to any other rule not mentioned here will not be allowed.

• Judges may wear a mask even if not required by the club

• The chair or table where the leash and other equipment is to be placed should be located at a convenient place determined by the judge but can be located in the ring or if not appropriate, just outside of the ring such that the handler can obtain the item without leaving the ring

• If a chair or table or any other surface is used to hold leashes, dumbbells, gloves or any other equipment owned by the handler, that surface must be sanitized immediately after use. Paper can be placed on the surface if sanitizing is not done but that paper must be removed immediately after use, disposed of appropriately and replaced ready for the next exhibitor

• If a re-throw of the dumbbell is required, the handler should be allowed to ask the dog to stay and the handler will go and pick up the dumbbell and return to where the dog was left. If the dog moves during this process, it will not be judged unless it is out of control

• For the article exercise in Utility, the handler can retrieve the articles to be scented from the article bag and put them on the 'article' chair

• Score sheets should not be given out to competitors in the ring, but the club may pass the scoresheet information on to the competitors electronically or some other 'touch free' means

• In the Rally Advanced Class, the handler can put the leash in their pocket or hang it around the neck as in the Pre-Novice recall

• The exhibitor may either leave the dog on a sit stay or heel with the dog to the location of the chair to both obtain and return their leash and articles used during the exercises.

• It is recommended that the club publish either in the premium list or judging schedule or both, the modified rules that it is adopting for their event.



CONFORMATION CLASSES OFFERED:

The following Regular classes will be offered, divided by sex.

for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

<u>JUNIOR PUPPY</u> - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show <u>SENIOR PUPPY</u>- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show <u>CANADIAN BRED</u> - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded. <u>12 – 18 MONTH CLASS</u> 12 months and under 18 months on the day of the show. <u>BRED BY EXHIBITOR</u> - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. <u>OPEN CLASS</u> - shall be for all Dogs. <u>SPECIALS ONLY</u> - This class will NOT be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for "Specials Only" and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be cancelled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

<u>VETERAN CLASS</u> - In this optional class for All Breed Shows, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. The awards for this class are: Best Male Veteran and Best Female Veteran Best Veteran in Breed Best Veteran in Group Best Veteran in Show A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Breed is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Group. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Group is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Show.

<u>BABY PUPPY CLASS</u> – Dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The award for this class are: Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female Best Baby Puppy in Breed Best Baby Puppy in Group Best Baby Puppy in Show

<u>BRACE CLASS</u> - This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). <u>EXHIBITION ONLY</u> - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.



OBEDIENCE:

- <u>PRE-NOVICE</u> shall be for any dog which has not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person.
- <u>NOVICE "A"</u> No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. Title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be canceled.
- <u>NOVICE "B"</u> Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person & shall be for pure-bred dogs of any breed which have not won the title of C.D. in Canada
- NOVICE "C" as per Obedience Trial Rules & Regulation
- **INTERMEDIATE NOVICE** as per Obedience Trial Rules & Regulation
- <u>OPEN "HA"</u>- The Open HA class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized
 - breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class. Group exercises in Open HA are out of site as before in the original open classes.
- <u>OPEN "18A"</u> -The requirements are the same as Open HA and the same rules except the Long Sit is replaced with Change of Positions Exercises and the Long Down is replaced with a Group Sit-Walk around.
- <u>OPEN "HB"</u> The Open HB class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. Dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X. or any higher titles may enter in the Open B class. A dog may also be entered in the Utility Class in the same trial. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 7 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines is to be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to the exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six routines so that each set will be used approximately the same number of times. Group exercises in Open HB are out of site as before in the original open classes .
- <u>OPEN 18B</u> The requirements are the same as Open HB and the same rules apply except the addition of the new Change of Positions Exercises. As described in the Open HA and Open 18A classes
- <u>UTILITY "A"</u> For any purebred dog that has not earned the title of UD. No person who has earned a MOTCH title may handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Exercises will be performed in the usual order.
- <u>UTILITY "B"</u> Exercises will be done in random order. Order will be posted approximately 30 minutes prior to judging.
- <u>VETERANS</u> (Unofficial class)– For any dog that has earned the title of C.D. or higher and is 7 years old or older on the day of the trial. Exercises shall be performed and judged as in the novice classes. Dog entered in veterans must also be entered in any regular class or exhibition only. Owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class.

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES OFFERED

- Rally Ring size will be **50' x 50'**
- The precincts of these trials are the ring and immediate area surrounding
- Only dogs entered are permitted within the precincts of the trial.
- Order of judging will be determined at the close of entries.
- All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.
- No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.
- No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC Obedience CDX title shall be eligible to enter the A class in Rally Novice, Advanced or Excellent.

The following classes will be offered in each Rally Obedience Trial: Rally Novice A, Rally Novice B, Rally Intermediate, Rally Advanced A, Rally Advanced, B, Rally Excellent A, Rally Excellent B, Rally Master

RALLY NOVICE A - Dogs competing in this class may not have earned the R. N. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY NOVICE B - Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY INTERMEDIATE - The Rally Intermediate Class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Rally Advanced Classes.(CKC rules, 10.1.2) This class shall be for dogs that have earned the

R.N. title. A dog completing the R.I. or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class (performed on leash, no jumps, no A or B division) may be entered indefinitely. Judges would ordinarily use the same course for it as for their Advanced Classes, substituting one other exercise for the jump required in Advanced.

RALLY ADVANCED A - This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY ADVANCED B - This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.A. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

RALLY EXCELLENT A - This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R. A. title, but have not earned the R. E. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is also a sit stay exercise after the finish sign. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY EXCELLENT B - This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.A. title. A dog completing the R.E. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is a sit stay exercise after the finish sign.

RALLY MASTER - This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.E. TITLE . A dog completing the R.M. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

15.1.13 The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

As of July 2021, the rules for awarding of Grand Champion and Grand Champion Excellent have changed. Please see CKC Conformation Rule 15.2 Grand Champion (GCH) & 15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GCHEX) for details.
